Protest held against forceful removal of 'janiwar'

Protesters seek stringent action against erring officials

The members of the Brahmin community staged a protest, condemning the forceful removal of 'janiwar' during the CET examination at Krishnani College, Madival and Nagarjun College in Chikhalapur.

They staged the protest under the banner of Akhila Bharatiya Brahmana Mahasangha, Belagavi unit, here on Thursday and demanded action against the officials responsible for the incident.

"The act of the officials has hurt the sentiments of

the students, parents and the Brahmin community. 'Janiwar' is not a mere thread, but is associated with the religious beliefs, culture, identity and mark of self-respect. Forceful removal of such religious marks is against the principles of the Constitution. It is a violation of an individual's rights," they stated in the

memorandum. The association demanded an inquiry into Krishnani College, Madival and Nagarjun College in Chikhalapur. They also urged that the concerned CET Cell commissioner, principal, examination supervisors, security staff and officials should be suspended from the service.

They also sought the formation of a special investigation team of senior officials for a fair and impartial investigation. Akhila Bharatiya Brahmana Mahasangha, Belagavi unit president Jayateerth Savadatti, Sanjeev Ambekar, Dr R Patil, Venkatesh Deshpande, Dr Satyapramod Kulkarni and other office-bearers were present.

Akka Pade prevents another child marriage

Akka Pade prevented the marriage of a minor girl that was being solemnised at Shastri Nagar here and rescued the girl and presented her before the Child Protection Committee.

It is the second such marriage being prevented in less than 10 days, after another minor girl had been rescued at Vantururi suburb.

Based on a tip-off, the Akka Pade, along with the District Child Protection Unit, visited the house. During the investigation, it was found that the girl was about to be married to a boy from Mudgali.

As per the documents, the girl was only 13-year-old. Information was shared with the women's police station police inspector. As per the directions of the official, Child

Helpline was informed. A case has been registered against girl's father at the women's police station for attempting to get the minor married.

Akka Pade members women police constables Renuka Kadagi, Aishwarya Anhale, Kamla Dandin, homeguard Mallah Karadi and District Child Protection Unit coordinator Mallesh Kundargi were present.

Man tries to end life at RC office

BELAGAVI, DHNS: A man from Nandebur in Haveri district attempted to end his life by consuming poison on the premises of the regional commissioner's office here.

Sources said that Rudrayya Aminbhavimath's application for land conversion was delayed at the deputy commissioner's office in Haveri. Subsequently, he raised the matter with the regional com-

missioner. However, the matter remained unresolved. Rudrayya had approached the Haveri deputy commissioner's office seeking the conversion of his two-acre land into non-agricultural land (NA). As there was a delay, he submitted an anonymous complaint to the regional commissioner's office and even visited the office several times, sources said.

On Thursday, he sought to

meet Regional Commissioner K M Janaki, but she was unavailable at the office. Frustrated over this, he reportedly consumed a poison-like substance on the office premises. He was immediately taken to Belagavi Institute of Medical Sciences District Hospital and admitted to the ICU.

The Market police visited the spot. However, no case has been registered.

Hescom to refund 10 paisa per unit

Company to share profit as it achieves high efficiency

Hubballi Electricity Supply Company Limited (Hescom) has announced good news for its consumers. The company has reduced electricity charges by 10 paise per unit for the financial year 2026-27. This benefit will apply to consumers who were consumers during 2024-25.

Hescom achieved high efficiency in power procurement, management, and expenditure during 2024-25. During this period, it generated total revenue of Rs.12,12,20 crore from power sales and other sources, while expenditure stood at Rs.11,95,87 crore, resulting in savings of Rs.153.46 crore. The company has decided to return this amount to consumers in 2026-27.

As per the order of the Karnataka Electricity Regulatory Commission (KERC), the re-

fund will be applicable only to consumers of the 2024-25 financial year. Based on their actual consumption during that period, an amount calculated at 10 paise per unit will be refunded in 12 equal monthly installments during 2026-27. This amount will be shown separately in electricity bills as 'FY25 True-Up Charges'. Consumers across Hescom's jurisdiction, including Dhawad, Bagalkot, Vijayapura, Belagavi, Gadag, Haveri, and Uttara Kannada districts, covering domestic and commercial categories, will benefit from this scheme.

"Due to Hescom's efficient performance in 2024-25, we achieved savings of Rs.153.46 crore. As per KERC orders, this amount will be refunded to consumers at 10 paise per unit. Accordingly, from May, the amount will be adjusted equally over 12 months in consumers' electricity bills," said Hescom MD Vaishali M.L.
