Super 8 opener abandoned as rain plays spoilsport

COLOMBO: The opening Super 8 clash of the ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2026 was abandoned without a ball being bowled as persistent rain played spoilsport at the R Premadasa Stadium here on Saturday. At 21:07 local time, rain returned to have the final say in the contest, leaving both teams to share one point each in a disappointing start to their Super 8 campaign. The match had already been delayed by light drizzle, which forced covers onto the field shortly before the scheduled start as ground staff worked to keep the playing area dry amid intermittent showers.

Pakistan had earlier won the toss and elected to bat, with skipper Salman Agha backing a spin-heavy strategy to exploit the Colombo surface.

But the steady droplets soon transformed into relentless pouring, forcing the officials to call off the match without a ball being bowled.

Before the skies opened up, Pakistan made one change to their eleven, bringing in Fakhar Zaman in place of Khawaja

Nafay. New Zealand made three changes with skipper Mitchell Santner back after missing the last match against Canada due to a stomach issue and Lockie Ferguson and Ish Sodhi also found a place in the XI. But all those calculations and combinations will have to wait for another day, as Pakistan will now face England here on February 24.

New Zealand will make a light travel to Colombo to face home side Sri Lanka on February 25. The washout has also placed both the Kiwis and Pakistan in a relatively tighter place ahead of their remaining two Super Eights matches. The rain-hit start to the Super 8 stage sets up anticipation for the next set of matches as the cricket carnival continues.

Fans will now turn their attention to today's double-header, with England taking on Sri Lanka at the Pallekele International Stadium, followed by a blockbuster clash between India and South Africa at the Narendra Modi Stadium in Ahmedabad — with the forecast looking more favorable for a full day of action.

FIH Men's Pro League

India go down 0-2 against Spain

HOBART: Indian Men's Hockey Team suffered a 0–2 defeat against Spain in a closely contested encounter on Saturday, with the Spanish side capitalising on their chances while

India were unable to convert promising opportunities despite sustained attacking intent.

Goals from Ignacio Abajo (6') and Ignacio Cobos (36'), one in each half, proved decisive as Spain combined clinical finishing with disciplined defending to secure the win.

India began the match with sharp, quick passing, looking to control possession early, but Spain's counter-attacking approach proved effective. Ignacio Abajo (6') capitalised on one such move, neatly deflecting the ball into the net to hand Spain



an early lead. Unfazed by the setback, India stayed committed to their structure, circulating the ball swiftly through midfield and probing Spain's defence with intent.

The Indian team created multiple promising

openings and nearly found the equaliser towards the end of the quarter when Abhishek fired a powerful strike, only to be denied by an excellent save from Spanish goalkeeper Luis Calzado. The second quarter produced end-to-end

action, with both teams showing attacking intent and creating chances but failing to convert. Spain earned their second penalty corner of the match in the 24th minute, however, Indian goalkeeper Suraj Karkera stood tall to make

a crucial save and prevent Spain from extending their lead.

In the closing minutes of the first half, Spain applied sustained pressure on India's defence, but the Indian side absorbed it well before launching quick counter-attacks of their own, including a promising circle entry that put Spain under pressure. Despite both teams pushing for a goal, neither could find the net, and Spain carried a slender 1–0 advantage into halftime.

Soon after the restart, Suraj Karkera produced a brilliant save as Spain came out aggressively, determined to extend their advantage. Their pressure eventually paid off when Ignacio Cobos (36') struck from close range after finding himself unmarked inside the circle to double Spain's lead.

India, South Africa set for high-voltage clash

AHMEDABAD: The ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2026 Super Eight stage promises one of its most enthralling contests when India face South Africa at the Narendra Modi Stadium today (Sunday). Both teams are unbeaten in the league stages, making this clash crucial not only for points but also for psychological advantage. India enters with confidence from a flawless home record, winning all seven T20Is ever

played at this venue.

The Proteas, however, arrive on a mission of redemption, having won their last three T20Is, proving that no streak is untouchable. The narrative is irresistible - home dominance versus a team in fine form seeking to challenge it under the Ahmedabad lights. India's batting strength has been impressive. Ishan Kishan leads the way with 176 runs, showcasing his ability to dominate from the outset.

Qatar Open : Alcaraz reaches final

DOHA: World No. 1 Carlos Alcaraz advanced to the final of the Qatar Open 2026 after defeating defending champion Andrey Rublev in straight sets in the semi-final.

The Spaniard registered a 7-6(3), 6-4 victory in a closely contested match played under the lights in Doha, converting his sixth match point to seal his place in the title clash, as per the ATP Tour website. With the win, Alcaraz extended his un-

beaten run in 2026 to 11 matches and reached his first final at the Doha ATP 500 event.

"I know what I am able to do every time I step on the court, what I am capable of doing," Alcaraz said. "The way that I am approaching every match, I'm just really proud about it. It's something I am trying to be better at, and it's paying off. I'm proud of myself for getting better and maturing."

Alcaraz was tested

throughout the contest, failing twice to serve out the opening set and surrendering a 3-0 lead in the second before regaining control. He also missed three match points at 5-3 in the second set when Rublev mounted a late comeback, but broke back immediately and eventually secured victory after two hours and two minutes. Reflecting on his approach, he said, "If you want to find a solution to a problem, you should

find it in a calm place. It's something I am working on. When I am playing and getting mad, seeing that I'm not at my best, I just get frustrated. That is not the place you will find solutions. In these matches, I have been really calm, thinking clearly, and being positive."

Alcaraz will face France's Arthur Fils in the final after the latter defeated Czech player Jakub Mensik 6-4, 7-5 in the other semi-final.

Dubai Tennis C'ships

Svitolina outlasts Gauff to reach final

DUBAI: Elina Svitolina defeated Coco Gauff in a hard-fought three-set semifinal to enter the women's singles final of the Dubai Tennis Championships in Dubai.

Svitolina prevailed 6-4, 6-7 (13), 6-4 in a match lasting three hours and three minutes, overcoming a stiff challenge from the American and missing multiple match points along the way, as per the WTA Tennis website.

Despite losing a marathon second-set tie-break 15-13, the Ukrainian held her nerve in the deciding



set to seal victory and reach her third final in Dubai and first since 2018.

"Speechless after that fight," Svitolina said. "I was really trying to put myself out there, and I was playing like there is no tomorrow, just trying to put all the effort in."

NEW DELHI: The Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) has issued notices to six e-commerce entities for allegedly listing and selling prohibited wireless signal jammers and anti-drone equipment in violation of existing laws, an official statement said on Friday. The action was initiated after the CCPA took suo motu cognisance of online listings offering anti-drone systems, drone jammers and GPS jammers without mandatory statutory approvals and disclosures.

These devices interfere with wireless communication and navigation signals and are strictly regulated under the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885 and the Wireless Telegraphy Act, 1933.
