ENCOURAGING PEOPLE to participate in large numbers in the ongoing Census exercise in the city, several prominent leaders, including Deputy Chief Minister Sunetra Pawar, Minister of Urban Development Madhuri Misal, Legislators Siddharth Shirole, Hemant Rasane and Yogesh Tilekar; Nagpur; PMC standing committee chairperson Shrinath Bhimale, among others, have been scheduled between May 10 and May 15. The present work involves giving numbers to each house and collecting basic details of its occupants.

On May 1, coinciding with Maharashtra's 75th birth anniversary, the state government, through the Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC) area visited the portal se.census.gov in to complete their self-enumeration.

They included Mohan, Minister of Urban Development, Madhuri Misal, Legislators Siddharth Shirole, Hemant Rasane and Yogesh Tilekar; Nagpur; PMC standing committee chairperson Shrinath Bhimale, among others. The state government, through the state's Omprakash Divade and Additional Municipal Commissioner Pavneet Kaur also participated in the special census drive by completing their own self-enumeration.

Minister of Urban Development Kishore Ram has made it mandatory for the entire civic staff to participate in the self-enumeration process. "Civic staff's participation in self enumeration can be considered part of the digital India movement," he said.

Divade warned of action against civic staff entrusted with Census field duty for being absent for ongoing training programmes. "It has been made mandatory for the deputised civic staff for Census duty have not been reporting for the training programme citing engagement in other duties, including election-related work. However, this is unacceptable and everyone deputised with Census work is to attend the training," he said.

The Census exercise is taking place after a gap of 15 years as it got delayed by the Covid outbreak. The previous exercise was in 2011.

Census in Pune Cantonment: Self-enumeration until May 15

CENSUS PREPARATION is progressing systematically across the Pune cantonment, with 103 houses listing back details of the eighteenth census. The Maharashtra State Census 2021, which is being conducted by the Pune Cantonment Board.

Pawar said that awareness activities are being conducted simultaneously through social media, and hoardings are planned to promote the self-enumeration programme and the census.

The census will be conducted in two phases. The first phase includes self-enumeration, from May 1 to May 15, 2021. The second phase, from May 16 to May 27, 2021, will be conducted from February 9, 2022, to February 28, 2022.

Officials have appealed to citizens to participate in the self-enumeration process by filling in the information.

As many as 113 enumerators and supervisors have been registered on the census portal, making a combined workforce of 132 personnel for the entire cantonment.

"Training for enumerators and supervisors has been planned in three batches, of which the first batch was successfully completed on April 29," Pawar said The Indian Express.

As per Census 2011 data, the cantonment comprises 15,702 houses with a population of 71,128, spread over an area of 11.54 sq km. Ward-wise demarcation of blocks has been made in accordance with Ward I having 11 blocks, Ward II 8 blocks, Ward III 9 blocks, Ward IV 14 blocks, Ward V 12 blocks, Ward VI 20 blocks, Ward VII 21 blocks, and Ward VIII 8 blocks, ensuring comprehensive coverage of the entire area.
