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SC rejects Trinamool claim of bias by Central govt. staff

Dismissing plea, it questions need for proportionate representation; Trinamool had said that EC was skewing playing field in favour of BJP by appointing more Central officers at counting centres

The Supreme Court on Saturday called it a "fallacy" nursed by the Trinamool Congress that West Bengal Government services' employees owe allegiance to it and Central employees were loyal to or controlled by the party ruling the Centre.

They are employees of the government and are part of the Election Commission in the exercise of their electoral duties during the poll time, it said.

The oral observations were made while disposing of a petition filed by the Trinamool, which alleged that the EC was deliberately skewing the playing field in favour of the rival Bharatiya Janata Party by appointing more Central of-

ficers, disregarding State employees, at counting centres across West Bengal.

Questions party

Justice P.S. Narasimha, heading a Special Bench, questioned the Trinamool's perceived need to have a "proportionate representation" of officers drawn from both Centre and State services at counting centres on May 4. "This

is yet another fallacy, that is those belonging to State government services have a different allegiance... These are but employees of the government. Give them some credit," Justice Narasimha said.

Justice Joymalya Bagchi, the associate judge on the Division Bench, said that once these officers were deployed for poll duties, they belonged to the EC. "All these persons, wheth-

er Central or State employees, are in the control of the EC in the discharge of electoral duties," Justice Bagchi said.

The special sitting, merely 48 hours before counting started in West Bengal, was convened on a petition filed by the Trinamool challenging an April 13 circular issued by the State's Additional Chief Electoral Officer directing that at least one counting supervisor and assistant at each counting table would be a Central government or Central Public Sector Unit employee.

The party, represented by advocates Kapil Sibal and Sanchit Garga, said the circular was a "textbook example of an unjust executive action".

EC announces repolling in all 285 stations of Falta in Bengal

The Election Commission on Saturday announced repolling for Falta Assembly seat in South 24 Parganas district of West Bengal on May 21.

Polling will be held in all 285 stations in the constituency.

The votes will be counted on May 24. On May 4, election results will be declared for 293 of 294 Assembly seats in the State, barring Falta.

Claims of malpractice

There were allegations of electoral malpractices in Falta. The EC took note of multiple instances of companions casting votes on behalf of electors and no video footage available at certain polling booths.

U.S. not committed to pacts, 'renewed conflict likely': Iran

TEHRAN

A senior Iranian military officer said on Saturday that renewed fighting with the U.S. was "likely", hours after President Donald Trump said he was not satisfied with an Iranian negotiating proposal. In a letter to U.S. Congressional leaders, Mr. Trump said hostilities with Iran "have terminated" as the cease-fire was holding.

Iran delivered the new draft to mediator Pakistan on Thursday evening, state media reported, without detailing its contents. The war, launched by the U.S. and Israel, has been on hold since April 8, with one failed round of peace talks having taken place in Pakistan since then.

Mohammad Jafar Asadi, a senior figure in the Iranian military's central command, said "a re-

newed conflict between Iran and the U.S. is likely", in quotes published by Iran's Fars news agency. "Evidence has shown that the U.S. is not committed to any promises or agreements," he said.

The U.S. has warned shipping firms that they could face sanctions for making payments to Iran to safely pass through the Strait of Hormuz.

FIR against MP who left AAP sparks row

Days after seven Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) Rajya Sabha MPs, six of them from Punjab, joined the Bharatiya Janata Party, the Punjab Police have allegedly filed two FIRs under non-bailable Sections against Sandeep Pathak, one of the MPs who made the switch.

The move drew sharp criticism from Opposition parties in the State, who termed it a settling of political scores.

'A conspiracy'

The BJP on Saturday alleged that the FIRs were a "planned conspiracy" to distract people from Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann's alleged

"drunken state" during the proceedings of the State Assembly on May 1. BJP national spokesperson Shehzad Poonawalla termed the FIRs, AAP supremo Arvind Kejriwal's vendetta. Mr. Kejriwal was misusing the Punjab Police to settle political scores, he alleged.

Southern States told to use clean air funds

The National Green Tribunal's Southern Zone Bench in Chennai has directed all five southern States and Union Territory Puducherry to ensure "strict and time-bound implementation" of their State Action Plans (SAP) under the National Clean Air Programme (NCAP).

The judgment flags persistent particulate pollution across the region and warns that continued under-utilisation of clean air funds could attract environmental compensation.

These directions assume significance as they put the spotlight on air pollution governance in the southern States — an issue

that largely dominates the northern regions, particularly Delhi-NCR.

The tribunal recorded that Karnataka had received ₹597.54 crore between 2019-20 and 2023-24, with Bengaluru alone receiving ₹541.1 crore but utilising only 13% by October 2024. A subsequent affidavit reported that 76% of total funds released up to 2025-26 had been utilised by September 2025.

One-man panel on laddu row finds lapses, suggests reforms in TTD Trust Board

The one-man committee, which probed the controversy related to the supply of adulterated ghee to the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) for preparation of laddu prasadam, has submitted its report to the A.P. government, identifying procedural and administrative lapses.

According to the sources at the Chief Minister's Office (CMO), the report submitted by the panel, headed by retired IAS officer Dinesh Kumar, has found that administrative lapses in the TTD had led to the adulteration of the ghee. The report, comprising more than 30

pages, suggested reforms in the eligibility criteria for the TTD Board members and a reduction in the number of members by amending the A.P. Charitable and Hindu Religious Institutions and Endowments Act, 1987.

The panel observed that the TTD Board must have

experts as per the requirements and they must be in the Sub-Committees of the Board. It suggested the constitution of an implementing authority and strengthening the vigilance wing. It observed that the vigilance wing had failed to prevent the entry of adulterated ghee into the tem-

ple. The panel suggested that a manual be prepared to govern procurement, storage, quality, inspection, roles and responsibilities of the Board members and experts.

A procurement portal must be set up and ghee producers must participate in tendering process. The tenders must be finalised based on the quality of the ghee, rather than depending on LI in the contract process.

The TTD Board must display the laboratory findings on ghee on the official website regularly. The government formed the panel on February 20, following the controversies over the supply of adulterated ghee to the TTD.
