

Adi Kailash yatra to begin on May 1



Online registration for Inner Line Permit will begin on April 28

Pithoragarh: The portals of the Shiv Dham at Joling-kong will open on May 1, marking the commencement of the Adi Kailash Yatra. All departments have been directed to ensure a safe journey for tourists and pilgrims.

At a meeting of various departments on Wednesday, district magistrate Ashish Kumar Bhargava said, "Online registration for the Inner Line Permit (ILP) will begin on April 28 while offline registration will start on May 1. ILP is mandatory to undertake the Adi Kailash yatra, and it will be valid for four days. The pass will be issued by Dharchula SDM."

Tourists and pilgrims can collect medical certificates and police verification from centres at Dharchula and Pithoragarh.

Adi Kailash is situated at an altitude of 5,945 m in Byas valley of Dharchula tehsil. Last year, 36,000 tourists visited Adi Kailash and Om Parvat, and the number is expected to touch 50,000 this year.

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Dehradun: The portals of the Kedarnath shrine, revered as the 11th Jyotirlinga, were opened for pilgrims at 6am on Wednesday in a ceremony witnessed by thousands of pilgrims.

The ritual began at 6am and culminated with Rawal Bhimashankar Linga, chief minister Pushkar Singh Dhami and religious leaders, entering the temple's sanctum sanctorum to perform worship. The temple was decorated with over 51 quintals of flowers, and as the doors opened, petals were showered from a helicopter.

No markings on helipad, chopper ops to Kedar delayed

Dehradun: Helicopter services to Kedarnath were delayed on Wednesday due to "technical issues" at the shrine's helipad, leaving hundreds of miffed pilgrims stranded at Sirsi, Phata and Guptkashi.

The services were scheduled to begin at 6am, coinciding with the opening day of the Kedarnath temple. Pilgrims reached the helipads early in the morning, only to be informed that operations had not commenced. Bookings for the 6am-9am and 9am-12 noon

reached the shrine the previous evening, travelling from its winter seat at Shri Omkareshwar Temple in Ukhimath via Guptkashi, Phata and Gaurikund.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi, in a post on X, wrote: "On the sacred land of Devbhoomi Uttarakhand, the portals of Shri Kedarnath Dham have today been opened for all devotees with complete rituals and traditions. This Ke-

slots were subsequently cancelled and refunded, adding to the inconvenience.

"The mandatory markings on the helipad could not be completed earlier due to heavy snowfall last week. Once the markings were done, helicopter services resumed at 1:30 pm," an aviation company operator said.

Rewant Mishra, a 48-year-old advocate from Kanpur who had travelled nearly 750 km with his friends to reach Phata a day earlier, said they had booked a 6am slot for the Kedarnath shuttle. "We understand weather-related disruptions in the mountains, but if the heli-

pad was not ready, tickets should not have been sold in advance," Mishra said.

He added, "While the ticket amount was refunded, the convenience fee of ₹1,062 was non-refundable. There were many elderly pilgrims waiting helplessly. The situation could have been handled in a better way."

Helicopter operations resumed later in the afternoon, but passengers affected by the morning cancellations were left scrambling for alternatives, highlighting gaps in coordination and preparedness at the start of the pilgrimage season.

Have UCC amendments been enforced: HC to govt

Petitions Focus On Provisions Of Live-In Relations

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Dehradun: Uttarakhand high court, while hearing a bunch of petitions against Uniform Civil Code (UCC), implemented on Jan 27, 2025, directed the state to clarify by next hearing whether amendments to the Act have been made and enforced. The petitioners argued they were unaware of any changes, despite the govt earlier stating that amendments were underway.

A division bench comprising Chief Justice Manoj Kumar Gupta and Justice Subhash Upadhyay scheduled the next hearing of the matter for the third week of July.

Challenges focus on provisions around live-in rela-

tionships, with petitioners claiming violations of privacy and fundamental rights.

In Oct 2024, the govt filed a 78-page affidavit proposing revisions to make UCC rules "practical, transparent and citizen-friendly." Key changes include restricting data sharing to record-keeping and mandating registrars and police to ensure applicants' privacy.

The proposed changes — detailed in a 78-page affidavit submitted before the division bench of then Chief Justice G

Narendar and Justice Subhash Upadhyay — sought to "clarify procedures around live-in relationships, registration and appeals while strengthening privacy protections".

