faces FIR for

Hisar: The Sirsa police have registered an FIR against a gas agency for allegedly overcharging a consumer by levying home delivery charges despite the customer collecting the LPG cylinder directly from the warehouse.

The case was filed following a complaint by the district food, civil supplies and consumer affairs department, which termed the act illegal overcharging.

According to officials, a complaint was received on March 31 regarding excess billing at the agency. A departmental team subsequently conducted an inspection.

During the inspection, it was found that an employee of Bhupendra gas agency in Sirsa charged Rs 943 (home delivery rate) for a cylinder collected directly from the warehouse by Sukhdev Singh of Kirarkot village. The standard warehouse rate is Rs 907.

Pen drive ‘missing’ from court records, HC CJ orders probe

Cong Candidate Had Filed Plea Against Election Of Palwal MLA

Chandigarh: The Chief Justice of Punjab and Haryana high court has ordered a probe into the disappearance of a pen drive containing election-related videos pertaining to a petition filed by Congress’s Karan Singh Dalal challenging the election of Haryana minister Gaurav Gautam as MLA from Palwal in 2024.

The pen drive allegedly disappeared from high court records. Information regarding the inquiry was provided before the bench of Justice Archana Puri on March 27. The court was informed that the inquiry officer posted in HC was probing the loss of the pen drive after receiving orders from the Chi-

ef Justice and that the inquiry is still pending. The next hearing is on April 30.

Gautam, contesting as a BJP candidate, won the 2024 Haryana assembly elections by defeating Congress’s Dalal by 33,605 votes. Dalal challenged his election in HC, alleging that Gautam had indulged in corrupt practices including appealing for votes in the name of religion,

misuse of religious events during the campaign period, and exerting undue influence on voters. He provided some material, including a pen drive, along with his petition to substantiate his allegations and sought Gautam’s disqualification for six years. As the matter was pending before HC, the high court registry informed Dalal that the pen drive that was part of the court records could not be traced. Dalal then submitted a formal complaint before the registrar.

As per the complaint, the pen drive contained videos relating to the election and constituted the primary electronic evidence in the election petition.

Gatam also filed an application before HC, seeking re-

jection of Dalal’s petition on the grounds that it lacked material facts required under Section 83 of Representation of the People Act. It also argued that ‘vague’ allegations were “vague”, particularly those involving use of ‘Sanatan’ and ‘Hindutva’, arguing that use of words associated with religion could not constitute corrupt practices without specific factual details. However, in its detailed order dated Nov 28, 2025, HC dismissed Gautam’s plea, holding that the allegations of corrupt practices under Representation of the People Act warrant a full trial. HC also held that Dalal’s petition contains sufficient material facts and cannot be thrown out for lack of cause of action.

Fatehabad youth killed in Russia-Ukraine war cremated

Hisar: The body of Ankit Jangra (24), a resident of Kumhariya village in Fatehabad district who was allegedly trapped in the Russia-Ukraine war, was cremated at his native village on Saturday. Ankit was among two youths from the village who had travelled to Russia and were reportedly drawn into the conflict.

According to family members, Ankit had sent a voice message to his brother via Telegram in Sept 2025, saying he was being taken to the battlefield and would not be able to remain in touch. His WhatsApp account was deleted shortly before that message.

Raghuvir Jangra, Ankit’s elder brother, said the family was informed on Friday about the repatriation of the body. “We reached Delhi on Saturday morning. The last rites were performed in the village later in the day,” he said. The family is still awaiting information about the second youth, Vijay Poonia, who had accompanied Ankit to Russia.

Raghuvir alleged that Ankit initially went to Moscow to enrol in a Russian language course and later took up work at a fast-food outlet. He claimed Vijay was lured by a woman who promised him a job as a security guard with a salary of Rs 2.5 lakh per month. The youths were allegedly made to sign documents in Russian and discouraged from translating them. They were later given brief weapon training

and forced into military roles, the family alleged.

The family said it repeatedly sought help from authorities, approaching the Russian embassy in Delhi and Chandigarh, besides writing to the ministries of external affairs and defence. Political leaders, including Sirsa MP Kumari Selja and Rohtak MP Deepender Hooda, also wrote to external affairs minister S Jaishankar seeking intervention.

Ankit had reportedly taken a loan of Rs 4.75 lakh by mortgaging his house to travel abroad. The family has no agricultural land and survives on daily wage labour, with Ankit’s father working as a mason. Ankit had earlier been employed with a transport company in Behror, Rajasthan. The family maintained that he fell victim to a job scam and was subsequently forced into the conflict.

Sonipat man dies while chopping tree in Netherlands

Sonipat: A 21-year-old man from Mai Majri village in Sonipat district, Sagar Rana, died in a tragic accident in



The Netherlands, plunging his impoverished family into grief and a financial crisis as they struggle to bring his body back to India.

According to family members, Sagar had travelled to France on a tourist visa on Nov 26, 2024, hoping to find work abroad. After failing to secure employment there, he moved to the Netherlands on the advice of a friend who assured him of a job. After finding work in the Netherlands, Sagar reportedly accompanied a friend to cut a tree. As the friend was unfamiliar with the task, Sagar climbed the tree himself.

