N-E woman brutalised by live-in partner in Gurugram, critical

A 19-year-old woman from North-East faced brutality at the hands of her live-in partner. She is in a critical condition and being treated at Safdarjung hospital.

In her statement to Gurugram police, the victim hailing from Tripura has said that he poured sanitiser on her private parts and set it on fire when she sought marital commitment. The accused, Shivam (19), then struck her on the head with a metal bottle, smashed it against household furniture and went on to attack her with a knife, she alleged. ing in Gurugram.

According to her, the violence continued for three consecutive days starting February 19 after an argument over their marriage plans.

The Gurugram police have arrested Shivam, a Delhi resident, and sent him to judicial custody. According to the police, the woman met Shivam through an online dating app in September 2025 and moved in with him months

later in Sector 69, Gurugram. The duo was reportedly discussing marriage prospects late at night when the violence started.

Medical examination has confirmed that the woman suffered multiple severe injuries, the police said. Gurugram DCP (South) Hitesh Yadav said the survivor was first taken to a government hospital in Gurugram in a critical state. She

was later shifted to AIIMS and then Safdarjung Hospital in Delhi for advanced treatment due to the seriousness of her injuries.

The case came to light after the victim's mother alerted the police. "My daughter was shattered and in pain. She pleaded to be rescued. We had no idea about her live-in relationship," said the victim's mother. An FIR has been registered against Shivam under Sections 115(2) (voluntarily causing hurt), 118(1) (causing hurt by dangerous weapons), 127(2) (wrongful confinement), 69 (sexual intercourse by deceitful means or false promise of marriage) and 351(2) (criminal intimidation).

Y'nagar police seize 550 bags of subsidised urea

On Saturday, he reached home at midnight after performing his duty. As his wife went to the kitchen to prepare meal, she heard a bullet sound from an adjacent room. As she went to crosscheck, she found Jasbir lying in a pool of blood.

Later, the police team along with forensic experts reached the spot to collect evidence. No suicide note was found from the spot. DCP (West) Kushal Pal Singh said nothing had come to the fore so far. He added that the body has been kept at mortuary of the civil hospital for the post-mortem examination. — TNS
