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Terms and Conditions for sale of assets of borrower accounts through online e-auction on 14.05.2026 for property (Lot No. 1 to 18) as specified in Sale Notice under SARFAESI Act

1. Nature and Object of Online Sale:

- The online e-auction sale is with the object of Free and Fair Sale, Transparency and for achieving best-possible recovery of public money.
- The sale is governed by the Provisions of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 and Security Interest (Enforcement) Rules, 2002 and the following specific terms and conditions.

2. (a) The auction sale will be On-line E-Auction / Bidding through website <https://baanknet.com> on **14.05.2026 for property (Lot No. 1 to 18) specified in the Sale Notice between 11.00 A.M. to 02.00 P.M. with unlimited extension of 10 minutes time in case of receipt of bid in last 10 minutes. Bidders shall improve their offers in multiples as specified in the Sale Notice during online bidding of the property.**

(b) **Inspection Date & Time: - For Property Lot No. 1 to 18 – from 11/05/2026 to 13/05/2026 between 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m with prior appointment only.**

3. Platform (<https://baanknet.com>) for e-auction will be provided by e auction service provider M/s. **PSB Alliance Private Limited** having its Registered office as at Unit 1, 3rd Floor, VIOS Commercial Tower, Near Wadala Truck Terminal, Wadala East, Mumbai-400 037 Phone – 022- 69029800 (Ext – 119) :+91-9892219848. The intending Bidders/Purchasers are required to participate in the e-auction process at e-auction service provider's website <https://baanknet.com>. This Service Provider will also provide online demonstration/training on e-Auction on the portal.
4. The intending participants of e-auction may download free of cost, copies of Sale Notice, Terms and Conditions of e-auction, Help Manual on operational part of e-Auction from Baanknet.com PSB Alliance portal (<https://baanknet.com>).
5. The intending Bidders / Purchasers are requested to register on portal (<https://baanknet.com>) using their mobile number and email id. Further, they will upload the requisite KYC documents. Once the KYC documents are verified by e-auction service provider (may take 2-3 working days), the intending Bidders/Purchasers has to transfer the EMD amount using online mode in his Global

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Wallet. Only after having sufficient EMD in his Wallet, the interested bidder will be able to bid on the date of e-auction.

6. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) amount as mentioned in sale notice in respect of respective property being Lot No. 1 to 18 shall be paid through Payment Gateway (i.e. NEFT/RTGS, Bank Transfer, Debit Card, UPI) and Direct to Indian Bank (Bank Transfer, NEFT/RTGS, challan). All payments are processed securely through Razorpay Payment Gateway / Direct through Indian Bank. We do not store your payment information. Upon successful payment, you will be able to check the details in your wallet account. After generation of Challan from (<https://baanknet.com>) in bidders Global EMD Wallet. NEFT transfer can be done from any Scheduled Bank. Bidders, not depositing the required EMD online, will not be allowed to participate in the e-auction. The Earnest Money Deposited shall not bear any interest.
7. Bidders may give offers either for one or for all the properties, as the case may be. In case of offers for more than one property, bidders will have to deposit the EMD for each property. Bidder's Global Wallet should have sufficient balance ($\geq$ EMD amount) at the time of bidding.
8. It is the responsibility of intending Bidder(s) to properly read the Sale Notice, Terms and Conditions of e-auction, Help Manual on operational part of e-auction on website (<https://baanknet.com>) and follow them strictly.
9. In case of any difficulty or need of assistance before or during the e-auction process may contact authorized representative of our e-auction service provider (<https://baanknet.com>). Details of which are available on the e-auction portal.
10. After finalization of e-auction by the Authorised Officer, only successful bidder will be informed by our above referred service provider through SMS/email. (On mobile no/email address given by them/registered with the service provider).
11. The secured asset will not be sold below reserve price.

12. Caution to bidders:

- a. Property is sold on **"AS IS WHERE IS", "AS IS WHAT IS" AND "WHATEVER THERE IS"** basis after taking Physical possession of the properties.
- b. To the best of knowledge and information of the Authorised Officers, there are no encumbrances on the properties. However, the intending bidders should make their own independent inquiries regarding the encumbrances, title of property put on auction, physical area of property, and claims / rights / dues / affecting the property, prior to submitting their bid. Further the bidder/purchaser should make

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their own inquiries regarding any statutory liabilities, arrears of tax, claims etc. by themselves before making the bid. The e-Auction advertisement does not constitute and will not be deemed to constitute any commitment or any representation on the part of the bank. The property is being sold with all the existing and future encumbrances whether known or unknown to the bank. The Authorised Officer / Secured Creditor shall not be responsible in any way for any claims / rights / dues.

