Telangana HC grants conditional, one-week relief to Pawan Khera

Hyderabad, April 10

TELANGANA HIGH Court on Friday granted relief for one week, with conditions, to senior Congress leader Pawan Khera who had approached the court apprehending arrest by Guwahati Police crime branch in connection with an FIR based on a complaint by Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma’s wife Riniki Bhuyan Sharma on April 5.

Justice K Sujana, dealing with the anticipatory bail plea filed by Khera, said, “The petitioner is granted one week time to file an application before the concerned court. The petitioner is granted relief for one week, with conditions.”

The judge also clarified that the order has been issued only for the purpose of enabling the petitioner to approach the competent court, which shall consider any application for regular or anticipatory bail on its own merits.

Khera has been asked to exercise restraint in making any further public statements in relation to the case. “The petitioner shall be released on bail in the event of arrest in connec-

tion with the crime on his executing a personal bond for Rs 1 lakh with two sureties for the like sum each to the satisfaction of the investigating officer,” the court said, adding that the petitioner is required to make himself available for interrogation as and when required by the investigating officer.

While granting the transit anticipatory bail for a limited period, the court said that the petitioner must not tamper with evidence or attempt to influence witnesses in any manner, or directly or indirectly induce, threaten, or promise any person acquainted with the facts of the case. The petitioner shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the court, it said.

SIR IN 10 STATES, THREE UNION TERRITORIES SO FAR  
Electoral rolls trimmed by 5.58 cr, most deletions in Gujarat and UP

THE ELECTION Commission’s Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls, held in 10 states and three Union Territories so far, has led to the electorate being cut by 5.58 crore or 9.55%.

The second round of the SIR of electoral rolls, which was carried out in nine states and three Union Territories starting October last year, concluded on Friday, with the electorate in these states/UTs being trimmed by 5.37 crore or 10.55%. Including Bihar, where the SIR was held in the first phase, the number of electors has gone down from 58.87 crore to 53.28 crore.

The SIR phase two ended on Friday with the publication of the final electoral roll in Uttar Pradesh, where the number of electors went from 15.44 crore to 13.39 crore, showing a decrease of 13.23%. While the electoral rolls of the other states/UTs were published in February, the EC had given Uttar Pradesh an extension till April 10.

Uttar Pradesh’s electorate grew by over 84 lakh to 13.39 crore after the completion of

the SIR, according to the final voter list.

Addressing a press conference at Lok Bhawan Media Centre in Lucknow, UP Chief Electoral Officer Navdeep Rinwa said the draft electoral roll published on January 6, 2026 had 12,55,56,025 voters, including 6.88 crore male voters, 5.67 crore female voters and 4,119 third gender voters.

The number of voters in

the 18-19 age group stood at 3,33,981.

The final electoral roll published on April 10 showed the total number of voters at 13,39,84,792, he said.

Overall, the electorate in the 12 states/UTs (Rajasthan, Goa, Lakshadweep, Puducherry, Gujarat, Chhattisgarh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal and UP), went from 50.97 crore on October 27, 2025, when the EC announced the SIR, to 45.59 crore post-SIR.

Among the nine states, Gujarat saw the highest cut in electors (13.39%), followed by UP (13.23%), Chhattisgarh (11.77%), West Bengal (11.63%) and Tamil Nadu (11.55%). Overall, Andaman and Nicobar Islands had the highest decrease (16.86%). In Bihar, where the EC had adopted a different methodology, the number of electors had decreased by 6%.

In a break from the annual and pre-poll Special Summary Revisions (SSR), the EC had on June 24, 2025 decided to conduct the SIR for the whole country, starting with Bihar where Assembly elections were due in November.

The EC had said in its order

that the last intensive revision was carried out about 20 years ago and the rapid urbanisation and migration since then had necessitated a clean-up of the rolls.

As opposed to the SSR, where additions and deletions are made to the existing roll, in an intensive revision, the rolls are prepared afresh. In previous intensive revisions, the EC officials, usually Booth Level Officers (BLOs), went house to house with an enumeration register to check the number and details of electors. However, the EC adopted an unprecedented method for the SIR exercise, requiring all electors to submit an enumeration form within a one-month deadline, or face deletion in the draft roll.

The EC also required certain categories of electors to submit documents to establish their eligibility, including citizenship, which was also an unprecedented method.

The EC’s June 24, 2025 order has been challenged in the Supreme Court, with critics terming the SIR a check of citizenship through the back door. The EC has announced that it will start the SIR in the remaining states/UTs soon.

Boat capsizes in Mathura, 10 dead

A BOAT carrying tourists, primarily from Punjab, capsized in Yamuna in Vrindavan on Friday afternoon, leaving at least 10 people dead and several others missing, officials said.

The accident occurred near Kesi Ghat when the boat carrying over two dozen tourists moved into deeper waters and hit a floating pontoon, they said.

Authorities noted that a pontoon bridge had recently been dismantled in the area due to rising water levels, leaving some pontoon drums in the river, one of which the boat is believed to have collided with.

District Magistrate Chandra Prakash Singh reported six fatalities earlier and later rescuers re-

covered four more bodies, taking the toll to 10, district administration officials confirmed.

“Sixteen to 17 people have been rescued safely so far. Efforts are ongoing to locate the missing,” the DM said earlier, adding that all tourists onboard were from Punjab.

Medical authorities at the Vrindavan Joint Hospital said the deceased include six men and four women.

Rescue operations are underway with teams of State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) and National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), and around 50 local divers deployed at the site.

The tourists were part of a larger group of around 150 pilgrims from Ludhiana and Muktsar in Punjab who had come to Vrindavan.

JD(U) leader Harivansh nominated for third term in Rajya Sabha

AFTER TWO consecutive terms, senior Janata Dal (United) leader Harivansh has been nominated for another six-year term in the Rajya Sabha by President Droupadi Murmu.

This development ended speculation about whether Harivansh would continue his membership of the Upper House after making way for JD(U) patriarch Nitish Kumar on one of the four seats that the key National Democratic Alliance (NDA) ally occupies in the House.

According to the current configuration of the 245-member House, the NDA holds sway in 141 seats, which include 105 for the BJP, five for the

AIADMK, and four each for the Nationalist Congress Party and JD(U), among others.

A senior party hand and former journalist, Harivansh currently serves as the deputy chairperson of the Council of States. His nomination was notified earlier on Friday.

A few months shy of turning 70 this June, Harivansh was first elected to the Rajya Sabha in April 2014 and served as a member on several key committees, including the Standing Committee on Defence, the Select Committee of Rajya Sabha on the Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Bill, 2013, the Joint Committee on the Bill to amend the Citizenship Act, 1955, among others.

He first served as deputy chairperson of the Rajya Sabha between August 9, 2018, and April, 2020. Following a brief break in this spell, he has served on the same post since September 14, 2020.
