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Woman stabbed to death in Kasba

Calcutta: A 42-year-old woman was allegedly stabbed to death with a knife in front of her 18-year-old daughter at their residence on Bosepukur Road in Kasba early on Sunday. Police said the woman's husband has been arrested.

The statement of the daughter, who is a Class XI student at a city school, led police to arrest the father, Binod Singh, for allegedly killing her mother.

Family members and neighbours said the woman had been abused by her husband for a long time.

Swarna Singh, who lived with her husband and their youngest daughter in a one-room, tin-roofed house in Kasba, worked as a domestic help in multiple households to support the family, while Singh, worked as a grille mechanic. They have two other daughters who are married.

Although the husband was at large when police were informed, they filed charges against him based on the statement given by the couple's daughter, who accused her father of killing her mother.

"We got information on Sunday morning that a woman, namely Swarna Singh, 42, of 175, Bosepukur Road, had been admitted to Calcutta National Medical College and Hospital around 5:30 am with stab wounds.

She later expired. When her daughter was questioned, it was learned that the husband of the victim had assaulted her with a knife at their residence around 4 am. The husband has been apprehended," said Rupesh Kumar, joint commissioner (crime), Kolkata Police.

Several neighbours said they were alerted by cries and commotion from the house in the early hours of Sunday. "We heard her daughter screaming that her mother was being stabbed," said a neighbour.

Tribunals, not Form 6, for deleted: EC officials

Calcutta: Voters marked "deleted" in the post-SIR supplementary lists will have to approach appellate tribunals headed by retired high court judges, as re-enrolling through Form 6 may not be an option, Election Commission officials said.

Amid confusion surrounding the process, booth-level officials (BLOs) across constituencies have been advising deleted voters to bypass the tribunal process by applying as new voters using Form 6.

"The Supreme Court has directed the formation of appellate tribunals for voters deleted during the adjudication process. Normal jurisprudence says that if there is a specific provision available for

remedy, the aggrieved person must use it. In this case, the appellate tribunals are the remedy," said an official from the office of Bengal's chief electoral officer (CEO).

"BLOs are wrong if they have asked voters to delete during the adjudication process to file Form 6," the official added. A 37-year-old voter from the Chowringhee Assembly constituency, who found his name deleted in the second supplementary list, said he had initially been advised to submit Form 6.

"The BLO told me to immediately file Form 6, but I was not sure whether it would work for me. I later learnt that the online window for applying before the tribunals has opened. I will file an appeal soon," he said.

Hastir Mallick, a voter from Serampore, had a similar experience. Mallick had submitted Form 6 after his name was struck off in the first supplementary list, on the advice of his BLO.

He was subsequently called for a hearing at the office of the Serampore sub-divisional officer (SDO) on Sunday. "I was asked to fill out a form at the SDO's office. Officials then asked whether I was a new voter or someone whose name had been deleted," Mallick said. When he told them that his name had been removed during adjudication, he was asked to approach the appellate tribunals. "They said Form 6 will not work for me," he said.

On March 20, the EC set up

19 appellate tribunals to hear appeals from voters whose names were deleted from the rolls during the adjudication process.

Earlier, on March 10, the Supreme Court had asked State High Courts to direct the Calcutta High Court, to constitute special appellate tribunals with former high court judges to examine appeals from those excluded from Bengal's voter list during the SIR.

Officials in the Bengal

CEO's office said the tribunals are not as prescribed format for such submissions, sources said. Voters can write their grievance on a sheet of paper and address it to the CEO concerned.

Appeal process

Aggrieved voters can file appeals online or submit written representations against the adjudication decision at the offices of district magistrates or SDOs.

In Calcutta, written appeals can be submitted to the district election officers (DEOs) of north or south Calcutta, depending on the

constituency where they vote. There is no prescribed format for such submissions, sources said. Voters can write their grievance on a sheet of paper and address it to the CEO concerned.

"A drop box for voters in north Calcutta will be available on the second floor of Jessop Building from Tuesday," a poll panel source said.

The seven Assembly constituencies under the DEO, north Calcutta, include Cossipore-Belgachia, Belega-

ta, Manikata, Shyampukur, Jomsambu, Entally and Chowringhee.

