opportunities abroad, but instead, victims are trafficked to countries like Myanmar and Cambodia, where they're forced to run cyber scams targeting innocent people worldwide. According to SSP Mohammad Yaseen Kichloo, head of the Cybercrime Investigation Centre for Excellence, it's essential to verify job opportunities thoroughly, especially those promising high salaries or easy work.

Sextortion is a form of exploitation where individuals use coercion, manipulation, or threats to extort sexual favors, images, or videos from others. This can occur online or offline and can have severe emotional and psychological consequences for the victims. In Jammu and Kashmir, cybercriminals are using sophisticated tactics to trick victims into compromising situations. Victims receive random video calls via WhatsApp or Messenger, often from fraudsters posing as nude individuals. These calls are recorded and later used to blackmail the victims with threats of sharing the footage online or with family members.

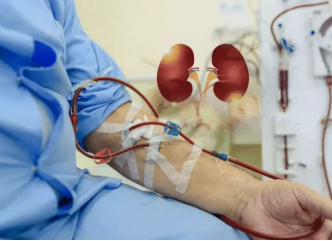

Alcohol-non-veg party in the Bhandara of Ambaji Temple at Girnar

The place where Prasad is prepared for Mataji was desecrated, 11 people including 10 priests were expelled

Junagadh

A video of a liquor-non-veg party taking place in the Bhandara of the Ambaji temple at Girnar has created a stir on social media. In the viral video, two to three people are seen allegedly consuming non-veg and drinking liquor while abusing each other. The video of such a party on the holy ground has spread anger among the devotees. Considering the seriousness of the matter, the administration has suspended 10 priests and a cook of the temple with immediate effect and banned entry into the temple premises.

Action taken after video of desecrating holy place goes viral:

As soon as this serious matter of video of non-veg and liquor being consumed in the storeroom of Mataji's temple went viral, immediate investigation orders were given on the instructions of the Collector and Mamlatdar. As the primary investigation revealed the truth, 11 employees who defiled the dignity of the temple have been suspended with immediate effect. The administration has made it clear that no one who hurts religious sentiments will be spared.

List of suspended priests and staff

The 11 people involved in this scam who have been charged mainly include the priestly class.

Purification and preparation of police complaint

After the incident, a 'purification' has been done as per the scriptural rituals to sanctify the temple premises and especially the dining area under the supervision of the Mamlatdar. SDM Charansinh Gohil said that for a long time, there have been repeated complaints about these illegal activities taking place on Girnar mountain, but some time ago, a video of a mutton and liquor party taking place in the warehouse of the Ambaji temple came to light, due to which 10 priests and a cook associated with the temple have been suspended. All

these people were appointed at the time when the temple was temporarily managed under the Mamlatdar. At present, a thorough investigation has been conducted in this entire matter and strict action will be taken against the culprits based on what comes to light in the future investigation.

History and Background of the Controversy: The Situation After Tansukhgiri Babu's Ascension to the Heavens

The roots of the controversy over the collapsed Ambaji Temple are very deep. For years, this temple was managed by the Gadipati Mahant Tansukhgiri Babu. But after his conversion to Brahminism, a huge controversy arose regarding the administration and inheritance of the temple. In view of the internal factionalism and the struggle for the throne, the administration took over the administration of the temple in order to prevent the situation from worsening. Currently, this temple is functioning under the government administration.

Risk on Mahant post claim: Trouble for Nana Pir and Mota Pir will increase

Recently, the process for the appointment of the permanent Mahant of Ambaji temple was carried out, in which many candidates filed their claims. These candidates also include members of 'Nana Pir' and 'Mota Pir'. However, due to the names of people who have come up in this liquor-mutton party scam or the involvement of staff who have been exposed, a big question mark has been placed on the claim of the Nana Pir and Mota Pir groups. According to sources, the claim for the Mahant post of these parties who have failed to maintain their sanctity may be permanently cancelled.

Security of devotees and new protocols

This incident has also raised questions about the security arrangements of Siddh Kshetra Girnar. Currently, the puja rituals

have been continued by keeping two old priests for the daily service of Mataji. Due to this entire episode, there is great anger among the saints and religious people of Junagadh, and there are demands for strict imprisonment against those responsible.

Alternative arrangements have been made by the administration to maintain the sanctity of the temple.

Junagadh City Mamlatdar A.K. Baraiya said that news of a meat and liquor party being held in the Ambaji temple premises was received through social media. Considering this serious matter, an immediate visit was made to the Ambaji temple as per the instructions of the Junagadh Collector and Provincial Officer. An investigation has been conducted into the entire matter based on the viral video published in the media.

All those found involved in this unholy incident have been expelled from the temple premises with immediate effect and their entry has been completely banned. A total of 11 people have been taken into custody in this incident, including 10 priests and 1 cook.

When the administration of Ambaji temple was taken over by the administration, 11 employees were appointed on a temporary basis to maintain order. All these people, despite receiving salaries from the government administration, have been found involved in this unsightly activity. Currently, the services of all of them have been terminated.

To maintain the sanctity of the temple, alternative arrangements have been made by the administration for worship and a new temporary priest has been appointed. Based on the evidence of the video that went viral on social media, the process of taking legal action against all these culprits as per the government rules is in motion. An FIR should be filed against those responsible for this incident - Dushyantgiri Aparnathi.

After the incident of the collapse of the span of the Subhash Bridge connecting the eastern and western areas of Ahmedabad, the Municipal Corporation had conducted a tender process to demolish the Subhash Bridge and build a new one and widen it. Recently, in the last standing committee of the ruling party BJP, approval was given to build a bridge at a cost of Rs. 235 crore.

Since the Subhash Bridge is to be opened by next January 2027, the work has started. Different tests have started. Different tests have started for the bridge and its demolition near the end towards the Subhash Bridge Collector's Office. First, the work is being done due to the need to do soil testing. Since the structure is to be designed, the measurement of the land has been started. Testing work has started on how deep the new foundations will have to be made and how much load the bridge will have to bear, etc.

Method for structure demolition also prepared - Subhash Bridge is to be demolished and new ones are to be built by demolishing the middle 6 spans. Method for structure demolition has also been prepared. The bridge is years old and is made of balance cantilever lever, so a process has also been done to prepare a method for how to demolish which part.
