The body of a youth was found hanging from a branch of a tree on the premises of the railway oil depot on Wednesday. The police identified the youth as 26-year-old Sanjay Chouhan, who was working as a vendor. Some people saw the body of the youth hanging from the branch of a tree and informed GRP about it. A GRP team identified the youth. As the mobile phone kept in the pocket of the youth's trousers continued to ring, the police identified the youth. The GRP sent the body to the district hospital for a postmortem and informed his relatives about the incident. The youth may have committed suicide, but the reasons for it were not known.

The police identified those who died in the accident as Nikhil Verma, a resident of Kothrimal and Ayush Dhangar Manakhedi, and the injured as Deepak Prajapati, a resident of Manakhedi. The state government on Wednesday appointed Manohar Porwal as the chairman of the Ratlam Development Authority and Govind Kakani and Praveen Soni as its deputy chairmen. Similarly, Rajendra Singh Goyal, Rajendra Maurya, Dheeraj Vyas, Rakhi Vyas, and Kiran Mahawar were appointed as its members. Vijay Yadav was appointed as chairman of the Chitrakoot Development Authority.

A message on social media is viral, in which it is claimed that police are recruiting volunteers for Simhashta Mela.

The PHQ clarifies that they are not planning any recruitment for the Mela here on Wednesday.

It is also clear that the selection or the recruitment of Simhastha Mela volunteers did not come under the police recruitment and no clear instructions has been issued in this regard.

It is cleared that during the meeting in Ujjain of Nagar and Gram Rakshak Samiti, it was decided to restructure them and to use them as a 'force multiplier'.

These volunteers will be used for the community policing, as volunteers. Their honorarium is also not yet decided.

The PHQ has asked not to spread such fake message and the police is also taking action against such police personnel who are involved in spreading fake messages.

Body of a 40-year-old missing trader was found inside a water filled pit under suspicious circumstances in Gungah area on Wednesday morning. The deceased has been identified as Devendra Mehra, a resident of Lambakhedda village. His kin have alleged foul play behind the incident. Further investigations were underway and exact circumstances of trader's death could be ascertained only after receiving post-mortem report, police said.

According to reports, Mehra left home on the night on April 17 but did not return home. His family lodged a missing complaint at Itkhedi police station. Police traced last location of Mehra's phone at a farmland on Dhamarra-Berasia Road. On Wednesday morning, Mehra's kin launched a search at the

farmland and found his body lying in a water-filled pit. The body was in a decomposed state and could be recognised through his clothes, mobile phone and other belongings.

Gunga police station in-charge Rinku Jatav said body was sent for autopsy. A case of unnatural death has been registered and further investigation is underway.

Police officials said that call detail records (CDR) revealed that Mehra's last three calls were made to close relatives including a woman and two men. Based on call records, the family has expressed suspicion of murder against the three.

The deceased's elder brother, Narayan Mehra alleged that Devendra had last spoken to Manoj, whose father owns the farm where the body was found. Police officials said that all angles, including possible foul play are under investigation.
