

Denied admission, woman gives birth outside Shamli dist hosp gate

Staff Demanded Money For Admission: Kin

Shamli: In an alleged case of medical negligence at the district combined hospital in Shamli, a 30-year-old woman from Baghpat district gave birth to a baby boy on the roadside outside the hospital gate after staff allegedly demanded money and refused to admit her to the facility.

Kaushar Begum, a resi-

dent of Asara village, was brought to the hospital late Thursday evening after experiencing labour pains. She was first taken to Kandhla CHC, from where doctors referred her to district hospital.

Her husband, Mohd Usman, as daily-wage labourer, said the hospital staff declined to admit her, claiming that delivery would only be possible through surgery and that her delivery date was not yet due. The family alleged that the staff demanded money for admission.

As they left the premises, Kaushar went into active la-

bour and delivered her child on the road outside the main gate around 9pm. Local women present there arranged sheets to provide privacy during the delivery.

The incident sparked outrage, with family members protesting outside the premises, accusing staff of negligence and bribery. They informed relatives in nearby Lilam village, after which members of Bharatiya Kisan Union (BKU) reached the spot and recorded videos, highlighting the hospital's alleged apathy.

Chief medical superintendent, Dr Kishor Ahuja, descri-

bed the matter as "serious" and said a team has been constituted to investigate why the woman was denied admission.

CMO Dr Anil Kumar added that an inquiry into the entire incident is underway and a report will be sent to senior officials. The woman and her newborn were later admitted to the hospital, where they are said to be stable.

Meanwhile, on Friday, farmer leaders and khap panchayat representatives protested at the office of the CMO. Protesters submitted a memorandum demanding strict action in the case.

Lko North tops deletions amid highest voter purge in district

Over 9.14 Lakh Names Struck Off In State Capital As On Fri

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Gender ratio varied sharply across constituencies

Lucknow: Deleted voters dominated the final electoral roll revision in Lucknow district, with over 9.14 lakh names struck off, accounting for 22.89% — the highest in the state — of the electorate as on April 10.

Lucknow district has a total population of around 60.4 lakh, of which 30.8 lakh are registered voters. Among them, 16.13 lakh voters are male while 14.67 lakh are female, reflecting a gender ratio of 910, marginally better than Uttar Pradesh's overall gender ratio of 834.

Constituency-wise data shows Lucknow North recorded the highest number of deleted voters at 1.54 lakh, followed by Lucknow East with 1.43 lakh and Sarojini Nagar with 1.42 lakh deletions.

In percentage terms, Lucknow Cantt saw the maximum deletion rate at 34.18%, while Lucknow East and North recorded deletions of over 31% each. In contrast, Malihabad reported the lowest deletion at 10.34%. Sarojini Nagar, despite being the largest constituency with 4.6 lakh voters, had a comparatively lower deletion of 23.6%.

29.6L voters listed in Agra, 6.3L removed

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The revision exercise was completed after 166 days of extensive fieldwork

Agra: The district administration Friday published the final electoral rolls for all Assembly constituencies in Agra after completing the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) 2026 exercise, with over 29.6 lakh voters listed and more than six lakh names removed. DM Aravind Mallappa Bangari released the final voter list at the Collectorate auditorium in the presence of representatives from various political parties.

Officials said the electoral rolls will be available for public inspection free of cost at all polling stations from April 10 to April 17. Copies have also been made available at the offices of electoral registration officers (EROs), Assistant EROs, and the district election office. The district now has a total of 29.6 lakh registered voters, including 16.2 lakh male voters, 13.4 lakh female voters, and 82 third gender voters. Sources told TOI that 6.3 lakh names were removed from the rolls following the revision exercise.

Providing a constituency-wise break-up, the DM said Etmadpur (06) has 4.2 lakh voters, Agra Cantonment (SC) (87) has 3.3 lakh, Agra South (88) has 2.7 lakh, Agra North (89) has 3.3 lakh, Agra Rural (SC) (90) has 3.7 lakh, Fatehpur Sikri (91) has 3.3 lakh, Kheragarh (92) has 3 lakh, Fatehabad (93) has 2.9 lakh, and

Bah (94) has 2.9 lakh voters.

Additional DM (city) and deputy district election officer Yamunadhar Chauhan said Booth Level Officers (BLOs) will remain present at their respective stations for a week to facilitate public verification. "If a voter's name is missing, they can apply for inclusion by submitting Form 6 either offline or through the Election Commission's online portal," Chauhan said. He added that under the Representation of the People Act, 1950, voters can file a first appeal within 15 days of publication of the rolls with the district election officer, and a second appeal can be made to the chief electoral officer within 30 days of the decision.

Bangari said the revision exercise, which began on Oct 27 last year, was completed after 166 days of extensive fieldwork. "Over 3,900 BLOs, 394 supervisors, 238 assistant EROs, and nine EROs participated, along with over 13,000 booth-level agents from political parties," he said.

The CEO said the overall voter-deletion rate of 13.2% in India's most populous state was still lower than Gujarat's 13.4%. Among the states and Union territories where voter rolls were revised, Chhattisgarh is third with a deletion rate of 11.7%, followed by Tamil Nadu with 11.5%, Goa 10.7%, Puducherry 7.5%, Madhya Pradesh 5.9%, Rajasthan 5.7% and Kerala 3.2%.

fore the CEO. If that also doesn't resolve the issue, one can still register as a new voter by filling in Form 6."

The SIR exercise started on Oct 27 last year with a voter list containing over 15.4 crore names. Between Jan 6 and April 10, over 8.1 lakh names were

deleted, almost 60% of these either for not responding to notices for hearings or for shifting elsewhere.

Rinwa said 3.2 crore notices were served and that not a single name was deleted from the rolls without adhering to the stipulated process. "If a name present in the draft rolls is missing from the final list, it is either due to discrepancies in Form 6 or a decision taken by a designated electoral registration officer after due process," he said.

Male voters in the final rolls account for 54.5% of the electorate and women 45.4%. A little over 17.6 lakh voters are in the age group 18 to 19.