- c. The Bank does not undertake any responsibility to procure any permission/license, NOC, etc. in respect of the property offered for sale or for any dues like outstanding water/service charges, transfer fees, electricity dues, dues to the Municipal Corporation/local authority/Co-operative Housing Society or any other dues, taxes, levies, fees, transfer fees if any in respect of and/or in relation to the sale of the said property. Successful Bidder has to comply with the provisions of Income Tax regarding purchase of property & to pay the tax to the authorities as per applicable rates.
- d. Bidders are advised / cautioned to verify the concerned Revenue Records/ other Statutory authorities such as Sales Tax/Excise/Income Tax etc. and shall satisfy themselves regarding the nature, description, condition, encumbrance, lien, charge, statutory dues, etc. over the property before submitting their bids.
- e. Bidders are advised to go through all the terms and conditions of sale and also in the corresponding public sale notice in the details before submitting the bid and participating in the online bidding/auction.
- f. Statutory dues/liabilities etc., due to the Government/Local Body, if any, shown in the sale notice/tender document shall be borne by the purchaser(s).
- g. The notice for sale is also being published in vernacular. The English version shall be final if any question of interpretation arises.

13. Inspection of Property/Immovable Assets:

- a. Property/Assets can be inspected on the date(s) given in the public sale notice, and on any other date at the discretion of Authorised Officer with prior appointment. For prior appointment please contact Mr. H.R. Meena-9587006577.
- b. Bidders shall inspect the property/Assets and satisfy themselves regarding the physical nature, condition, extent, etc of the property/Assets.
- c. Bidders are bound by the principle of caveat emptor (Buyer Beware).

14. Inspection of Title Deeds:

- a. Bidders may inspect and verify the title deeds and other documents relating to the property available with the Bank.

15. Submission of bid forms:

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- a. Bids shall be submitted online only before the last date and time given in the sale notice.
- b. Bidders may give offers either for one or for all the properties. In case of offers for more than one property bidders will have to deposit the EMD for each property.
- c. Intending bidder should hold a valid e-mail id. All the correspondences will be done through E-mail. Interested bidders should have their own arrangements for internet service. Internet connectivity and other paraphernalia requirements shall have to be ensured by the bidders themselves.
- d. Bids form shall be duly filled in with all the relevant details. The bidders should upload scanned copies of PAN card and proof of residential address, while submitting e- tender/bid form. The bidders other than individuals should also upload proper mandate for e bidding.
- e. Bidders staying abroad/NRIs/PIOs/Bidders holding dual citizenship must submit photo page of his/her valid Indian Passport.
- f. Incomplete/unsigned bids without EMD remittance details will be summarily rejected. NRI Bidders must necessarily enclose a copy of Photo page of his/her Passport.
- g. Only copy of PAN Card, Passport, Voter's ID, Valid Driving License or Photo Identity Card issued by Govt. and PSU will be accepted as the identity document and should be submitted along with the bid form.
- h. Original Identity Document copy of which is submitted along with the bid form must be produced on demand.

16. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):

- a. The bid shall be accompanied by the EMD as specified in the public sale notice/tender document. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) amount as mentioned in sale notice in respect of respective property being Lot No. 1 to 18 shall be paid online through Payment Gateway (i.e. NEFT/RTGS, Bank Transfer, Debit Card, UPI) and Direct to Indian Bank (Bank Transfer, NEFT/RTGS, challan). All payments are processed securely through Razorpay Payment Gateway / Direct through Indian Bank. We do not store your payment information. Upon successful payment, you will be able to check the details in your wallet account. Bidders not depositing the required EMD online, will not be accepted. In case of failure to deposit the amounts as per above within the stipulated time, the amount deposited by successful bidder will be forfeited to the Bank and Authorised Officer shall have the liberty to conduct fresh auction/sale of the property & the defaulting bidder shall not have claim over the forfeited amount and property.
- b. After successful verification of KYC documents Bidder shall request for payment of 10% EMD amount through Payment Gateway (i.e. NEFT/RTGS, Bank Transfer, Debit Card, UPI) and Direct to Indian Bank (Bank Transfer, NEFT/RTGS, challan). through <https://baanknet.com> website. After payment of 10 % EMD amount on or before due date only the bidder can participate in e auction .
- c. Bidder may refer educational VIDEOS / Manual /SOPs for guidance.

