

Railway staff help pregnant woman deliver safely on train

On April 5, a pregnant lady and her family, hailing from Dhanbad, was travelling from Chennai to Dhanbad in B1

Coach of Train No. 13352 (Alapuzha-Dhanbad Express) experienced labour pains shortly after the train passed Annavaram station. Her family members immediately approached the on-duty Ticket Checking staff for assistance.

Responding swiftly to the situation, G Jyothi, TTI/Amenities/Vijayawada, took charge and extended all possible assistance to ensure a safe delivery onboard the train. She promptly coordinated with the



Commercial Controller and arranged medical assistance through 108 service.

Understanding the urgency of the situation, the train was given a special halt at Elamanchili station.

With the coordinated efforts of the on-duty Ticket Checking staff, the mother and the newborn baby girl were safely shifted to Government Hospital, Elamanchili, by 108 ambulance. Both the mother and the baby are reported to be safe

Govt receives addl 1.9L HPV vaccine for teenage girls

THE AP government has received an additional consignment of 1.90 lakh doses of the HPV vaccine from the Centre, aimed at protecting adolescent girls aged 14-15 from cervical cancer.

Health Minister Y Sathya Kumar Yadav announced that this fresh supply follows the earlier batch of 1.90 lakh doses dispatched last month, bringing the total number of doses received by the state to 3.81 lakh.

According to official data, there are 3.45 lakh eligible girls across the state. So far, 1.14 lakh (33.19%) have been vaccinated.

District-wise distribution shows the coverage in Kurnool (6,785), Nellore (6,726), Kadapa (6,725), and Anantapur (6,655), while lower numbers were recorded in Polavaram (669), ASR (1,063), Sri Sathya Sai (2,769), and Anakapalle (2,959). Authorities are ensuring that vaccines are allocated in proportion to number of girls.

Vaccination is being carried out at 1,645 primary and urban health centres equipped with cold-chain facilities. After receiving the shot, girls are monitored for 30 minutes to ensure safety, and officials confirmed that no adverse reactions have been reported so far.

The pace of vaccination is expected to increase, and the drive will continue uninterrupted. In line with the directives of central government, AP has emerged as one of the leading states in implementing the vaccination programme.

2 Maharashtra men held for temple theft

ORVAKAL police arrested two accused from Maharashtra and recovered 4 kg of stolen silver in the Kalvabugga Bugga Ramaswara Temple theft case.

Kurnool district SP Vikrantatil said the accused, Arjun Poonam Kumbhar from Pune and Akshay Jaisingh Thakur from Chinchwad, were involved in the theft. He said the theft occurred on the night of March 16, 2026, under Crime No. 46/2026 of Orvakal Station.

A five-member gang allegedly stole nearly 10 kg of silver ornaments. The SP said special teams under the supervision of DSP J Babu Prasad used CCTV footage from toll gates and other technical evidence to trace the accused. Police also seized tools used in the crime and a vehicle.

Police are making efforts to arrest the remaining three accused and recover the rest of the stolen property, he added.

96 new courts to come up in AP to reduce pendency

12 courts in Dist & Sessions cadre, 25 in Civil Judge cadre on anvil

THE State government on Monday issued a Government Order (GO) sanctioning the establishment of 96 additional courts across the State, in a significant move aimed at strengthening the judicial infrastructure and reducing case pendency.

According to the GO, the newly sanctioned courts include 12 in the District and Sessions Court cadre, 25 courts in the cadre of Civil Judge (Senior Division), and 59 courts in the Junior Civil Judge category. The decision is expected to enhance access to justice, particularly in districts facing a heavy backlog of cases.

Along with the establishment of these courts, the govern-

ment has also approved the creation of 1,730 new posts.

These positions will range from judicial officers to administrative and supporting staff, including office subordinates. The move is seen as a comprehensive effort not only to expand the number of courts but also to ensure that they are adequately staffed for efficient functioning.

Legal experts believe that the addition of these courts will help expedite the disposal of both civil and criminal cases, thereby reducing delays that have long affected litigants.

The increase in judicial capacity is also expected to ease the burden on existing courts, many of which are currently handling a high volume of pending cases.

With the addition of new courts, the strength of district judges will be increased from 176 to 182, civil judge (senior division) from 138 to 163 and civil judge (junior division) from 329 to 388.

The initiative reflects the State government's focus on improving the justice delivery system and addressing infrastructural gaps in the judiciary.

Once operational, the new courts are likely to play a key role in ensuring timely hearings and quicker resolution of disputes across the State.

Officials indicated that necessary steps for the establishment of these courts, including infrastructure development and recruitment processes, will be taken up on priority to ensure early implementation of the GO.

APSDMA warns of rain, heatwave across State

THE Andhra Pradesh State Disaster Management Authority (APSDMA) has cautioned that varied weather conditions will persist across the State for the next two days. Managing Director Prakhara Jain said that while many districts will see cloudy skies, thunderstorms and rainfall, others may experience intense heat.

A surface circulation remains active over the southwest Bay of Bengal, with a trough stretching from Rayalaseema and Tamil Nadu up to the Gulf of Mannar, influencing the current weather system.

On Tuesday, light to moderate rain accompanied by lightning is expected in parts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, ASR, Polavaram, Vizag, Anakapalle, Kakinada, Konaseema, Godavari districts. Isolated showers with thunder are likely in Elu-

ru, Krishna, NTR, Guntur, Bapatla, Chittoor and Tirupati.

Heavy rainfall was recorded on Monday evening in several areas: 57.5 mm in Lakshimpur (East Godavari), 52.5 mm in Etcherla (Srikakulam), 52.5 mm in Ramachandrapuram (Konaseema), 47.5 mm in Tadwai (Eluru) and 40.5 mm in Nidadavolu (East Godavari). It warned of hailstorms on Wednesday in parts of Nellore, including Manubolu, Chilakuru and Gudur mandals, as well as in Tirupati district.

Meanwhile, heatwave conditions reported in several districts. On Monday, maximum temperatures reached 42°C in Terannapalli (Anantapur), 41.9°C in Rajupalem (Kadapa), 40.7°C in Nandana Marella (Markapuram), 40.6°C in Perusomala (Nandyal), 40.3°C in Varikuntapadu (Nellore), 40.1°C in Gopidinne (Annamayya) and 40°C in Tovi (Kurnool).
