

50% jump in price, low supply could turn V'puram eateries cylinder-less by weekend

NEARLY 90% of hotels in town could run out of cylinders by the weekend as the distributors sell only one or two cylinders per day to outlets, according to hotel owners in Villupuram.

Outlets in Villupuram town functioned as usual for the last four days, despite the halt to sales of commercial cylinders across the country, because most large-scale outlets use both firewood and gas, sources said. "However, the sales of cylinders have dropped from six to seven to two cylinders per hotel per day, and that has impacted the cooking methods," Chandrasekar, the president of the town hotel owners association, Villupuram, told TNIE.

He said the price of cylinders has gone up by ₹500-600 within 10 days between March 4 and 13. What cost ₹1,561 now costs ₹2,220, a nearly 50% rise, and even the number of cylinders sold has dropped from 10 to two.

"The transport cost of the fewer cylinders will be meted out from the extra charge. The stock is also slowly decreasing because we have no new supplies of commercial cylinders from the company. We may not be able to give even one cylinder per outlet from Sunday," said a commercial cylinder distributor attached to Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited. The owner of a popular non-

vegetarian hotel near the Villupuram signal told TNIE, "We generally use firewood for briyani, curries, rice, and other vegetable sides. Gas cylinders are used for making non-vegetarian starters and tiffin items such as dosa and parotta. Now those tiffin items are not made in large quantities, and we have limited the serving period for those items." Meanwhile, LPG distributors

in Villupuram have announced that they would not provide cylinders at the outlet; residents can obtain them only via online booking. Though it takes a day or two to deliver, cylinders will be provided only in that option.

An agent at a distributor outlet in Vandimedu told TNIE, "Two days back, people crowded the outlet in panic, demanding cylinders. We were unable to manage the crowd while also addressing the growing online bookings simultaneously. So, the company has decided to stop the store sale of cylinders until the situation normalises. The online booking is running smoothly, and everyone will receive the (domestic) cylinders."

Moreover, district collector Sheikh Abdul Rahman passed orders to temporarily shut down several fuel bunks that allegedly sold petrol to customers in water cans measuring more than 20 litres. He had also directed bunks not to provide fuel in any external units other than vehicles.

NDA open to new parties; CM wants BJP's word on statehood

THE National Democratic Alliance (NDA) in Puducherry has opened its doors to new parties ahead of the upcoming Assembly elections, even as Chief Minister N Rangasamy insisted that the Centre should assure the grant of statehood to Puducherry as a key promise before the polls.

Union Minister and BJP's high-level observer for Puducherry, Mansukh Mandaviya, held discussions with the CM and senior AINRC leaders on Friday evening regarding seat sharing and alliance strategy. The meeting, held at a private hotel, was attended by BJP Puducherry in-charge Nirmal Kumar Surana and Public Works Minister K Lakshminarayanan. The talks lasted for about half an hour.

Speaking to reporters later, Surana said that the NDA partners – the BJP, AINRC, and AI-ADMK – would contest the upcoming Assembly elections together, just as in the previous

election. Surana added that the alliance remained open to expansion. "The door is open for new parties to join the National Democratic Alliance," he said.

During the discussions, Rangasamy is understood to have reiterated his party's stand that the Centre should announce its commitment to grant statehood to Puducherry ahead of the elections. Statehood has long been a key demand of the NR Congress. Ahead of the seat-sharing talks with the BJP, the CM called for a marathon meeting on Thursday night for poll strategy and insistence on statehood.

Mandaviya is believed to have assured the leaders that the demand for statehood would be conveyed to the BJP's national leadership.

Speaking after the meeting on Friday evening, Rangasamy said the talks were positive and proceeding smoothly. "We have always been in alliance with the BJP and will face the upcoming election together as well. I will share further details after the election date is announced," he said.

Panel submits report to govt for OBC quota in local bodies

THE commission headed by former Madras High Court judge K K Sasidharan, appointed by the Puducherry administration to recommend reservation for Other Backwards Classes (OBCs) in local body elections, submitted its detailed 6,000-page report to the government on Friday. Justice Sasidharan handed over the report to Lieutenant Governor K Kailashnathan and Chief Minister N Rangasamy at a function held at the Marie Puducherry Municipal Building.

The last local body elections in Puducherry were held in 2006, succeeding the 1968 elections. The elected representatives then remained in office until 2011; no elections have been conducted since then.

Speaking on the occasion, CM Rangasamy said that conducting local body elections faced legal challenges, primarily due to the issue of OBC reservation. "In a democratic country, the basic needs of the people are addressed through municipalities and commune panchayats. Therefore, it is essential to hold local body elections in accordance with democratic principles," he said.

The enumeration exercise was carried out at a minimal cost of ₹3.5 lakh by engaging 1,541 Anganwadi workers, Justice Sasidharan said. He noted that the delay in submitting the report was due to the time taken for enumeration and uploading the collected data. The task of identifying wards for reservation for OBCs as well as Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes will be carried out by the State Election Commission, Justice Sasidharan said.

DyCM inaugurates 758 projects, distributes aid worth ₹116 cr in K'kurichi

TAMIL Nadu Deputy Chief Minister Udhayanidhi Stalin on Thursday inaugurated 758 completed development works worth ₹34 crore and laid the foundation stone for 1,740 new projects estimated at ₹81 crore in Kallakurichi. He also distributed government welfare assistance worth ₹116.24 crore to 24,910 beneficiaries. District collector M S Prasanth, Kallakurichi MP D Malaiarasan, Members of the Legislative Assembly D Udayasuriyan, Vasantham K Karthikeyan, and A J Manikannan were present at the event.

Addressing the gathering, Stalin said the state has been implementing welfare schemes with a focus on women, students, and economically weaker sections. He noted that the free bus travel for women has recorded about 920 crore journeys across the state, including nearly 12 crore trips in Kallakurichi.

"The Chief Minister's break-fast scheme currently benefits about 22 lakh school children daily, including nearly 47,000 students in the district. Under the Pudhumai Penn and Tamil Puthalvan schemes, around 27,000 students in Kallakurichi receive a monthly financial assistance of ₹1,000," he said.

Highlighting infrastructure development, he said a SIPCOT industrial park has been established on about 200 acres in Ulundurpet taluk with an investment of about ₹2,000 crore, creating employment opportunities for around 2,000 people. He also noted that road upgradation works have been taken up for ₹560 crore in several key routes in the district.

Stalin stated that 41,000 house site pattas were distributed in the district, and houses are being built under the Kalaignar Kanavu Illam. He also added that welfare measures for tribal communities and self-help groups are being expanded in Kallakurichi.

early on Thursday. As the truck stopped for tea and to pick up a person at Vaniyampalayam bus stop, a heavy-load lorry rammed into the truck from behind.

As many as 19 were severely injured and a 60-year-old work-

er, S Sekar died, police said. The impact propelled the truck into a nearby thatched-roof house, destroying the structure. The accused driver fled the scene, and Valavanur police have initiated an investigation to track him.

'16 seats for AINRC in Pondy NDA'