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- d. The H1 bidder shall get an email /letter from the Authorised officer of the Bank to pay residual 15 % in Account Name: **E-AUCTION DEPOSIT A/C-PWZ**, Account No. **60350359155**, Branch name: **Pimpri**, IFSC Code: **MAHB0000080**. The H1 bidder has to specify A/c (Name of Borrower), with relevant details like Lot No/Bank Property ID No. or description of property while transferring the remaining 15 % of Sale Price . The remaining 75 % of Sale price shall be deposited on or before 15th day of confirmation of sale or such extended period as may be agreed in writing between Purchaser and Secured Creditor as envisaged in the SARFAESI Act. The said 75% of Sale price shall also be deposited in A/c. No. **60350359155** only.
- e. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) shall be adjusted in case of highest bidder, otherwise refunded on request of unsuccessful bidder. The unsuccessful bidder will have to generate request for EMD refund through the <https://baanknet.com> website. The EMD shall not carry any interest. Further, in case possession of property is delayed by any reason whatsoever, the auction purchaser will neither be entitled for any interest nor damages.
- f. A copy of bid form along with the enclosures submitted online (also mentioning the UTR No. and the account no. through which EMD is remitted) shall be forwarded to the Authorized Officer, Bank of Maharashtra, Pune West Zone so as to reach us on or before the last date of submission of bid.
- g. Bidders not to disclose remittance details of EMD, UTR Code, etc. to any one and to safeguard its secrecy.
- h. Bidders shall preserve the remittance challan and shall produce the same as and when demanded.
- i. Bid form without EMD shall be summarily rejected.
- j. All details regarding remittance of EMD shall be entered in the bid form.
- k. EMD, either in part or in full, is liable for forfeiture in case of default.

17. Bid Multiplier:

- a. The bidders shall increase their bids in multiplies of the amount of increment specified in the public sale notice/Terms and condition of Sale.

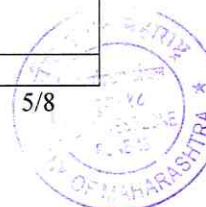
18. Duration of Auction sale:

- a. Online auction sale will start automatically on and at the time given in the public sale notice/Tender Document.
- b. Auction/Bidding time will initially be for specified period and if bidding continues, the bidding process will get automatically extended ten minutes duration of each and kept open till the auction-sale concludes.
- c. If any market-leading bid (bid higher than the highest at the point in time) is received within the last ten minutes of closing time, the bidding time will be extended automatically by ten minutes and if no bid higher than last quoted highest bid is received within the said extended ten minutes, the auction sale will automatically get closed at the expiry of the extended ten minute. There will thus be an extension of bidding-time, each of ten minutes duration, till auction is concluded.
- d. Bidders are advised to enter their bid accordingly keeping in mind the ten minutes duration.
- e. No complaint on time-factor or paucity of time for bidding will be entertained.

19. Online Bidding:

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- a. Auction/ bidding will be only online.
- b. In case of sole bidder, the sale may be accepted or deferred and property be brought for resale or otherwise sale will be deferred or cancelled.
- c. Bidders are cautioned to be careful while entering their bid amount and to check for alteration, if any, before confirming the same.
- d. No request/complaint of wrong bidding will be entertained for canceling the sale and in such case, the EMD in full will be forfeited.

20. Declaration of successful bidder:

- a. Highest bidder will be declared the successful bidder and sale will be confirmed in his favour in consultation of Secured Creditor as per provisions of SARFAESI Act. Intimation to this effect will be given through e-mail by Service Provider/Bank.
- b. Highest bid will be provisionally accepted on "subject to approval" basis and the highest bidder shall not have any right/title over the property until the sale is confirmed by the Authorized Officer.
- c. All intimations to bidders/auction purchaser will be primarily through e-mail by the Bank. Date of sending e-mail will be considered as date of intimation. If no intimation reaches, bidders are expected to take efforts to find out status from the Bank. Non-receipt of intimation should not be an excuse for default/non-payment.

21. Deposit of purchase price:

- a. The bidder declared successful, shall pay, immediately or within 24 hours after such declaration, a deposit of 25% (less EMD already paid) of Sale Price
- b. In case of the auction-sale proceeding and concluding beyond the banking transaction hours, the deposit of 25% of purchase price (less EMD already paid) shall be remitted by next working day.
- c. The balance amount of Sale Price shall be paid on or before the 15th (Fifteenth) day from the date of the sale or within such period as may be extended, for the reason to be recorded, by the Authorised Officer.
- d. It shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder to remit the TDS @ 1% as applicable u/s 194-IA if the aggregate of the sums credited or paid for such consideration is Rs. 50 lakhs or more. TDS should be filed online by filling form 26QB & TDS certificate to be issued in form 16 B. The purchaser has to produce the proof of having deposited the income tax into the government account.

