Darjeeling: The long-term lease of Sallabash, once the summer retreat of the Raja of Digapata, which is now in Rajshahi, Bangladesh, by the Gorkhland Territorial Administration (GTA) has ignited a debate over heritage protection and the "privatisation" of the public property in Darjeeling.
Binay Tamang, the former chairman of the board of administrators that ran the GTA, has issued a written statement, saying Sallabash was handed over to a private company in Siliguri on a 66-year lease at an annual fee of ₹1.98 crore.
"Sallabash is a historic site and a public asset of Darjeeling. Handing it over to a private company for 66 years is equivalent to selling the rights of the people for pennies... A 66-year lease is in essence privatisation," said Tamang.
Norden Sherpa, the GTA Sabha member in charge of tourism, did not take calls from the Telegraph to elicit a response to the charges.
Sources in the GTA said a tender had been called for the

lease as an earlier project to develop a hotel management institute had remained incomplete, and the property had been lying in disuse after the palace had been dismantled in 2016.
"The new lessee will develop it into a tourism property with an investment of ₹200 crore. The plot of five acres will belong to the GTA and the property will be transferred to the hill body after the lease period is over," said a source.
Many rue the loss of a heritage structure of Darjeeling.
In his book, *A Concise History of The Darjeeling District Since 1835*, which was published in 1922, E.C. Dosey, a writer and historian, said the building had been set up on land that was once owned by Capt J. Masson, the superintendent of Tukvar tea estate, by the "Digapata Rajah".
The retreat near Jalapahar was earlier called Girtivash, and the name was changed to Sallabash after Independence.
The Late Nayan Subba, who had chronicled various buildings in the Darjeeling hills, had said Raja Pramatha Nath Rai Bahadur had founded Girtivash, whose garden

was laid out by a German floriculturist and horticulturist, Morgenstern. The property had 12 gardeners.
Nobody could say exactly when the building had been constructed. But it is believed that the retreat was built in the last decade of the 19th century.
"Girtivash was a favourite place for the British governors of Bengal... The British army took over the building in 1942. Later on, it was acquired by the government. It also served as a Tibetan school for a while. The palace has lost the historical grandeur of Girtivash," Subba had written.
According to Subba, the colonial building had an attic with miniature gables and a small dome, and an all-weather glazed rotunda with small square windows in classical style. There was a tennis court as well.
"Raja Pramadanath Roy occupied the front suite on the ground floor, which included the library, with its precious screens of velvet and ornate wooden palmets," wrote Subba.
The front suite of the upper storey with the snow view rooms was "for the ran".
"It was beautifully furnished with a curtained brass cot and a chandelier. There was a huge grandfather clock, which indicated the days of the month and the full moon of (Ekadashi). On the ground floor were the drawing room, dining room, *tash khana* (card room) and the billiards room," Subba said.
Despite being in a dilapidated state, Sallabash was still a landmark in Darjeeling and functioned as a guesthouse after Independence. Once the building was taken over by the Darjeeling Gorkha Hill Council in 1988, the office of the hill body's vice-chairman was housed there. The building had been lying vacant till it was razed in 2016.
Bharat Prakash Rai, convener of the Indian National Trust for Art and Cultural Heritage (Darjeeling chapter), said: "How foolish can we be to dismantle such structures in the name of development. Could it not have been repaired? We have lost a piece of history, and that is very sad."
The five-acre plot in which the Sallabash is located is also surrounded by many private guesthouses, along with a pond built by the DGHC.

HC okays Parivartan Yatra of BJP with riders

Calcutta: A single bench of Calcutta High Court on Friday approved the BJP's proposed Parivartan Yatra (Rally for Change), but with a few riders.
Justice Suvera Ghosh said the BJP would have to restrict its rally between March 1 and 6.
"Not more than 1,000 persons will be allowed in the rally at any point at any given time. Rallyists will have to ensure free movement of traffic during the programme," the judge said.
The court said in the order that rallyists would not be allowed to make any unparliamentary and provocative comments. "Peace and harmony should be maintained during the programme," Justice Ghosh said.
Tarunijoti Tiwari, the lawyer for the BJP, said: "The Yatra was supposed to start from February 19. But the party failed to obtain permission from the police in the districts. The rally will start from nine different districts of the state."
Tiwari assured that the rally would start after a public gathering on the court ground

in Cooch Behar. BJP leaders will address nine meetings in different districts.
"Apart from Cooch Behar, rallies will be held on private land in other districts," Tiwari said.
When the judge asked whether the BJP had obtained permission from the district administration to hold the meeting on the court ground in Cooch Behar, Tiwari replied: "The party has already submitted a proper application to the district magistrate."
Appearing for the state, advocate general Kishore Datta opposed the prayer.
"The only purpose of the rally was to create a law and-order problem when various school-level examinations were being held in the state. Free movement of traffic will be disturbed if the rally is allowed to be organised. There are fair chances of the rally trying to disrupt communal harmony," the AG submitted.
While the court gave its go-ahead to the rally, BJP leaders said that the Parivartan Yatra would start from nine localities across Bengal on Sunday and Monday. The rally will cover 250 Assembly segments and reach all its organisation-aided districts before concluding in Calcutta.

The march will culminate at a mega meeting to be addressed by Narendra Modi on the Brigade Parade Ground in Calcutta. The BJP will announce the date of the Brigade rally soon. A source said the meeting was likely to be held on March 15 or 16.
National BJP leaders, including Union home minister Amit Shah and the party's national president Nitin Nabin, will inaugurate the yatras. Nabin will take part in two rallies in North and South Bengal. Shah will lead the march from Raidighi in Mathurapur on March 2.
The first four rallies will begin on March 1 from Cooch Behar, Krishnanagar in Nadia, Kult in West Burdwan, and Garbeta in West Midnapore. The remaining five Yatras will commence on March 2 from Islampur in North Dinajpur, Sandeshkhali in North 24-Parganas, Hasan in Birbhum, Mathurapur in South 24-Parganas, and Ama in Howrah.
Sanik Bhattacharya, the BJP state president, urged people, including Trinamool Congress supporters who had not benefited from power in Bengal, as well as Congress and CPM supporters, to join rallies to bring about a change in the state.

Siliguri: Government officials from India and Bhutan held a secretary-level bilateral meeting in Thimphu on Wednesday to discuss transboundary river management and review the Punatsangchu-I hydroelectric project being implemented in Bhutan in partnership with India.
A source said the Indian delegation was led by V. L. Kanha Rao, secretary of the department of water resources, river development & Ganga rejuvenation — which functions under the Union ministry of Jal Shakti — and comprised officers from the department and

from the state governments of Bengal and Assam.
"On February 25, both sides reviewed the existing mechanisms of cooperation in flood management and forecasting," said a source.
The teams discussed strengthening and modernising the existing hydro-meteorological observation network, improving data-sharing mechanisms and flood forecasts on transborder rivers, enhancing technical exchanges and addressing emerging challenges arising from climate change, such as glacial lake outburst floods (GLOFs), the source said.
Chief minister Mamata Banerjee has said that rivers flowing into districts like Jalpaiguri, Alipurdhar and Cooch Behar from Bhutan cause severe flash floods during the monsoon. She has demanded that the Centre form a joint river commission with Bhutan.
In October 2025, flash floods in the Nagrakata and Banarhat blocks of Jalpaiguri killed several people and caused extensive property damage, displacing hundreds.
