

1st supplementary Bengal list leads to large-scale disenfranchisement

Draft rolls in Dec excluded 58 lakh “absent, shifted, dead or duplicate” voters. Final rolls published on Feb 28 dropped another 5.5 lakh voters and placed 60 lakh under adjudication, bringing the count down to 6.4 crore.

“Judicial officers had disposed of about 29 lakh cases till Monday but we received only 10 lakh names with digital signatures. These are part of the first supplementary list,” the EC official said. EC is scheduled to release the second and third supplementary lists on March 27 and April 3. “HC will send names with e-signatures post-5pm on March 27. Thereafter, 4-6 hours are required to publish the list,” the official added.

EC wrote to the HC on Wednesday, requesting that it be allowed to add names to the supplementary list daily. “We have been informed that it will be considered after March 27,” the official said.

The release of the first supplementary list triggered chaos, with the EC website showing all voters on the final list as being “under adjudication” or “deleted” for a few hours on Tuesday night.

RG Kar victim mom among BJP picks, vows women safety fight

Reflects Public Anger, Says BJP; Double-Talk: TMC

Kolkata: BJP named the mother of the 31-year-old resident doctor raped and murdered at RG Kar Medical College and Hospital in 2024 as a candidate from her home constituency in its third list released Wednesday for the April 23 and 29 assembly polls.

The list carries 19 names, including ex-NSG commando Dipanjan Chakraborty, taking BJP’s total to 275 candidates, with 19 seats undecided.

The victim’s mother said she entered politics to pursue justice and systemic reform. “A long time has passed since my daughter’s murder... we’re yet to get justice. I chose a political platform to fight through electoral process,” she said, pledging to push for women’s safety and to root out corruption in govt hospitals.

Her husband said campaigning would begin Thursday.

day. “We are receiving overwhelming support. Our victory is almost certain. But this is not just about politics, it is about protecting public interest and preventing another RG Kar-like crime,” he said.

The decision triggered criticism from activists linked to the “Reclaim the Night” movement that coalesced after the killing. “I am unimaginably hurt that they joined a party which garlands rapists and upholds patriarchy, as a response to what happened in Aug 2024. Bilkis Bano, Kathua, Unnao... it’s heartbreaking to keep count,” said Rimjhim Sinha, a leading member of the movement. Satabdi Das

of “Reclaim the Night United” said the candidacy “won’t bring justice to any victim, including her daughter”.

State BJP chief Samik Bhattacharya said the nomination reflects public anger over lawlessness and the party’s outreach to “a cross section of society”.

He said the victim’s mother approached BJP. “She wanted to protest the lawlessness in the state and needed a chance to do so. She realised BJP is the only force that can dislodge this govt. We admired her fighting spirit and decided to nominate her,” he added. Trinamool questioned the move, calling it “doubles-

Poll duty for 48 docs of WB hosp triggers protest

Kolkata: EC has requisitioned 48 doctors for poll duty at Prafulla Chandra Sen Govt Medical College and Hospital in Arambag, Bengal, triggering howls of protests from the medical community. These doctors will be neither wearing stethoscopes nor the doctor’s white coat this election, reports **Sumati Yengkhom**.

The doctors on the EC list are all senior faculty members. Fourteen non-medical staff members, too, have been requisitioned for poll duty. “Patient care services will be crippled if 48 doctors stay away from the hospital at the same time. Students will suffer, too, as we are all teachers,” said a faculty member at the college.

All doctors have been designated as presiding officers. They’ve applied for exemption following a discussion with principal. “Thavespoken to the DM (also the district election officer) on this issue. There seems to have been communication gap leading to this situation. We have been assured that doctors will be exempted from poll duty,” the principal said. CEO Manoj Aggarwal said, “District election officer has the power to exempt anyone from election duty. This (medical service) is an emergency duty. They can all be exempted.”

Modi remains world’s most popular leader, says study by US firm

New Delhi: Prime Minister Narendra Modi has once again topped global popularity charts, securing 68% approval rating in the latest Morning Consult survey, reaffirming his position as the world’s most popular democratic leader.

The US-based data analytics firm said 26% of respondents disapproved of Modi’s leadership, while 6% remained undecided. The ratings are based on a trailing seven-day simple moving average of public opinion among adults in each country surveyed.

Modi continued to lead by a clear margin over his global peers. Switzerland’s Guy Parmelin followed with 62% approval rating, while South Korean President Lee Jae-myung ranked third with a similar approval level but higher disapproval.

Canadian PM Mark Carney was placed seventh with 55% approval. At the other end, French President Emmanuel Macron recorded the lowest rating, with 17% approval and 75% disapproval.

The figures mark a dip from last year for Modi, when he had recorded 75% approval rating in the same tracker. Earlier this year, Modi became the first global leader to

He blended Bengali folk Baul with kirtan, creating a distinct musical tradition. Influenced by Tantra, he spent hours in meditation and later became court poet of Raja Krishnachandra of Nadia.

Over the past year, BJP has moved from “Jai Shree Ram” to invocations of Kali and Durga, with Modi’s speeches now opening with “Joy Ma Kali.”
