Resolution of Pending Cases of Post Matric Scholarship for
SC/BC Students of Higher Education, pertaining to Academic
Years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25**

Taking into consideration of the representations from various quarters, the Department of Higher Education, Government of Haryana has decided to provide a final opportunity to the students of Colleges and Universities, to resolve the pending cases of students who have applied for Scholarship under the Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for Scheduled Castes (PMS-SC) for the academic years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25, applied through the Harchhatravati Portal.

Therefore, all interested students, whose cases are pending due to incomplete documentation and non-verification of credentials/documents, are hereby instructed to visit their accounts in the portal and get the deficiencies rectified immediately. They are also advised to ensure that their Aadhar is seeded with their Bank Account, if not done yet, immediately. The timelines prescribed for rectification of the deficiencies and other verifications at different levels are as below.

The Students and Nodal Officers at all levels (Institutions, Nodal Body Level and HQ Level) must ensure that necessary actions are done within the stipulated timelines. It is strictly notified that after the expiry of these deadlines, the portal will be closed, and no further requests shall be entertained for the above years. However, the intending bidders should make their own independent inquiries regarding the encumbrances, title of properties put on auction and claims / rights / dues / affecting the properties, prior to submitting their bid. The e-auction advertisement does not constitute and will not be deemed to constitute any commitment or any representation of the bank.
