A-class Mandi in a mess, farmers not getting water

An A-class Mandi in the district, known across the country for procuring Sarbati wheat or golden wheat, is in a mess these days, sources said. The farmers coming to the Mandi to sell their crops are not getting basic facilities there. The Mandi, which gives lakhs of rupees to the government in the form of revenue, does not offer even drinking water to the farmers who bring their crops there for sale. The farmers from neighbouring districts, Shajapur, Dewas, Bhopal, Rajgarh, Raisen, and Sehore, come to the A-class Mandi to sell their



crops. According to farmers, they get proper rates for Sharwati wheat at Sehore Mandi. In other Mandis, they do not get proper rates, the farmers said.

Because the rest room has been locked, they stay either on their tractor-trolleys or under them, which has caused resentment among the farmers. At a time when the temperatures have shot up to 40 degrees Celsius, the water coolers installed on the Mandi premises are out of order. The farmers demanded the mandi officials open the restroom without delay and ensure a supply of drinking water for them. Mandi secretary Narendra Maheshwari said the key of the restroom was with the canteen director, and farmers could stay there. The room is regularly cleaned, he said.

4 days before wedding, son of corporator faces rape case

Satna: The police have slapped a rape case on a youth who was going to get married on April 20. The youth, Tarun Lodhi, a resident of ward number 28 in the Jawahar Nagar area, is the son of a corporator, Sushma Singh Lodhi. A woman lodged a complaint of rape against Tarun, who was going to get married with another girl.

The youth befriended the woman some time ago, and they soon fell in love with each other. After Tarun promised to marry her, their love affair developed into physical relations. The girl said she believed that the youth would marry him. When she came to know that Tarun was going to marry another girl, she went to the police station and lodged a complaint against him. The complainant said the youth raped her on the pretext of marriage. The police said they were trying to arrest the youth.

Two Poclain machines, dumper, tractor-trolleys confiscated

HARDA A team of the mining department has seized two Poclain machines (excavators), a dumper, and two tractor-trolleys as part of its campaign against illegal miners. A team consisting of mining officer Pragati Sonwani, assistant mining officer Chainsingh Damor, and mining inspector Devendra Singh raided an area on the Handia-Harda four-lane road near Kasia village.

They found a dumper transporting illegally mined moram (red sand), and the team members asked the driver to show legal documents to carry sand, he could not. So, the team members seized the dumper and parked on the Handia police station premises. The team also confiscated a poclain machine in Heerapur Mal village in Khirkia Tehsil where it was excavating sand. Similarly, another poclain machine was found excavating sand in Jhadiha village in Rahatgaon Tehsil. The team confiscated the machine. A tractor-trolley without a number place was confiscated in Alampur village and parked on the Rahatgaon police station premises. The team confiscated another tractor-trolley from Lakshman Kewat, a resident of Bichhapur village in Timrani Tehsil.

Satellites being used to douse flames in forests

Dindori: The forest department has started using satellites to monitor incidents of fire. According to reports, the high-tech monitoring has brought down the incidents of fire in the past one year. In charge of the control room Shobhit Vanvasi said the incidents of fire took place from February 15 to June 15. The VIIRS satellite is so accurate that it updates every bit of information about forest fires. As soon as information is received it is sent to the mobile phones of the forest guard, Vanvasi said, adding that a team rushes to the spot and doused the flames. When a fire broke out in Umarda and Vikrampur forests on Thursday, forest officials rushed to the spot and doused the flames.

Traffic blocked against road construction in other village

Residents of Lutgaon blocked the Modki-Shahdol Marg on Thursday, alleging that a construction agency began to build a road in another location instead of their village. The road blockade, which continued for two and half hours, caused traffic gridlock on the highway. The protesters said the road was proposed for the Lutgaon village, but the work was underway in the neighbouring village, Udri. A police team, the Nayab Tehsildar, and some officials of the Prime Minister's Gram Sadak Yojana rushed to the spot. An altercation took place



between the protesters and officials when they urged the villagers to end the road blockade. They also told the protesters that the road construction had started in another village because of some technical problems. They said roads would be constructed in both villages. A villager, Kallu Chandel, who was leading the protest,

said a board was put up in the Lootgaon village, declaring that the road construction was underway in the village under the PM Jan Maan Yojana. The farmers said they had cut off their crops to donate their lands for road construction. They took to the streets because the construction was underway in another village. Engineer of the construction

company, Akshay Patel, who also rushed to the spot, said, "According to the terms and conditions of the PM Jan Maan Yojna, when over 100 families of the Baiga tribe live in an area, a road is approved." The road construction began in Udari village because 120 families are living there, he said. On the other hand, since the number of Baiga families, living in Lootgaon, is less than 100, a road will be built there under Mukhyamantri Majra Tola Yojna, he said. The approval for road construction will be available by April 25, Patel said. After the assurance of the officials of the district and engineer of the construction company, the villagers called off the road blockade.

NSS camp in Rewa promotes social service, student development

Mystery deepens in trader's murder as gunshot remains unconfirmed

Bhopal: The murder of a 42-year-old grocery trader, Mohammad Hanif, in Berasia has taken a new turn after the initial oostmortem report failed to confirm earlier suspicions of a gunshot injury. Initial reports suggested that Hanif was shot dead. However, the postmortem did not find clear bullet wounds. Police now suspect that a rod-like object may have pierced through his chest. Berasia police station in-charge Veerendra Sen said it remains unclear whether the death was caused by a gunshot or by a sharp, rod-like object. The exact cause will only be confirmed after the detailed postmortem report, he said. Hanif's body was found near a dhaba on Shamsabad Road, around 10 km from his residence in Ward No 7, Berasia, on Wednesday around 4:30 pm.

Officials asked to provide facilities to farmers

Harda: Collector Siddharth Jain inspected the wheat procurement centres in Dhangaon and Dudhkachch villages on Thursday. Jain directed the officials at the procurement centres to provide facilities to the farmers who come to the centres for selling their crops. PWD directs strict monitoring to ensure quality road construction

Rewa: Public Works Department (PWD) SDO Omkar Mishra has directed engineers to closely supervise ongoing road projects across Rewa, Gudh, and Govindgarh to ensure timely completion and high quality. Rs 25.65 lakh siphoned in digital arrest fraud, CBI steps in

Retired employee of the irrigation dept robbed by cyber crooks

The CBI, Bhopal, has registered a case in connection with a digital arrest scam in which a retired employee of the irrigation department was robbed by cyber fraudsters. The case was registered following suo motu cognisance taken per Supreme Court orders.

The 64-year-old victim, a resident of Bawadia Kalan in Bhopal, retired from the electrical engineering light machinery division of the irrigation department. On Nov 4, 2024, she received a video

call informing her that a complaint had been filed against her. Shortly after, she received another call from a person posing as an officer of the Internal Security and Counter Terrorism Department.

Case followed SC's suo motu cognisance

The caller threatened her, claiming that funds from her account had been used for terrorism and that legal action would be initiated. She was further intimidated with the threat of property seizure and shown a forged seizure order. On Nov 6 and Nov 7, she was coerced into depositing money into specified accounts. She transferred Rs 16.50 lakh and Rs 9.15 lakh over the two days, totaling Rs25.65 lakh.

The victim initially filed a complaint with the cyber police on Nov 28. Following a suo motu writ petition in the Supreme Court and subsequent judicial orders, a regular case has been re-registered against unknown suspects. The investigation has been entrusted to inspector Abhishek Sonekar of the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB), Bhopal.
