'Democracy being strangled': Mann slams Centre on ED raids

'BJP's Politics Of Intimidation Can't Scare Us'

Chandigarh: Punjab chief minister Bhagwant Mann on Friday came down heavily on the BJP-led Centre after the Enforcement Directorate raided the residence of state industries and power minister Sanjeev Arora, accusing the ruling party of using central agencies to intimidate non-BJP governments and throttle democracy ahead of elections.

Addressing a press conference, Mann alleged that the BJP was "preparing" for the upcoming Punjab assembly elections by using the ED and issuing notices to intimidate rivals instead of winning public support. He claimed the saffron party is struggling to find even 117 candidates for the state's constituencies.

"We have seen in recent times that democracy is being slowly strangled. BJP is doing politics of intimidation in the entire country. In West Bengal, the entire lot of officers, including the DGP, were changed ahead of the assembly elections. They win elections through ED, CBI, the Election Commission, and other depts used for intimidation," he said.

On April 15, the ED conducted FEMA searches at the premises of AAP Rajya Sabha MP Ashok Kumar Mittal. Mittal was recently appointed the deputy leader of the AAP in the Rajya Sabha, replacing

NOT THE FIRST ED RAID AGAINST ARORA

Even as the ED raids on Wednesday at premises linked to Aam Aadmi Party Rajya Sabha member Ashok Mittal and his family were yet to conclude, ED sleuths on Friday raided Punjab minister Sanjeev Arora (in pic), his business partners Hemant Sood in Ludhiana and Chandrasekhar Aggarwal in Jalandhar, reports I P Singh. It is after about a year and a half that the ED has raided Arora, Sood and Aggarwal again. In Jalandhar, ED sleuths raided Aggarwal's residence in Guru Teg Bahadur Nagar and the office of his company, Mexmon Financials Pvt Ltd, near Jyoti Chowk. The sleuths reached these locations around dawn.

IT HAPPENED IN OCT 2024

On Oct 7, 2024, the ED, Jalandhar, had carried out search operations at various business and residential premises linked to Arora's company, Hampton Sky Realty (erstwhile Ritesh Properties Industries Ltd), and its directors/partners, Sood and Aggarwal. At that time, raids were also conducted at premises linked to Royal Industries Ltd and its directors, Gurmeet Singh and Pardeep Kumar Aggarwal.

PROBE & 'FINDINGS'

After those raids, ED said it had initiated an investigation based on a criminal complaint filed in a Ludhiana court under various sections of the IPC against Ritesh Properties Industries Ltd (RPL), and an FIR registered by Ludhiana Police against Royal Industries Ltd.

According to ED, during investigation, it was found that, with the objective of promoting industry in Punjab, both entities — Hampton Sky Realty (erstwhile RPL) and Royal Industries Ltd — were allotted industrial land by Punjab govt with certain conditions. Investigation revealed that RIL sold the allotted industrial land in violation of those conditions.

Probe revealed that Hampton Sky Realty changed land use without permission of the govt and later developed a residential project and business park on the land by concealing facts while seeking permission. These activities caused loss to state and generated huge proceeds of crime, the ED said.

Something 'fishy': BJP on AAP reaction

Reacting to AAP's criticism of the Centre over ED raids on AAP leader and cabinet minister Sanjeev Arora's premises, Punjab BJP on Friday said the "noise" being made by the AAP suggested that indeed there was "something fishy." Punjab BJP general secretary Anil Sarin, in a video, said, "Today there was an ED raid on Punjab cabinet minister Sanjeev. I am surprised — why is so much noise being made about it? If a matter comes to an investigating agency, isn't it their responsibility to investigate it?"

HP govt hikes MSP for key crops, clears 1,500 govt posts

Shimla: The Himachal Pradesh cabinet on Friday approved a hike in the minimum support price (MSP) for key crops — wheat from Rs 60 to Rs 80 per kg, maize from Rs 40 to Rs 50 per kg, barley (from Pangri Valley in Chamba) from Rs 60 to Rs 80 per kg, raw turmeric from Rs 90 to Rs 150 per kg, and ginger at Rs 30 per kg under natural farming.

The cabinet, chaired by chief minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu, also approved the creation and filling of 1,000 police constable posts and 500 assistant forest guard posts, with 50% quota for Van Mitras. It cleared the engagement of eight naib tehsildars, 20 kanungos and 44 patwaris from among reti-



red revenue officials on fixed remuneration for the forest department, along with 10 legal consultants across its territorial circles. To address faculty shortages, retired teachers will be engaged as professors in new medical colleges across various specialities.

