

West Asia conflict: Panic buying of LPG cylinders; add-in claims no crisis

Rumours Spread After Wait Time Was Raised

Prayagraj: The govt's decision to raise the minimum wait time for booking a domestic LPG cylinder refill from 21 days to 25 days to prevent hoarding has led to widespread rumours of its shortage, causing panic among consumers. As a result, long queues were witnessed at LPG gas distributors' offices on Tuesday, though the govt assured that there is no shortage, and oil marketing companies are prioritising domestic LPG supply to households.



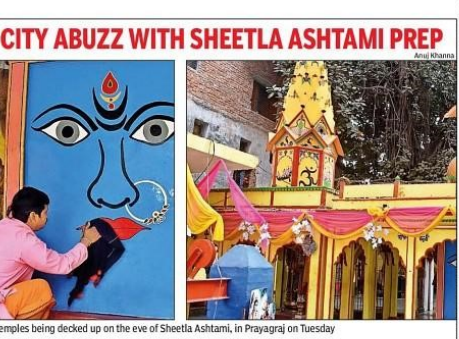

While tapping the US, Algeria, Norway and Canada for LPG supplies, govt on Monday issued fresh orders asking oil refiners to ramp up production of cooking gas for domestic consumers. Prayagraj: A 30-year-old man was arrested on Monday night for faking his son's kidnapping to implicate his estranged wife and her sister.

Police said Kamlesh Bindu Pratapgarh had been living with his wife a few months back, and both started living separately. Since, Kamlesh Bindu Pratapgarh, 50, gave the custody of his 10-year-old boy to his brother-in-law, Bajrangji Singh of Bauchhi Kathana village.

On March 7, the boy's mother and aunt submitted a complaint to the Phulpur police seeking the boy's custody.

Despite repeated persuasion, Bajrangji refused to return the child, leading to a challan being filed against him under section 170 of the BNS.