Though he managed to cut it, he slipped while climbing down and fell, hitting his head on a stone. The impact caused serious head injuries. He was rushed to a hospital, where he remained admitted from March 21 to March 30. Doctors conducted two surgeries to save him, but Sagar succumbed to his injuries.

RTI activist held for extorting ₹1L from trader

Hisar: The police on Friday night arrested an RTI activist for allegedly extorting Rs 1 lakh from a shopkeeper by threatening to get his under-construction building sealed through a complaint to the Hisar municipal corporation.

The accused, identified as Manoj Sindhwani of Dev Vatika in Hisar, was caught red-handed during a trap laid by the city police. A case has been registered against him based on a complaint filed by Deepanshu.

According to the complaint, Deepanshu was constructing a building near Sector 14 in the city when the accused allegedly began demanding money, threatening to file an RTI and a com-

plaint to have the structure sealed if payment was not made. The shopkeeper later approached the superintendent of police, Hisar, following which the city police were directed to take action. Acting on the complaint, a trap was laid, and the accused was apprehended while allegedly accepting the money. The police said they were probing the accused’s links to ascertain whether others were involved and if the extorted amount was to be shared.

The investigation will also examine the role of any other individuals allegedly involved in similar activities within the MC.

The officials added that the accused had faced similar allegations in the past also.

Woman sets 2 sisters-in-law on fire in Fbd

Gurgaon: Two sisters were left critically injured after being set on fire by their sister-in-law in Faridabad’s Dabua Colony on Friday, following a family dispute, police said. The incident occurred around 5pm when the sisters, Meena and Seema, were standing on the rooftop of their house and talking. According to police, the accused, identified as Pinky, who lives in a separate house, arrived carrying petrol. She poured it on both women and set them ablaze using a matchstick.

As the flames engulfed them, the sisters ran downstairs screaming for help. Neighbours rushed to the spot after hearing the commotion, and took the injured to a hospital. TNN

State health min Rao inspects OPD services at PGIMS Rohtak

Chandigarh: Haryana health minister Aarti Singh Rao conducted a surprise inspection of the Chaudhary Ranbir Singh OPD at the PGIMS Rohtak Saturday afternoon.



She first inspected the CT scan and MRI machine rooms of the Health Map, operating under the PPP mode. The minister issued strict orders that patients should be provided their MRI and CT scan reports within 1 day instead of 3 or 4 days so that treatment could begin as soon as possible. She emphasised that doctors treat patients based on reports and, therefore, reports play a crucial role in treatment.

Aarti Singh also visited the X-ray department, reviewed its functioning, and expressed satisfaction over the promptness with which X-rays were being conducted for patients. She then inspected the OPD of the orthopaedics department. The minister expressed displeasure at the crowd gathered for providing blood samples in room number 75, and directed the officials to ensure prompt

treatment for patients so that they did not have to stand in long queues.

She said wherever additional lab technicians and data entry operators were available, they should be deployed in the OPD so that patient samples could be collected quickly.

The minister also inspected the toilets, and upon finding a lack of cleanliness, strict instructions were issued to the officials that the toilets should be cleaned three times during the OPD hours.

Later, Aarti Singh interacted with patients and inquired about the treatment being provided at the PGIMS. One patient reported that many medicines were not being made available to them. PGI officials informed that currently 200 types of medicines are available at the institute.

On this, the minister directed the formation of a committee to look into why only 200 types of medicines were being procured and provided to patients when the govt is making more than 500 types of medicines available. Thereafter, Aarti Singh inspected the OPDs of the gynaecology department, super speciality department, and surgery department.

State approves action plan to strengthen fight against AIDS

Chandigarh: The 23rd executive committee meeting of the Haryana State AIDS Control Society (HSACS), chaired by additional chief secretary, health & family welfare, Sumita Misra, on Saturday, resolved on accelerating Haryana’s fight against HIV/AIDS and strengthening public health infrastructure. The committee approved a proposed annual action plan for 2026-27 with a total outlay of over Rs 47.16 crore. Key allocations include Rs 16.45 crore for targeted interventions and link worker scheme; Rs 10.90 crore for ICTC/BSO services; Rs 6.22 crore for institutional strengthening; Rs 4.68 crore

for care, support and treatment; Rs 3.75 crore for IEC activities; and Rs 1.52 crore for STI services.

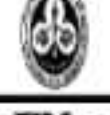
The committee noted that a second HIV Viral Load Laboratory was approved and would be made functional at Panchkula within one month. At present, one Viral Load Lab at PGIMS Rohtak serves 17 districts, while five additional districts are linked to IHBAS, New Delhi.

Among the decisions taken, the committee approved

ved a proposal for simultaneous HIV and syphilis testing of spouses of all antenatal care (ANC) women.

As per NACO’s revised ANC estimation, the screening target in Haryana for the FY 2025-26 stands at 5,95,880. Under the proposal, around 12,00,000 dual HIV/syphilis tests would be required annually to cover pregnant women and their spouses, with efforts aimed at ensuring the Elimination of Vertical Transmission of HIV and Syphilis (EVTHS) to nearly zero.

The committee also approved a proposal to develop a secure web-based platform for voice messages, SMS alerts, and follow-up reminders to all the PLHIVs.

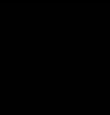
