VN Pandey calls for adopting innovative water preservation methods in Itanagar

ITANAGAR, Feb 19: Er. V.N. Pandey, Retd. Superintending Engineer, Drilling, Tube Well & Ground Water, Water Resources department, Arunachal Pradesh, who was in Itanagar from February 9-15, 2026 on Mission Arunachal Pradesh, spoke about two important issues — water security & social security in the border State of Arunachal Pradesh.

He is associated with an think tank organisation - Rashtriya Suraksha Jagaran Manch/Forum For Awareness of National (FANS) - working on national security related issues across 21 states with its 50 chapters across the country including two — one each in Itanagar & Pasighat.

Pandey was accompanied by Dr. AP Rout, IPS & former



Director General of Police (DGP) and also former Chief RTI Commissioner, Assam & Er Vikram Aditya Singh, national General Secy, FANS, New Delhi & conducted a talk with youth/student/faculty members at NERIST, Nirjuli, VKV, Chimpu & DNGC, Itanagar on the theme 'Northeast Border Land: Issues & Challenges with the motto 'No More Pakistan: Hence No More Bangladesh'. The FANS team also discussed the issue with Governor Lt. General KT Parnaik (Retd.) and CM Pema Khandu.

The FANS team assessed the current issues faced by the state in the social sector; threat to Indigenous faith & culture of the state in view of the recent Islamic influx in Hyderabad and in restricted tribal State protected under Article 371H Constitution of India that needs to be protected under Inner Line permit (ILP) system since NEFA.

The team was satisfied with the State government actions taken in this regard by Home Minister Mama Natung, along with CM Pema Khandu and the movement of civil societies like Indigenous Faith & Culture Society of Arunachal Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh Indigenous Youth Organisation (APIO), Indigenous Youth Force Organisation (IYFO).

FANS feels that Arunachal Freedom of Religion Act (AFRA) 1978 should be acted henceforth with con-

sultation of all stakeholders in order to preserve the tribal culture of the state.

Regarding water security in Arunachal where it is very difficult to draw the portable ground water, Pandey feels that the State will face a huge water crisis but it is lucky to have been getting very good annual rainfall which is around 4000 mm and is only second in India after Meghalaya.

"However, Itanagar receives only around 2000 mm so all the stakeholders should aim to save water and use various water conservation methods like Rain Water Harvesting, construction of recharge pit, digging missionary well. This will allow rain water to go subsurface, which prevents huge soil erosion," he said.

Moreover, it is also important to maintain greenery in the area and the preserved water can be used in the lean

period during November to February.

There should be a ban on wastage of water done by car washing stations.

"The government should completely ban unplanned drilling as owners of drilling machines charge huge money and the DTH machine used for drilling of tube wells is not at all suitable for this soil texture/soil formation. The Capital region has very poor in ground water as the soil is loose and thus it gets choked within very few years," Pandey said.