The cabinet also decided to take the services of Param Vir Chakra awardee Honorary Captain Sanjay Kumar (retd) with effect from May 1 to encourage the youth of the hill state to join the Armed forces. For timely disbursement of social security pension to beneficiaries, the cabinet decided to amend Rules 10 (2) and (3) of the Himachal Pradesh Social Security (Pension/ Allowance) Rules, 2010. The council of ministers approved allotting 71 small hydroelectric projects to the eligible independent power producers who fulfil the eligibility criteria as per Hydro Power Policy, 2006.

Approval was also given to simplify the fire no objection certificate (NOC) process to make it more streamlined and citizen-friendly. The revised norms aim to promote ease of doing business while benefiting residential building owners and strengthening fire safety measures. It was also decided to reorganise the administrative set-up of divisions of Jal Shakti department in Sirmaur district on the basis of constituency to provide better facilities to the public.

Another youth loses life to drugs in Kapurthala

Bholath (Kapurthala): Another drug addict from Raipur Araiyan village in Kapurthala, where two young addicts had died on April 9, was found dead at his sister's house in nearby Bagrian village.

Former sarpanch Stephen said the deceased, Samuel alias Sunny, in his early 30s, was addicted to drugs and his family had been planning to admit him to a de-addiction centre at Kapurthala civil hospital. He had been staying at his sister's house for the past few days.

"The family suspects he died after taking a drug dose," Stephen said.

Samuel's brother-in-law Raman said they found him unconscious and rushed him to a hospital, where doctors declared him dead.

On April 9, two addicts, Balbir Singh Billa and Shali, had died in the same village. "We were attending a prayer meeting for Shali when we got the news that Samuel had died," Stephen said.

Following a complaint by Shali's father, police registered a case of culpable homicide not amounting to murder against four youths.

Earlier, on April 7, another addict, Sonu (32), died at Govt Medical College, Amritsar. His parents had said four of their other sons had already died due to addiction. That youth too was from Kapurthala district, where he lived in Sultanpur Lodhi.

Light snow, rain lower temps in Himachal

Kullu: Providing relief from surging heat, parts of the high, mid, and low hills of Himachal Pradesh received light rainfall on Friday amid an orange alert issued by the weather department. Precipitation occurred in isolated areas of Kullu, Mandi, Bilaspur, Kangra, and Chamba districts, while light snowfall was recorded in high-altitude regions.

According to the District Disaster Management Authority, seven roads, including Koksar to Rohtang Pass, Darcha to Sarchu, and Gramphu to Batal, remained blocked. This rain pushed maximum temperatures down at various places. As per the Meteorological Centre, Shimla, Sundernagar recorded 28.2°C, 2.2 degrees below normal; Mandi saw 27.7°C, 6.5 degrees below normal. Meanwhile, the Met forecast suggests light rain and snow are likely in isolated parts on April 18 and 19. A yellow alert for thunderstorms, gusty winds, and lightning has been issued for Chamba, Kangra, Kullu, Mandi, and Shimla districts for those dates.

Family unchains 75-yr-old woman after panel notice

Amritsar: Kicked out of her home and chained to a porch for days, 75-year-old Prerana Devi could finally move her frail body on Friday, after she was unchained by her family. However, except for the removal of chains, little had changed despite the Punjab State Women Commission taking note — she continued to live outside her house.

JSS secretary Harsimran Singh said the organisation had earlier rescued her and admitted her to Guru Nanak Dev Hospital on April 14. "We admitted her and arranged treatment at our own expense," he said. He alleged that her relatives later reached the hospital, argued with doctors and forcibly got her discharged. "After taking her back, they again kept her outside the house. Her relatives are financially stable, but they are mistreating her," he said, adding that her weight had dropped to around 22 kg.



INHUMANE ACT

A video of the woman being chained surfaced on April 15, prompting the Punjab State Women Commission to take suo motu cognisance and seek a report from the Amritsar deputy commissioner and commissioner of police by April 20. When contacted, DC Dalwinderjit Singh said: "We have marked an inquiry. Officers concerned will visit the spot and submit a report."

JSS members who visited again on April 17 found that while she was no longer chained, her condition remained critical.