The petitioners argued that the state govt, by enacting the UCC, cannot be permitted to infringe upon the fundamental rights, specifically the personal rights, granted to individuals under the Constitution. They contended that this constituted a violation of the right to privacy and therefore necessitated rectification.

HC seeks report on medical waste dumping in Pithoragarh

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Dehradun: Uttarakhand high court on Wed, hearing a PIL against the alleged dumping of medical waste from hospitals in the open in Pithoragarh district, including into rivers, drains, pits and municipal garbage bins, directed state govt to apprise it of the situation within four weeks.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that hospital waste was being disposed of in municipal garbage bins, posing a serious threat to human health, animals and the environment, and violating biomedical waste management rules.

A division bench of Chief Justice Manoj Kumar Gupta and Justice Subhash Upadhyay asked the state to file a report on the prevailing situation within four weeks.

The PIL, filed by Pithoragarh resident Dr Rajesh Pandey, stated that the district lacks facilities for the proper disposal of biomedical waste. As a result, waste generated by govt and private hospitals, as well as pathology laboratories, is being "indiscriminately" dumped in the open, increasing the risk of disease outbreaks.

The chief medical officer of Pithoragarh acknowledged that the district "lacks adequate disposal mechanisms", leading to difficulties in waste management and resulting in haphazard disposal by healthcare facilities.

HC orders ₹25 lakh payout in accidental death insurance case

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Dehradun: Uttarakhand high court directed Uttarakhand Gramin Bank to pay Rs 25 lakh with 5% annual interest to Danyanti Negi, widow of late constable Narendar Singh Negi, after finding that she could not be denied accidental



death insurance benefits merely because her husband's name was omitted from list prepared under the bank's

Complimentary Police Accidental Death Insurance Cover" scheme. In its ruling, the court set aside the bank's communication dated May 21, 2022, rejecting her claim.

Justice Pankaj Purohit was hearing a dispute arising from the death of Negi, who was on deputation as a driver with the State Disaster Response Force (SDRF). The court recorded that he died in a road accident on Aug 7, 2021, in the course of service.

The court also observed that Negi had maintained a salary account with Uttarakhand Gramin Bank since 2015, with his salary regularly credited to it. A loan had also been sanctioned against the same account.

The insurance scheme came into effect on April 12, 2021, for police personnel whose salaries were disbursed through accounts maintained with the

bank, with the premium to be borne by the bank. After Negi's death, his widow sought benefits under the scheme, but the bank rejected the claim, stating that his name was not included in the final list of 676 employees covered under the policy and that no premium had been deposited in his case.

Rejecting this stand, the court held that the sole ground for denial was "unsustainable". It found that the omission of the deceased's name was an "administrative lapse" due to lack of coordination between the bank and the police department, and that the petitioner could not be made to suffer for a lapse beyond her control.

The court also observed that the bank could not claim ignorance of the deceased's status as police personnel when his salary account had been maintained there for years and a loan was linked to it. Calling the bank's action arbitrary and violative of Article 14, the court held that it "could not take advantage of its own omission".

50yo woman mauled to death by wild animal

Nainital: A 50-year-old woman was mauled to death by a wild animal in a forest in Jaulkote area of Nainital district, where she had gone to collect grass, on Wednesday. Eyewitnesses said Hema Pandey, a resident of Gram Sabha Jaulkote, was dragged about 1km into the jungle.

Range officer Nitin Pant said the animal responsible for the attack had not been identified. "The nature of the injuries and the condition of the body, however, suggest that a large animal was involved," he added.

Divisional forest officer Akash Gangwar said, "The matter is being investigated, and patrolling has been increased. People have been advised to remain vigilant." Sonali Mishra

Sports teacher axed for filming minor student

Rudrapur: A sports teacher at a college in US Nagar district was suspended Wednesday for allegedly filming an obscene video of a minor student and threatening to circulate it. In a police complaint, the girl's family said the man had been blackmailing her for a prolonged period. When summoned for questioning, he allegedly deleted the footage. Locals claimed similar misconduct over the years.

Villagers accused block education officer of shielding the accused. Chief education officer KS Rawat said, "Strict action will be taken against anyone found guilty. The BEO has also been attached to the Rudrapur office pending inquiry." Aakash Ahuja