Those under the DEO, south Calcutta, include Ballygunge, Bhabanipur, Calcutta Port and Rashtabari.

Voters from Kasba, Behala East, Behala West, Jadavpur and Tollygunge constituencies, which fall under South 24-Parganas district, will have to submit written appeals to the district magistrate and DEO of South 24-Parganas.

BLO who verified others loses own right to vote

Calcutta: A booth-level officer (BLO) in North 24-Parganas who kept assuring voters that their electoral rights would be retained found his own name deleted from the rolls after the first post-SIR supplementary list was published on March 23.

Samsuzzaman Sahin is one of 42 names deleted from a booth in Kalkipura Dakshin village of the Haroa Assembly segment, a minority-dominated seat barely 45 km from the heart of Calcutta. His parents have also been removed from the rolls.

"When we were listed among those with logical discrepancies, I was confident that the names would eventually be cleared. Even when the February 28 list put us under adjudication, I did not lose hope. But after I saw our names deleted, I was stunned to speak. It was a com-

bination of disbelief, frustration, anger and anguish," said Samsuzzaman, who teaches physics at a government high school in Haroa.

Samsuzzaman, who turns 41 this June, uses only his first name in official records. All his documents, including his passport, list only one name. There were 912 voters in his booth. Eighty of them were under adjudication. The March 23 list showed that 42 have been deleted.

"Many families in this locality were extremely worried despite having official documents. They saw the SIR as an attempt to harass minorities. I would keep encouraging them to stay positive. I assured them I would do my best to ensure genuine voters were not harassed. But now, I am at a loss for words. Their suspicion seems genuine," Samsuzzaman said.

Samsuzzaman submitted his passport, Aadhaar, Madhyamik pass certificate and birth certificate at a hearing conducted in the last week of January in the presence of an assistant electoral registration officer and a micro-observer. His 76-year-old father, who earned a living as a private tutor, submitted his passport, land deed and Aadhaar card. His mother, an Anganwadi worker and a former BLO, submitted her passport, land deed and Madhyamik certificate.

'Fatal sea plunge' to save co-star

A popular actor, writer and podcaster host, Banerjee, 42, fell in the water during a sea shoot on Sunday afternoon.

He was rushed to the Digha State General Hospital, 11 km from Talsari, where doctors declared him dead on arrival.

On Monday, Tapan told The Telegraph they had been watching the crew working since the morning. "They were mostly on the beach, and no one sensed any apparent danger."

"Towards the evening, I saw them in knee-deep water. It looked like a dance. Then, madam fell," Tapan said.

Another boatman, Bhagrat Jana, was the first to reach Banerjee and his co-star.

The woman was rescued immediately, but Banerjee could not be traced for a considerable time.

Balesore police, under whose jurisdiction the area comes, said the film production team had neither sought any permission from Odisha police nor intimated the local Talsari police station for "precautionary steps that are generally taken during such shoots."

"In case they had informed us, we could have taken the necessary arrangements. For any such shooting, we keep a doctor's team, lifeguards, rescue boats and police ready. None of them was present nearby on Sunday," said an officer of the Talsari police station, bordering Bengal.

The police said some boatmen and at least one of the crew members were instrumental in fishing out Banerjee from the water.

Another boatman, Pullin, said when Banerjee was brought to the land, they turned him around and pressed the back of his chest. "He threw up some water. He was alive. He was groaning in pain. He was gasping for air. Then the crew took over," Pullin said.

Banerjee's inquest was conducted at the Digha State General Hospital and his post-mortem was at the Tam-

luk hospital.

"The preliminary post-mortem opinion is clear that the actor had taken in a lot of saline water and sand, which means he was gasping for air under water," said a senior officer of the East Midnapore police station.

Banerjee's body was brought from Tamlik to his home at Bijoypur in Calcutta, where his family, friends and thousands of people who recalled him fondly, paid their last respects.

The actor's body was taken to Kooratala crematorium on Monday evening for the last rites.

A senior officer of the Bengal police said an unnatural death case had been started.

Sources said there were several inconsistencies in the statements given by the crew members. The case is being jointly probed by Odisha and Bengal police.

"No one from his family has lodged any specific com-

plaint either in Odisha or in Bengal," the officer said.