22. Default of Payment:

- a. Default of payment of 25% of bid amount (less EMD) on the same day or the next working day as stated above and 75% of balance bid amount within the stipulated time shall render automatic cancellation of sale without any notice and the EMD and any other monies paid by the successful bidder shall be forfeited by the Authorised Officer of the Bank.
- b. The EMD and any other monies paid by the successful bidder shall be forfeited by the Authorised Officer of the Bank.

23. Sale Certificate / Payment of Stamp Duty:

- a. On confirmation of the sale by the Bank and compliance of the terms of payment, the Authorized Officer shall issue a certificate of sale of the said property in favour of the successful bidder/purchaser in the form given in

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Appendix V to Enforcement of Security Interest Rules. The Sale Certificate shall be issued only in the same name in which the tender /bid is submitted.

- b. No request for inclusion/substitution of names, other than those mentioned in the bid, in the sale certificate will be entertained.
- c. Sale Confirmation/Sale Certificate shall be collected in person or through an authorized person.
- d. The successful bidder would bear all the charges/fees payable for conveyance such as stamp duty, registration fee or any other cost as applicable as per law. All statutory/non statutory dues, taxes, rates, assessments, charges fees etc. will be responsibility of the successful bidder only.
- e. The Sale Certificate will not be issued pending operation of any stay/ injunction/ restraint order passed by the DRT/DRAT/High Court or any other court against the issue of Sale Certificate. Further no interest will be paid on the amount deposited during this period.
- f. The deposit made by the successful-bidder, pending execution of Sale Certificate, will be kept in non-interest bearing deposit account.
- g. No request for return of deposit either in part or full/cancellation of sale will be entertained.

24. Return of EMD to unsuccessful bidders:

- a. EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned through NEFT transfer to the bank account details provided by them at the <https://baanknet.com> website. The unsuccessful bidder will have to generate request for EMD refund through the <https://baanknet.com> website. The refund usually takes minimum 3 working days after successful submission of request for EMD refund transfer.
- b. Unsuccessful bidders shall ensure return of their EMD refund through the <https://baanknet.com> website and if not, immediately to contact the Authorised Officer of the Bank for assistance.

25. Stay/Cancellation of Sale:

- a. In case of stay of further proceedings by DRT/DRAT/High Court or any other Court, the auction may either be deferred or cancelled and persons participating in the sale shall have no right to claim damages, compensation or cost for such postponement or cancellation.
- b. Default in payment of 25% of the purchase price or the balance purchase price within the stipulated/extended time shall result in forfeiture and cancellation of sale and Bank will be entitled to re-auction the same.

26. Delivery of Title Deeds:

- a. The title deeds and other documents related to the property and deposited with the Bank for creation of Equitable Mortgage shall be delivered to the Successful bidder/Auction Purchaser, on execution of the Sale Certificate

27. Delivery of possession:

- a. All expenses and incidental charges for delivery of possession shall be borne by the auction purchaser.

28. Other Conditions:

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- a. The Authorised Officer will be at liberty to amend/ modify/ delete any of the conditions as may be deemed necessary in the light of facts and circumstances of each case.
- b. The Bank has the absolute right and discretion to accept or reject any bid or adjourn/postpone/cancel the sale/modify any terms and conditions of the sale without any prior notice and assigning any reason.
- c. The Authorised Officer reserves the right to accept or reject all or any bid or bids without assigning any reason and to postpone or cancel the sale without assigning any reason.
- d. Bidders shall be deemed to have read and understood all the conditions of sale and are bound by the same.
- e. No counter-offer/conditional offer/conditions by the bidder and/or successful-bidder will be entertained.
- f. The Borrowers attention is invited to the provisions of sub-section 8 of section 13 of the Act in respect of time available, to redeem the secured asset.
- g. Particulars specified in respect of the property in the public notice have been stated to the best of the information of the Authorized Officer/Bank and Bank would not entertain any claim or representation in that regard from the bidders.
- h. This publication notice of 15 days is as required by Act/ Rules of Securitisation Act to Borrower/s and guarantor/s.
- i. Disputes, if any, shall be within the jurisdiction of Pune Courts only.
- j. Words and expressions used herein above shall have the same meanings respectively assigned to them in SARFAESI Act, 2002, and the Rules framed thereunder.
