Two killed in separate accidents

TWO persons have died in two separate accidents in the city since Sunday night.

A 32-year-old bike rider died after hitting a concrete mixing machine that was fixed to a goods vehicle on the Byatarayanapura flyover at around 6 am on Monday. The victim, Anil Gowda, 24, hailed from Rajaghatta in Doddaballapura and was working as a writer in RMC Yard. Gowda was going on his way to work from his home. He reportedly lost control of the bike and rammed into the mixer that was going in front. Gowda succumbed while being shifted to the hospital. The Hebbal traffic police have registered a case.

Under the Jnanabharathi traffic police station limits, a 45-year-old autorickshaw driver died after his auto toppled when he applied sudden brakes while trying to avoid hitting a bike rider. The victim, Rajesh, was a resident of Chikkabasthi.

At 8 pm on Sunday, Rajesh and his friend Devaraju were riding in the auto. While nearing Doddabasti on Vishweshwaraiiah Layout 100 Ft Road, a bike rider suddenly came in front of the auto. Rajesh, while trying to avoid hitting the two-wheeler, applied the brakes suddenly, and in the impact, the auto toppled. Rajesh, who sustained severe head injuries, was rushed to a nearby hospital, where he succumbed at 10 pm.

Evasion of notice, probe grounds for arrest: HC

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THE Karnataka High Court has said that an accused can be arrested if he evades the notice issued to him under Section 35(3) of BNSS and does not co-operate with the officers investigating his crime.

Justice M Nagaprasanna passed this order on March 25, rejecting a petition filed by Yugadev R from Cuddalore in Tamil Nadu, questioning the arrest order issued on January 19 by the additional chief judicial magistrate in a crime registered under Section 66C of the IT Act and Section 318(4) of BNS with Adugodi police in the city. Citing a verdict of the apex court, the high court said that Section 35(3) does not empower the police to communicate an electronic copy or by WhatsApp the notice or copy of FIR. It has to be mandatorily given in person. The police searched the petitioner for 40 days to hand over the notice. This non-cooperative behaviour of the accused was enough for the police to take him into custody. Three persons, including Anki Bhauwala from Wilson Garden in the city, registered a complaint against the petitioner and his wife.

The petitioner and his wife introduced themselves as yoga teachers and started running a company, Jai Bhairavi Devi Financial Solutions, and received

investments through a website. The complainants are said to have invested Rs 39.20 lakh. The complaint was registered in December 2025 for criminal breach of trust, misappropriation and causing wrongful loss.

The police wanted to serve the notice under Section 35(3) and began looking for the petitioner, who dodged them for more than 40 days. They found him in Cuddalore and served the notice. As he refused to cooperate, he was taken into custody on January 17. An arrest intimidation was issued to his relatives and he was produced before the local magistrate. The advocate for the accused challenged his arrest, contending that it was illegal.

Later, he was produced before the jurisdictional magistrate court in the city, which passed the arrest order. Challenging this order, the petitioner's counsel submitted that the police have failed to digitally or physically serve the notice under Section 35(3) to his client. This violated the guidelines issued by the apex court.

Refuting it, additional state public prosecutor BN Jagadeesha contended that the police tried to serve the notice several times and made efforts to contact him for more than 40 days. Finally, the police found him in Cuddalore, where he refused to accept the notice. Therefore, he was arrested, Jagadeesha said, furnishing call records and geo-location of the petitioner.

5 women blackmail bizman, extort ₹25L

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A 52-year-old man was extorted of Rs 25 lakh by a gang of five women. The victim, N Suresh (name changed) a resident of Aghahara Badavane in Ramana-gara visited his theatre on the pretext of watching a movie. She introduced herself and said she wanted to marry him, surprising Suresh who said he was not interested. After this, she visited him with two other women from Kothipura. Subsequently, all the women, on one pretext or another, threatened him and extorted money and gold ornaments from him.

Initially, these accused are alleged to have extorted small amounts, and later demanded large sums. Whenever he re-

In his complaint, Suresh said that around six to seven months ago, one of the accused residing near Kothipura in Ramana-gara visited his theatre on the pretext of watching a movie. She introduced herself and said she wanted to marry him, surprising Suresh who said he was not interested. After this, she visited him with two other women from Kothipura. Subsequently, all the women, on one pretext or another, threatened him and extorted money and gold ornaments from him.

Initially, these accused are alleged to have extorted small amounts, and later demanded large sums. Whenever he re-

fused to pay, they threatened to file false cases of gang rape and POCSO against him and send him to jail. The women also took 500 grams of gold ornaments from him. The repeatedly blackmailed him, forcing him to purchase online groceries and daily essentials by sending requests through WhatsApp from different mobile numbers. The complainant, who has a kidney ailment, was admitted as an inpatient for 15 days at a hospital in Bengaluru.

A case of extortion (BNS 308) along with other sections of BNS was registered by the Ijloor police against the five women. "The case is under investigation and notices have been served to the accused," said an officer.

Top GST officer caught red-handed for graft

The senior commercial tax officer was caught red-handed by the Lokayukta police while accepting a bribe of Rs 6 lakh from a businessman to adjudicate an inspection report on evasion of Rs 60 lakh tax, in Bengaluru on Monday. According to an official statement, Bharath Kumar Hegde (48), who serves as Deputy Commissioner of Commercial Tax in Hubballi, had allegedly demanded Rs 10 lakh from B'loru-based Vishwajit Nayak, but finally settled for Rs 6 lakh. Nayak then lodged a complaint with the Lokayukta police who laid a trap and caught the officer. **ENS**

Traffic cops switch off body cams, collect bribe

Three traffic policemen attached to the High Grounds traffic police station have been suspended for illegally stopping vehicles and collecting money after switching off their body cameras. West Division DCP (Traffic) Anoop A Shetty suspended Assistant Sub-Inspector Suresh, constables Prashant and Sadik on Monday. The department had conducted an internal investigation after receiving numerous complaints from the public that the trio would stop vehicles around Chalukya Circle even though there were no visible violations and illegally collect bribes. There are strict orders for traffic policemen not to stop vehicles only to check documents. Sadik was earlier suspended for dereliction of duty while serving in Vijayanagar traffic police station. **ENS**
