Migrant exodus cripples sanitation, slows deliveries, hits households

As election activity intensifies in West Bengal and Assam ahead of the Assembly polls, Gurugram and neighbouring Faridabad are grappling with a severe labour shortage triggered by a large-scale return of migrant workers to their home states.

The exodus has disrupted essential services, with door-to-door waste collection — the backbone of urban sanitation — being the worst hit. Over the past few days, waste management contractors have issued advisories to Residents’ Welfare Associations (RWAs) and ward councillors about a slowdown in services.

“Due to a shortage of labour because of the elections in Assam and Bengal, waste collection will be slow for the next 5-6 days. We will send the vehicles, but there will be no labour. We request residents to step out and dump their waste directly into the vehicle,” read a message from a local sanitation contractor.



Gurugram and Faridabad together have around 2.5 to 3 lakh workers from West Bengal and Assam.

The situation has once again exposed the city’s heavy dependence on migrant labour. Local estimates suggest that Gurugram and Faridabad together have around 2.5 to 3 lakh workers from West Bengal and Assam, forming a significant part of the workforce in sanitation, housekeeping, construction and gig services. In several residential areas, a majority of sanitation

staff is drawn from these states.

The disruption has affected both high-density and upscale residential pockets, including Sectors 15 (Parts I and II), 17 and 23, DLF phases, and old Gurugram areas.

Praveen Yadav, president of United Gurugram RWAs, said the situation was worsening. “The sanitation system was already under pressure, but this

election-related migration has brought it to a tipping point. In sectors like 15 and 17, garbage is piling up. RWAs are working overtime to manage the situation and are constantly in touch with the MCG to find temporary solutions, but without manpower, there is only so much we can do,” he said.

The labour shortage has also impacted households and the gig economy. Many residents reported a shortage of domestic help as workers travelled back home for the polls. “My cook and cleaning help both left for Malda last week for the polls. It’s been a struggle to manage work and chores,” said Ananya Roy, a software engineer living in Sector 23.

The impact is visible on app-based services as well, with food delivery and quick-commerce platforms reporting longer delivery times or temporary service disruptions in parts of Gurugram and Faridabad. Industry observers say the number of active gig workers has dipped significantly this week due to the reverse migration.

G'gram tops nation's pollution chart in March, says report

Gurugram has been ranked the most polluted city in India for March 2026, according to a report by the Centre for Research on Energy and Clean Air, underlining a deepening air quality crisis in Haryana.

The report notes that Haryana accounted for four of the country's 10 most polluted cities during the month, highlighting the widespread nature of pollution in the state.

Gurugram recorded a monthly average PM2.5 level of 116 µg/m³, placing it at the top of the national pollution chart. Data further showed that nine of Haryana's 24 monitored cities exceeded the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS).

Apart from Gurugram, other cities from the state featuring in the top 10 include Bahadurgarh, Faridabad and Manesar. The list also includes Singrauli and Mandideep in Madhya Pradesh, Ghaziabad and Noida in Uttar Pradesh, Bhiwadi in Rajasthan and Nandesari in Gujarat.

While Gurugram topped the charts for March, the report noted that Ghaziabad remained the most polluted

city overall for the entire 2025-26 financial year.

The findings come against the backdrop of persistently poor air quality in the region. In 2025, both Gurugram and Faridabad frequently figured among India's most polluted cities. Earlier trends indicated that while Faridabad often recorded higher PM2.5 levels, Gurugram consistently reported elevated PM10 concentrations, largely attributed to construction activity and road dust.

However, the latest data indicates a sharp spike in PM2.5 levels in Gurugram, pushing it to the top position once again.

The CREA analysis also reviewed the progress of the National Clean Air Programme seven years after its launch, and found mixed results across cities.

Dehradun recorded the highest reduction in PM10 levels — about 75% compared to the 2017-18 baseline — while Delhi saw a modest 17% decline. In contrast, Visakhapatnam registered the highest increase in pollution levels at 73%. Several cities in Odisha and Madhya Pradesh also reported rising PM10 levels, while nine cities in Uttar Pradesh recorded reductions exceeding 40%.

ED attaches ₹39-cr assets of Al Falah Trustee

The Directorate of Enforcement (ED) on Tuesday attached properties worth Rs 39.45 crore under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), 2002, belonging to Al Falah Charitable Trust and its Managing Trustee, Jawad Ahmad Siddiqui.

The attached assets include Siddiqui's residential premises in Jamia Nagar, Okhla, agricultural land at Dhauj village in Faridabad adjoining the Al Falah University campus, as well as his demat holdings, bank balances and fixed deposits linked to both Siddiqui and the Trust.

The ED had arrested Siddiqui on March 24 from Tihar Jail, where he was already lodged in connection with an earlier ED/Delhi Police case involving the Trust. He is currently in judicial custody. The latest arrest relates to another money-laundering probe in which he is accused of using forged documents to acquire land worth around Rs 45 crore in Delhi's Madanpur Khadar.

The present PMLA investigation stems from three FIRs registered by Delhi Police on November 13.

Conflicting claims by Cong MLAs deepen internal crisis

Ilyas denies cross-voting, Israil admits not toeing party line

Amid the controversy over alleged cross-voting in the Haryana Rajya Sabha elections, Congress MLA Mohammad Ilyas has denied the charges, asserting that he neither cross-voted nor plans to resign. Speaking to the media for the first time since the row surfaced, Ilyas said, “I have not done cross-voting. Those who want to say it are saying so.” His statement comes even as conflicting claims

have emerged within party ranks over voting patterns.

Ilyas was addressing reporters during the inauguration of a private school in Sirol village of Nuh district, where Hathin MLA Mohammad Israil was also present. While Israil openly admitted to cross-voting, Ilyas maintained his denial, underlining growing differences within the Haryana Congress.

Explaining his position, Ilyas cited ill health during

the election period. “During the Rajya Sabha elections, my health was not good. What happened during that time, I don't have complete information. Even today, I am not fully healthy,” he said. On the possibility of disciplinary action, he said the decision rests with the party. “If the party feels that action should be taken, it is their right,” he added. Dismissing speculation about stepping down, Ilyas said, “I have no plan to resign. What happens in the future, time will decide.”
