

3 Mizoram women escape horror spa

Local Auto Driver Helps Them Flee Rudrapur Racket
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Dehradun: Three young women from Mizoram, helped by a local auto-rickshaw driver, managed to escape an alleged prostitution racket in Rudrapur town of Udhham Singh Nagar district and one of them after reaching Aizawl approached cops there, which led to a joint operation by police teams from Mizoram and Uttarakhand to rescue five more girls and arrest six accused.

Promised ₹20k/month on FB by a Mizoram woman for a 'lucrative job', victims started leaving their native state a few months ago and broke into one of the rooms where the three - aged 20-22 years - were confined.

The driver directly drove them to the town's railway station, and seeing their traumatic state along with language and cultural difficulties, he guided them with the train details and gave them money for their journey home.

"It all happened in April-end," Aizawl ASP (crime), Zoramthara, told TOI, adding that, "One of the escapees filed a complaint at All Women Police Station in Aizawl on May 1."

After registering an FIR, Mizoram police set up an SIT team and sent a team to Rudrapur to rescue the remaining women. And the spa was raided on Tuesday.

Zoramthara said the victims belonged to impoverished families and were desperately seeking work back home. "The one who posted the job offer with a contact number

New hosp starts at Kedarnath

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Dehradun: CM Pushkar Singh Dhami inaugurated a 50-bed hospital designed to operate in high-altitude conditions near Kedarnath temple on Friday. Officials said the hospital, set up by Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited, has six critical care specialists who will remain deployed round the clock for six months, along with 25 technical staff.



CM said the 50-bed hospital will strengthen healthcare services in the region

He added that doctors, paramedical staff, health check-up centres, oxygen facilities and emergency medical services have been arranged along the yatra route to help devotees.

The charitable hospital is an expansion of an existing medical unit near the temple, located at an altitude of around 12,000 ft. It will be run by the Swami Vivekananda Health Mission Society.

Officials said the hospital has facilities for emergency care, pulmonary medicine, cardiology, trauma care, orthopaedics, general medicine and an ICU.

DMC captures 36 monkeys in 2 mths

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Dehradun: The Dehradun Municipal Corporation (DMC), tasked under a 2023 govt order with capturing and relocating monkeys straying into residential areas, has captured and relocated 36 of them since the programme began in March, officials said.

Earlier, complaints related to the monkey menace were handled by the forest department. Officials said the work took nearly three years to begin due to a lack of trained manpower and technical expertise.

"We still do not have a local unit equipped to carry this out. Based on quotations provided by the forest department, a Chidhiyapur-based company has been carrying out the drives across all 100 wards," said senior veterinary officer Dr Varun Agarwal.

Officials said complaints received directly by the corporation, as well as through the helpline and CM portal, are being addressed on priority. In March, two rounds of the drive led to the capture of 17 and 14 monkeys respectively, followed by five in April. DMC spent Rs 1,250 per animal.

A senior official said there is no monkey shelter in Dehradun, due to which captured animals are first taken to Chidhiyapur for examination and then relocated to the nearest forest range from where they were captured.

Among the localities facing the most issues are Tehri House, Rajpur Road, Azabpur, Indra Nagar, Mothrowala and Bengali Kothi.
