

Six UDF candidates from Kozhikode seek counting of VVPAT slips

Six United Democratic Front (UDF) candidates from Kozhikode district have urged Rathan U. Kelkar, Chief Electoral Officer, Kerala, to count Voter Verified Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) slips along with the votes cast in the Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) in all polling stations in their constituencies on the counting day on May 4.

The candidates from Perambra, Koyilandy, Kunnamangalam, Kozhikode North, Kozhikode South, and Balussery Assembly Constituencies claimed in a letter on April 26 that they were apprehensive about the integrity and transparency of the electoral process.

“It has come to our attention that on April 20, 2026, access was made to a room within the premises of the strong room facility located at JDIT Islam Convention Centre, where EVMs of the above-mentioned constituencies are stored. This was reportedly done without prior intimation to the contesting candidates or their authorised agents,” they said.

The candidates said that they came to know about this from UDF workers who had been stationed round-the-clock on the premises to monitor the strong rooms.

When the candidates sought clarification from the officials, it was stated that only a “material room” for the Perambra constituency had been accessed. However, after ob-

serving CCTV visuals and verification of the site, there was some confusion about the room that was actually opened.

“Further, the room in question was found to be marked as a strong room, and the officials were seen inside the room carrying out work using electronic devices, including laptops. It was informed that certain forms of verification work were being undertaken. These circumstances, including the location of the room within the inner perimeter and the nature of activities conducted therein, have led to reasonable apprehensions among candidates and the public alike,” they said.

Thus, VVPAT verification could be the only reliable

and transparent method to independently validate the votes recorded in the EVMs and to restore the confidence of candidates and the general public in the electoral outcome, the candidates pointed out. The letter was written by Fathima Thahiliya, M.A. Razak, V.K. Faisal Babu, V.T. Sooraj, K. Jayanth, and K. Praveenkumar.

The UDF leaders told the media on Monday that after the April 20 incident, though Mr. Kelkar had directed polling officials in the State not to open any room on the strong room premises, the returning officer from Koyilandy had gone to the facility. The returning officers from Perambra and Koyilandy should be kept off from the counting process, they added.

DME panel to probe mental harassment charges against faculty members

The Directorate of Medical Education (DME) has set up an inquiry committee to look into allegations of mental harassment against two faculty members of the Department of Psychiatry, Government Medical College, Kozhikode.

According to sources in the DME, two of the panel members are from Government Medical College, Thrissur, and the other is from Government Medical

College, Kottayam. The panel has been asked to submit a report in a week.

All 12 PG doctors in the department had accused the two women faculty members of humiliating them, even in front of patients and medical and non-medical staff. A complaint filed with the Principal said the PG doctors were under tremendous stress, which was affecting their personal and professional lives as well. The doctors had claimed that the faculty members often

threatened to fail them in exams.

Meanwhile, the university students’ union at the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) has sought an independent investigation into the allegations. In a letter to the university authorities, the union functionaries said action should be taken against the faculty members as per university rules and National Medical Commission guidelines.

The Students’ Federation of India (SFI) recently

took out a protest march seeking action against the accused teachers. The Kerala Medical Post Graduate Association and the students’ union too demanded justice for the complainants. The SFI leaders also claimed that this was not the first such instance of harassment being reported from the college. A similar complaint had been raised against one of the above-mentioned faculty members in 2025 January, but action was not taken, they said.

Actor assault case: legal support trust formed

A legal support trust has been formed by people from different walks of life to back the survivor in the actor assault case.

Functionaries of the ‘Avakkoppam Legal Support Trust’ told the media here on Monday that it would support the survivor in her attempts to legally challenge the trial court verdict in the case.

Activist K. Ajitha, writer-filmmaker Deedi Damodaran, dubbing artiste Bhagyalakshmi, actor Prakash Bare, and IT expert Joseph K. Mathew, among others, are part of the trust.

To file appeal
The trust members said the survivor was planning to file an appeal in the Kerala High Court against the acquittal of the four accused, including actor Di-leep.

The prosecution has already filed an appeal for the purpose. A team led by Vrinda Grover, senior Supreme Court lawyer, would appear for the survivor in the High Court.

Members of the trust, meanwhile, pointed out, quoting forensic reports, that a memory card related to the case had been misused while it was in judicial custody.

A comprehensive inquiry was needed as the hash value of the memory card was found to have been changed thrice.

Since the legal fight required funds, the trust would accept contributions from the people as well.

A bank account had been opened, and the details of the transactions would be made public, they added.
