Aston Villa, Forest set up all-English Europa semis

Ollie Watkins scored again as Aston Villa knocked Bologna out of the Europa League in a 4-0 rout Thursday to set up an all-English semifinal against Nottingham Forest. Unai Emery's team reached its second European semifinal in three seasons with a 7-1 aggregate victory. Watkins, who netted twice in last week's 3-1 win in Italy, set the pace at Villa Park by tapping in a Morgan Rogers cross after 16 minutes for his 100th goal for Villa. Rogers later missed a penalty, but Emiliano Buendia doubled the lead from a tight angle a minute later. Rogers made it 3-0 in the 39th minute, and Ezri Konsa finished the scoring before the whistle. Villa is currently fourth in the Premier League..

Forest ends 30-year wait

Nottingham Forest reached the semifinals by beating 10-man Porto 1-0, marking a successful return to Europe after a 30-year absence. Forest

advanced 2-1 on aggregate. Morgan Gibbs-White scored the winner in the 12th minute after Porto's Jan Bednarek was sent off for fouling Chris Wood. Wood, a key striker for Nottingham and New Zealand, was substituted with a knee injury. Porto has never beaten a Premier League club in England in 24 attempts.

Freiburg makes history

Freiburg marched into the semifinals for the first time by

beating Celta Vigo 3-1, securing a 6-1 aggregate win. Igor Matanovic opened the scoring with a stunning volley, and Yuto Suzuki doubled the advantage before adding another after the interval. Freiburg next faces Braga, which beat Real Betis 4-2.

This follows the elimination of Atalanta, the only Italian club to reach the Champions League round of 16, in a 10-2 aggregate loss to Bayern Munich.

Shubhankar ends 8-year title drought with Boulders win

Sharma cards record 25-under to claim ₹1 crore title

HYDERABAD

Shubhankar Sharma carded a five-under 67 to claim his seventh DP World Professional Golf Tour of India (PGTI) title at the inaugural ₹1 crore Boulders Classic played at the Boulder Hills Golf and Country Club in Hyderabad.

The 29-year-old from Chandigarh dominated the week, finishing at a record 25-under 263 (66-66-64-67), eight shots clear of the field. His winning total set a new benchmark for the lowest aggregate score on the PGTI.

The victory earned Sharma ₹15 lakh and marked his first win on the tour since the McLeod Russel Tour Championship in Kolkata in December 2017.

It was also his first professional title worldwide in over eight years, dating back to his triumph at the Maybank Championship in February 2018.

Sharma's winning total of 25-under eclipsed the previous record of 24-under 264, held by Anirban Lahiri (2010), Rashid Khan (2019), Akshay Sharma (2020), and Manu Gandas (2022).

Hyderabad's Mohd Azhar, Delhi's Rashid Khan, and Chandigarh's Angad Cheema shared second place at 17-under 271, finishing eight shots behind the winner. Chandigarh's Ajeetesh Sandhu, a five-time winner on the tour, secured fifth place at 16-under 272.

Gandas produced a late surge to finish tied ninth at 11-under 277 after equalling the course record with a blistering eight-under 64 in the final round. The 2022 PGTI Ranking winner climbed 21 places from his overnight tied 30th position to break into the

top 10.
The week saw the course record repeatedly challenged and reset. Vishesh Sharma set the early pace with a seven-under 65 in the opening round. Honey Baisoya raised the bar with an eight-under 64 in round two, Shubhankar matched that effort in round three, and Gandas capped it off by equalling the mark again on the final day.
Shubhankar Sharma started his final round with a seven-shot cushion at 20-under and closed with a five-under 67, featuring six birdies and a lone bogey.

Under German coach Thomas Tuchel, who replaced Gareth Southgate after Euro 2024, the team qualified with a perfect winning record. Despite sustained success in reaching recent semifinals and finals, questions remain over whether the squad has improved since their last major final.

Croatia has a habit of delivering on the big stage, having reached the final in 2018 and the semifinals in 2022. National icon Luka Modric remains the leading player at 40. While the squad has fewer stars from Europe's elite clubs than in previous years, Manchester City mid-

fielder Mateo Kovacic is expected to be fit for the tournament.
Manchester City forward Antoine Semenyo is the stand-out for Ghana. The team has qualified for five of the last six World Cups, famously reaching the 2010 quarterfinals. Former Real Madrid coach Carlos Queiroz recently took charge following a turbulent qualification period.
Panama enters its second World Cup under coach Thomas Christiansen.
