Palghar girl skips rabies shot after being scratched by dog; dies

A NINE-YEAR-OLD girl has died of rabies after she failed to take the vaccine shots, citing fear of injections in Palghar district, officials said on Tuesday. Kashish Sahni, a Class 4 student and resident of Nalasopara West, succumbed to the infection at a hospital on Monday, six months after she sustained a minor injury from a stray dog

while walking with her grandfather, they said. According to officials, while the child had been taken to a hospital a day after she was scratched by a dog, she reportedly cried and refused to take the anti-rabies vaccine out of fear of injections. The wound subsequently healed and was ignored. Officials said the girl's condition deteriorated four days ago, she refused food and water, and her

eyes had turned red. "She was rushed to a local hospital and later shifted to Mumbai's Kasturba Hospital, where she succumbed during treatment. The death report cited rabies as the cause," said Shruti Shenoy, secretary of the housing society where the child resided. Dr Bhakti Chaudhary, medical officer from the Vasai-Virar Municipal Corporation's health department, announced a primary investigation.

SATARA ZP ELECTION CONTROVERSY

Legislature can't step into executive's shoes, says Fadnavis

Hints that suspension of Satara SP only after checking reality

CHIEF MINISTER Devendra Fadnavis said Tuesday that the legislature cannot assume the executive's role, adding that directions issued by the legislature do not become the final authority, as any action based on them must be guided by ground realities. Fadnavis's statement comes a day after the chaos and manhandling of ministers during the Satara Zilla Parishad (ZP) presidential elections triggered an uproar in both houses of the legislature, bringing the internal rift within the ruling alliance into the open. Shiv Sena legislators demanded action against Satara superintendent of police Tushar Doshi. The controversy escalated after Legislative Council Deputy Chairperson Neelam Gorhe directed the state government to suspend Doshi, who was allegedly linked to a

lathicharge during the Maratha reservation protests in 2023. However, Council chairman Ram Shinde later said he would rule on whether Gorhe could exercise such power, effectively putting the suspension in limbo. "The Constitution has defined three branches. These are the judicial, legislative, and executive branches, and they work independently. The legislature can give directions to the executive, and as a matter of respect, the executive tries to respect the legislature. But with all due respect to the chair, I want to say that the legislature cannot go into the shoes of the executive," said Fadnavis. He was replying to the debate initiated by Shiv Sena (UBT) MLC Anil Parab through a point of business. Parab recalled Shinde's announcement on Monday regarding giving a ruling on whether the deputy chairperson has the right to suspend an

IPS officer and asked him to solve the constitutional deadlock. NCP(SP) MLC Shashikant Shinde, too, requested Council chairman Shinde to give a ruling. Fadnavis, who was present in the Council, said, "Just because directions have been given (by the legislature), it does not become the ultimate truth. The action will take place only based on reality on the ground." Referring to Parab and Shinde's reference to the suspension of an IAS officer in the Assembly, the chief minister said the action was a result of the official's absence from the briefing called by the minister for legislative work. "That was related to the business taking place inside the legislative building. Here, the incident occurred outside the legislative building. Directions are given by the chair, and the executive has the right to convey the reality. Even the promises given inside the house are not like gospel truths. We have a Promises Committee to monitor those for that very purpose," the CM said.

Supriya Sule questions 'invisible political power', defends police

WHILE STRONGLY condemning the political developments in the Satara Zilla Parishad polls, NCP (SP) MP Supriya Sule said Tuesday that the police should not be blamed for the incident, as she questioned the "invisible political power" she alleged was influencing their actions. While speaking to reporters in Delhi on the Satara Zilla Parishad presidency polls, where the BJP won despite its allies the Shiv Sena and the NCP having a majority, Sule said she will write a letter to Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis. In the elections for the post of Satara ZP president held last Friday, BJP's Priya Shinde emerged victorious, defeating the nearest nominee backed by the Shiv Sena-NCP alliance. On Monday, Shiv Sena minister Shambhuraaj Desai accused the BJP of manipulating the polls. In a scathing attack in the Assembly and outside, Desai said, "The BJP has murdered democracy." Members of the Shiv Sena and Makarand Patil from the NCP also protested on the steps of Vidhan Bhawan. The Shiv Sena, led by Dep-

uty Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, alleged that the BJP engineered defections to win the presidency post. At the eleventh hour, two members each from the Shiv Sena and the NCP were allegedly poached, while two members elected on the Shiv Sena symbol were disqualified to reduce its strength. The party further alleged that the BJP used the police to influence the polls and that police personnel manhandled Sena minister Desai and other members. However, Sule said the police cannot be blamed for the incident. "I have known the Maharashtra police force, which is the best. They will never indulge in such things. The question is: who is the mastermind behind it? What is that invisible political power which is driving the police to act? We have to question misuse of power," she said. "It was very unfortunate to see such political manipulation in Maharashtra, which has always been guided by the democracy of Dr B R Ambedkar," she said. To achieve victory at any cost, if a ruling party misuses its power, it is disgraceful, the MP said.

Metro Line 3 hits first major snag since full rollout

Services disrupted for 30 minutes

MUMBAI METRO Line 3 services were disrupted for around 30 minutes during peak hours on Monday morning due to technical snag – the first such incident in five months since the full underground corridor

became operational. Passengers reported that trains began slowing down around 8.45 am, before stalling intermittently and moving at reduced speeds. Services in both directions were affected, leading to delays of up to half an hour for officegoers.

Officials from the Mumbai Metro Rail Corporation Limited (MMRCL) attributed the disruption to a "minor technical glitch", stating that the issue was resolved within 10 minutes. However, commuters described a longer and more chaotic experience. "The metro stopped between Santa Cruz and Bandra Colony around 8.45 am. It then crawled to the station, halted

for 5–7 minutes, and again moved slowly to BKC, where we were held up for about 10 minutes. The rest of the journey was normal," commuter Maruti Naik posted on social media platform X. Naik added that while announcements referred to an "emergency", they did not specify the issue, causing anxiety among passengers. Another commuter said the train was halted for nearly 20

minutes between Aarey JVLR and SEEPZ, before proceeding at a slow pace up to the Airport station. Commuters also pointed to communication gaps inside the underground corridor, noting that limited network connectivity made it difficult to seek updates or assistance. This comes after a brief disruption reported on the line in November 2025, making Monday's incident one of the more
