

John Abraham’s cult classic *Amma Ariyan*’s restored version to premiere at Cannes

Forty years after John Abraham made *Amma Ariyan*, one of the remarkable independent films to come out of Kerala, a 4K restoration of the film is set to be premiered at the Cannes Film Festival. The film with a cult following, restored by the not-for-profit organisation Film Heritage Foundation (FHF) is the only Indian feature film selected for world premiere at the festival this year. The premiere is scheduled on May 16.

John, who began working on the film based on a sliver of an idea based on the suicides of persons associated with the Naxalite movement, followed an alternative method of production and distribution with his friends at the Odessa Film Collective. The collective staged street plays and screened films to

collect voluntary contributions from the public to make the film. Although it was never released in the theatres, the film has acquired a cult following over the years.

Shivendra Singh Durgapur, director, Film Heritage Foundation, told *The Hindu* that his memories of *Amma Ariyan* goes back to his student days at the Film and Television Institute of India (FTII), where legendary archivist P.K. Nair used to show the film to

the students. “He used to tell us beautiful stories about John. At the institute, it was one of my favourite films. The restoration was challenging as we had no original camera negative to work with. The whole process, from searching out the last surviving unsubtitled print from the National Archives to identifying the copyright holder at the Odessa collective to restoring the print took close to 5-6 years, with the restoration

work alone taking two years,” he says. After initial conservation work in India, restoration was carried out at L’Imagine Ritrovata at Bologna and Digital Film Restore Private Limited. The Film Heritage Foundation’s restorations of Aravindan’s *Thamp*, Aribam Syam Sharma’s *Ishanou*, Shyam Benegal’s *Manthan*, Satyajit Ray’s *Aranyer Din Ratri* and Sumitra Peries’s *Gehenu Lamai* were premiered at Cannes over the past five years.

Amma Ariyan’s editor Bina Paul, who was closely involved in the restoration work, especially in securing permissions from the collective, says that it is a film that needs to be seen widely by the younger generation. “When I watched the film after a long time, I realised that it has a timeless quality and stands the test of time. All the debates that are very current had

already been looked at in *Amma Ariyan*’s form, especially the use of documentary elements. When it comes to Cannes, John will also finally get the deserved recognition and the film will be available to many more people,” says Ms. Paul, who will be among the presenters of the film in Cannes.

Cinematographer Venu, who shot the film, is glad that the restoration team retained the original ruggedness of the film, from the rough tone and grain to the uneven exposures.

Gerald Duchaussoy, Head of Cannes Classics states, has conveyed to the FHF that *Amma Ariyan* is one of the best films the festival has received this year. He said he was blown away by the intensity which spread throughout the film, the camera movements, the black and white imagery and the political atmosphere.

CIAL registers 10% growth in cargo movement

Despite disruptions in flight operations in the wake of the West Asia conflict, Cochin International Airport Limited (CIAL) achieved nearly 10% growth in cargo operations during the 2025-26 fiscal, claimed the agency.

During the period, CIAL handled 72,178 metric tonnes of cargo, of which nearly 76% comprised international cargo, a growth of around 10% compared to the previous year. Consequently, revenue from the cargo segment rose to ₹52.84 crore, said a communication.

The increase in cargo volumes was due to the higher movement of perishables, pharmaceuticals, industrial consignments, and e-commerce shipments, it said.

CIAL also launched a Dedicated Trucking Centre to streamline landside car-

go movement and improve logistics efficiency. The facility includes dedicated parking and movement zones for long-haul and short-haul cargo trucks, along with separate parking facilities and driver amenities to support round-the-clock cargo operations, it said.

With the expansion of the Export Cargo Warehouse, the airport’s annual export cargo handling capacity has now increased to 1,25,000 metric tonnes.

The airport currently operates cargo warehousing facilities spread across approximately 2.5 lakh

square feet, handling a major share of Kerala’s air freight movement.

The communication noted that nearly 60% of the State’s air cargo traffic was routed through CIAL.

The agency also handled 11 non-scheduled cargo freighter operations connecting Kochi with Gulf destinations during March-April 2026 to export of perishables and essential commodities including vegetables, fruits, garments, cardamom and related produce to Gulf markets, according to a statement issued by CIAL managing director S. Suhas.

Three held for allegedly forging documents for organ donation

The Kunnathunad police have arrested three persons, suspected to be part of an organ trafficking network, for allegedly forging documents relating to organ donation in two related cases. Three others are absconding.

The arrested are Sunny Varghese, 56, of Kizhakkambalam and his wife Sini Varghese, 50, and Sanoj K.P., 32 of Pattimattom. Najeeb Kallatra and Rash-eeda, both from Peringala, and one Asif are absconding.

The police registered the cases suo motu based on a tip-off. According to the FIRs, the accused forged letterheads of two major hospitals in Ernakulam, including the name and seal of doctors as well as blank letterheads in the name of outgoing Uduma MLA C.H. Kunhambu and affidavits in the name of Ernakulam MP Hibi Eden.

The accused have been charged with forgery under Sections 336 and 340 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

The arrests were made after six teams, led by District Police Chief (Ernakulam rural) K.S. Sudarshan, held raids in multiple locations.
