

Addressing staff shortage, pending promotions: newly elected PGI nursing chief’s top priorities

NEWLY ELECTED PGI nursing president Arti Saini said on Friday that with the patient load continuing to rise at the institute, nurses are working under pressure due to staff shortages and increasing workloads. She demanded urgent recruitment, the implementation of safe nurse-patient ratio norms, and better security arrangements,

especially during night duty. Speaking about the challenges being faced by the nursing workforce, Saini said, “The shortage of manpower has become a serious issue, directly impacting healthcare delivery as well as the physical and mental well-being of nurses. In many areas, one nurse is handling far more patients than what is considered safe.” Saini said PGI’s rapid expansion through new centres and

super-speciality units significantly increased responsibilities for nursing staff, while recruitment failed to keep pace. “Nurses are simultaneously managing patient care, advanced technology, documentation, emergency services and counselling responsibilities.” Highlighting concerns related to women staff working night shifts, Saini said, “Some improvements have been made after repeated representations

by nursing employees, but several issues remain unresolved. Safe transportation, surveillance systems and emergency response mechanisms for women healthcare workers still need strengthening. Highlighting the lack of proper restrooms, changing spaces and welfare facilities at several departments, Saini said, “These are necessities considering the physically demanding nature of nursing duties.”

22 injured as Volvo bus overturns after collision with truck, oil tanker

At least 22 passengers were injured after the Volvo bus they were travelling in from Manali to Delhi overturned after colliding with a truck and an oil tanker at the Chhat Light Point in Zirakpur around 3.30 am on Friday. Sadak Suraksha Force (SSF) and local police teams rescued passengers trapped inside the bus by breaking its windowpanes, police said. Police said all injured passengers were initially taken to the Civil Hospital in Dera Bassi, from where 17 were referred to Government Medical College and Hospital (GMCH) at Sector 32 in Chandigarh given serious injuries, and a youth, whose hand was severed in the accident, was referred to the Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research (PGIMER). According to police sources, preliminary investigation suggests “negligence on the part of the bus driver led to the accident”. Sahil, a traveller on his way from Rajpura to Zirakpur, told police, “The truck driver was slowly crossing the intersection as the Chhat Light Point was orange. At the same time, the Volvo bus coming from the Airport Chowk side at a high speed tried to overtake an oil tanker ahead of it. Negotiating with the tanker, the bus driver failed to notice the truck crossing the intersection and crashed into it.” “At the same time, seeking collision, the oil tanker driver applied sudden brakes and crashed into the bus, which overturned in the middle of the road,” Sahil added.

Police said around 35 passengers were on board when the accident took place, and most of them were asleep and had little time to react before the bus overturned. Among the seriously injured was 18-year-old Vishal, whose hand was severed during the accident, police said. Doctors at the Dera Bassi Civil Hospital said his hand was badly crushed and was referred to the PGI for surgery. According to the GMCH-32 administration, all injured passengers were brought to the hospital around 5 am, following which, the emergency, orthopaedics and surgery department teams were immediately placed on alert. Doctors initiated treatment under disaster management and emergency response protocols. The hospital administration said registration, clinical examination, x-rays and other radiological tests were conducted promptly. Zirakpur ASP Ghazalpreet Kaur said, “Police and SSF personnel rushed to the spot immediately after receiving information about the accident. The injured were shifted to hospitals without delay. The damaged bus, truck and oil tanker have been impounded. An investigation has been initiated.” “Police are examining CCTV footage and recording statements of eyewitnesses. Legal action will be taken against the driver found responsible for negligence,” the ASP added.
