months after the military conflict between India and Pakistan. Following the May 7 to 10 conflict, all the three forces were asked to work on the lessons learnt from it. 'Bar Khaira from House proceedings'

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In another post, Khaira said, "I stand by what I said or shared on social media because this Rs 1,000 scheme is nothing but a vote-seeking stunt. If AAP was genuinely serious about implementing their promise, they should have done it in the first budget and not the last..."

In the assembly, four women MLAs of the ruling AAP — Amandeep Kaur Arora, Saravjyoti Kaur Manu, Inderjit Kaur Mann and Jivanjot Kaur — protested in the well of the House, raising slogans and demanding an apology from Khaira.

The resolution, moved by Manuke and endorsed by finance minister Harpal Singh Cheema read: "A post has been put on social media by member of vidhar sabha, Sukhpal Singh Khaira stating: 'How will women who celebrate the 1,000 rupees monthly stipend give birth to warriors (surmay)? This post is a direct insult to women. Furthermore since this decision (the welfare scheme) was taken by this sacred house, this is also an insult to this sacred house. This house strongly condemns insult directed at women, and this sacred house, by Sukhpal Singh Khaira.'

SAD MLA Ganieve Kaur Majithia received support from Congress legislators as she criticised the ruling party over its own remarks about women. She objected to AAP MLAs laughing while she spoke and questioned whether the party would condemn the chief minister's "improper" references to women in speeches. There were heated exchanges between Ganieve and the AAP's women MLAs even after the SAD MLA's mic was switched off. Congress MLA Aruna Chaudhary also accused the govt of disrespecting women, citing incidents where protesting teachers were allegedly manhandled. AAP women MLAs, including Inderjit Kaur Mann, Amandeep Kaur and Jivanjot Kaur, stood up to counter Ganieve's criticism.

so offer an apology in the Vidhan Sabha. She added that Khairat should not be allowed to attend the proceedings of the House until then.

Congress MLAs Tript Rajin, der Singh Bajwa and Aruna Chaudhary, too, urged the govt to wait for Khaira. However, Inderjit Kaur Mann said the remark was clear and did not require any clarification, while Amandeep Kaur said it was shameful for Congress members to defend Khaira.

Earlier, the issue was raised during question hour by Cheema, prompting protests from AAP MLAs and forcing the speaker to adjourn the house for half an hour.

Reading out Khaira's Facebook post, Cheema accused the Congress of insulting women and asked its MLAs whether they would apologise for the remarks.

Speaker Kultar Singh Sandhu later conducted a voice vote on the resolution. When the motion was first put to vote, most Congress MLAs remained silent, prompting minister Aman Arora to demand that the party clearly state its position. The speaker then conducted the vote twice more, ruling that continued silence would be treated as opposition to the motion before declaring it adopted.

During the debate, Bajwa argued that Khaira had not specifically referred to dalit women. Arora countered that the comment insulted all women in the state, prompting the speaker to announce that the wording of the resolution would be amended accordingly.
