



GOVT BUILDINGS TO BE MOVED FROM MUSI CORRIDOR TO SHAMSHABAD, FUTURE CITY

Part of proposal to rejuvenate the 55-km river stretch, support development of 'Future City'

THE state government has initiated plans to relocate several government and institutional buildings from the Musi river corridor to new hubs in HMDA layouts at Shamshabad and the upcoming Future City.

The move is part of the Musi Riverfront Development Project (MRDP), which aims to rejuvenate the 55-km river stretch and support the development of 'Future City'.

Institutions proposed for relocation include the Water and Land Management Training and Research Institute (WALAMTARI), Institute of Cooperative Management (ICM), Telangana Institute of



Rural Development (TGIRD), Telangana State Cooperative Apex Bank Training Centre (TGCAB), SC/ST IAS study circles, allied educational facilities and integrated vegetable and flower markets. The plan may also include additional government offices, institutional buildings and tourism-

related infrastructure as identified by the Musi Riverfront Development Corporation Limited (MRDCL).

The government has already provided land along the river for the project. MRDCL has invited requests for proposals to appoint consultants to design the new institutional spaces with a focus on sustainability, resilience and long-term urban growth.

Officials said the relocation aims to decongest the Musi riverfront and reduce environmental stress, while aligning with the state's broader urban strategy of developing new growth corridors with modern infrastructure.

The new hubs are expected

to benefit from proximity to the Outer Ring Road (ORR), improved connectivity and planned urban ecosystems. The selected consultant will prepare architectural, structural and MEP (mechanical, electrical and plumbing) designs in consultation with the concerned institutions and submit them to MRDCL for approval.

All designs will comply with Indian Standard Codes, National Building Code (NBC), Energy Conservation Building Code (ECBC), IGBC norms, Telangana State Building Regulations and Future City planning guidelines, with emphasis on sustainable and energy-efficient construction.

Rajamouli seeks 15 lakh litres of drinking water, HMWSSB says sorry

IN a clash between summer demand and cinema, the Hyderabad Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board (HMWSSB) has declined a request from filmmaker SS Rajamouli's team for 150 water tankers, each with a capacity of 10,000 litres, for the shooting of his upcoming project 'Varanasi'.

The film, starring Mahesh Babu and Priyanka Chopra, is being shot on a specially constructed set on the outskirts of Hyderabad. The production house, Sri Durga Arts, had approached the Water Board seeking supply of tankers for underwater sequences.

According to sources, the water was to be used at a film studio in Gaganpahad, Rajendranagar, where a water pond has been created for filming. In a letter to HMWSSB Managing Director K Ashok Reddy, the



production house said it would bear the transportation cost and requested that the water be purified to meet filming requirements. The shoot for these sequences is scheduled for May 18.

However, the Board declined the request citing increased demand for water across the city due to summer conditions. Officials said the department is already facing pressure in meeting public demand and a surge in tanker requirements from various parts of the city, and therefore could not assure supply for the film project.

Gau Rakshaks told to avoid vigilantism

Hyderabad: Ahead of Bakrid, Hyderabad police commissioner VC Sajjanar held a meeting with representatives of Gau Rakshak organisations on Sunday. He said police have made arrangements to prevent untoward incidents. The CP asked volunteers to report illegal transport of cattle to the police and not take the law into their own hands. They were told not to join police at check-posts, photograph cattle or share details of suspects on social media. He said cases will be registered against those posting provocative content online. The CP also took to X to urge commuters not to stop their vehicles on the ORR unless there is an emergency. He advised motorists to call the ORR helpline (14449) immediately in unavoidable situations and move to the extreme left lane for safety.

Couple booked for ₹2.14 crore fraud

THE Economic Offences Wing (EOW) of Cyberabad police has booked two persons for allegedly cheating multiple victims of ₹2.14 crore by promising high returns from toy shop investments.

The case was registered on a complaint by Kandikonda Lavanya against Vadde Sri Priya and Ramakrishna. Lavanya said Sri Priya, introduced through a friend, claimed to invest in toy shops in Tirumala Tirupati and earn about ₹50,000 per day. She sought funds, promising repayment within 10 days with 10% interest.

Lavanya initially paid ₹1 lakh and received partial repayment, gaining confidence.

RETIRED TEACHER DUPED OF ₹25 LAKH

A 72-year-old retired teacher from Ameenpur was cheated of ₹25 lakh in a digital arrest fraud. She received calls between April 14 and 30 from persons posing as Anti-Terrorism Squad officials, who accused her of involvement in a terrorism funding case. They asked her to transfer money for 'verification', citing Aadhaar details and threatening restrictions on her movement. She was kept on video and WhatsApp calls, told not to inform anyone and made to give a written undertaking. Claiming the case was in the Supreme Court, they forced her to transfer ₹25 lakh to multiple accounts. Realising it was a fraud, she approached Cyberabad cybercrime police. A case has been registered



She later invested larger amounts but received only partial returns. When she sought the remaining ₹4.12 lakh, the accused promised payment by the second week of April. However, when Lavanya visited her house, it was locked. She later learnt that the accused had vacated the house

and was not responding to calls. Further enquiries revealed that several others had been cheated in a similar manner: Lavanya said over 20 persons were affected, with total losses amounting to about ₹2.14 crore. Based on the complaint, police registered a case and launched an investigation.

RGIA introduces 'Park and Fly' service

THE Rajiv Gandhi International Airport (RGIA) in Hyderabad has introduced a 'Park and Fly' service, allowing passengers to pre-book parking slots online for a smoother travel experience.



The service enables travellers to reserve parking for cars, two-wheelers and other vehicles, including buses and coaches, through the airport's official website. Once booked, passengers receive a confirmation email, which can be shown at entry points for seamless access to designated zones such as E-9 and E-10.



Introduced amid rising demand for parking, the system allows payment at exit without advance charges and also offers valet services. It is expected to benefit short-trip passengers travelling to nearby cities such as Vijayawada, Visakhapatnam, Tirupati and Rajahmundry.

Tariffs are structured for both short- and long-term parking. Four-wheelers are charged from ₹150 for up to 30 minutes, with a daily cap of ₹750. Two-wheelers start at ₹40 for one hour and ₹250 for 24 hours.

Valet services range from ₹300 for 30 minutes to ₹900 per day, while commercial vehicles and coaches are covered under separate plans.

Passengers must book slots at least six hours in advance, with bookings valid for 24 hours from the selected check-in time. If primary zones are full, vehicles will be redirected to other available parking areas within the airport premises.

Man jumps before train at Secunderabad station, dies

AN unidentified man reportedly died by suicide after jumping onto railway tracks as the Telangana Express was arriving at Secunderabad Railway Station on Sunday morning.

According to railway police, the incident occurred around 6.40 am when the train (12723), travelling from Hyderabad to New Delhi, was entering Platform No. 1. The man suddenly lay on the tracks in front of the train.

The train ran over him, and he died on the spot. The body was severed into two parts. No identification documents were found.

A case has been registered and investigation is underway.
