

Kolkata man held for beating his 5-month-old daughter to death, throwing body in dustbin

Incident came to light after locals noticed his wife crying near Brigade Parade Ground

A 24-YEAR-OLD footpath dweller in Kolkata was arrested by the Maidan Police on Friday for allegedly murdering his five-month-old daughter.

The arrest of Debojit Jana, alias Pitlu, followed a dramatic

confrontation near the Brigade Parade Ground after his wife publicly accused him of the crime.

The incident came to light around 1.46 pm on Friday near the Shri Mandir beside the TAOI Ground pond after a group of locals noticed 18-year-old Kajol Jana crying profusely. When they approached her, she narrated a harrowing account of what happened to her daughter on the previous Sunday (May 9) evening.

According to witnesses, Kajol told them that her husband had beaten their infant daughter to death while they were sitting on the grounds of the Brigade.

Debojit Jana allegedly beat his 5-month-old daughter to death and disposed of her body in a dustbin placed beside the JLN Road that same night, Kajol reportedly told the locals.

She further alleged that the child was killed by "repeated beating on her back and throttling".

As Kajol recounted the tragedy, her husband was spotted walking towards the group. As the locals identified and intercepted Debojit, he initially attempted to flee, but they caught him. When the locals confronted him, Debojit reportedly confessed to the crime before the police arrived.

The police registered a case under Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita sections 103(i) (murder) and 238 (causing disappearance of evidence) after a resident near the Park Street Flyover, Chottu Miri, filed a complaint.

Investigating officers noted that while the mother appeared disoriented and incoherent during questioning, hospital records from Matri Sadan, Hazra, confirmed she had given birth to a baby girl on December 12, 2025.

The recovery of the infant's body has proven difficult. While the accused led the police to a specific dustbin on JLN Road, the site had already been cleared by the Kolkata Municipal Corporation's (KMC) sanitation workers.

However, cameras near the site show the accused carrying the baby in his lap at 10.04 pm on May 3, according to the police.

Subsequent footage shows him disposing of a "white plastic bag" into the dustbin shortly after, the police said, adding that they recovered the clothing worn by Debojit on the night of the incident.

Authorities have identified the specific KMC garbage vehicle that cleared the bin on Monday morning. The police said efforts to locate the child's remains are currently ongoing.

No arrest yet, probe hinges on survivor's testimony: Police

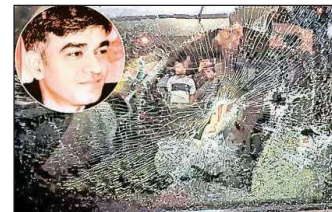
Police trace UPI transaction made by suspects at a Hooghly toll plaza before the killing

FOUR DAYS since the murder of West Bengal Chief Minister Su-
vendu Adhikari's personal assistant Chandranath Rath and police are yet to make any arrest, with the ongoing probe hinging on the testimony of the 33-year-old survivor in the car. While the Special Investigation Team (SIT) claims to have identified several suspects and questioned several individuals, there hasn't been any major breakthrough yet, officials said, citing the "fragile mental health" of their witness and the need to maintain the "integrity of a high-stake probe".

According to officials, the investigation now largely hinges on Montu Mondal, a resident of the toll plaza, who was the driver of the silver hatchback used to block Rath's SUV and not in the middle where files were kept rendered him "invisible" to the shooter.

As a hatchback blocked their path and unidentified bike-borne gunmen fired shots from the left, Mondal instinctively slumped into the gap between the seats, officials said, adding, "that he was so much in shock that he even forgot the shooter left, he refused to lower the windows for rescuers until he was also

lately certain the threat had passed.

As investigators scrutinise Nath's call logs and Mondal's detailed account to reconstruct the routes and potential surveillance leading up to the attack, two leads are at the centre of the investigation — a phone call that led the police team to a Siliguri-based owner of a car, whose number plate was used in the hatchback used to stall Nath's SUV, and a UPI transaction made at a toll plaza in Hooghly, officials said.

According to officials, the silver hatchback used to block Rath's SUV was found to have a fake number plate linked to a vehicle in Siliguri, whose photos were likely lifted from an online sales portal to create the "clone" vehicle. This prompted a team of Bengal investigators to travel to Uttar Pradesh, as they look for links between the local planners and out-of-state hitmen.

According to an officer, the silver car crossed the Balu toll plaza shortly before the attack, and the occupants paid the toll through UPI.

"The UPI transaction helped the investigators identify a mobile number linked to one of the suspects. CCTV footage from the toll plaza also captured images of the vehicle and its occupants," the official told news agency PTL.

The CID and the STF have jointly formed a Special Investigation Team (SIT) to probe the case.

Investigators have also identified the weapon allegedly used in the murder as an Austrian-made Glock 47X pistol, a sophisticated firearm whose use has rung alarm bells among both state and central intelligence agencies.

"A Glock pistol is not easily available in India. Its use prompted investigators to examine whether there could be any international or cross-border link behind the crime," the officer said.

A police officer said all possible angles, including personal enmity and criminal motives, are being examined. "No authority has been ruled out at this stage. The investigation is progressing on multiple fronts," he said.

Yogi inducts six ministers with big bets on OBC, Dalits & Brahmins ahead of UP polls

A YEAR ahead of the Assembly elections in Uttar Pradesh, six new ministers — two of Cabinet rank and four Ministers of State (MoS) — were inducted into the BJP government in the state. The second expansion of the Yogi Adityanath Cabinet focused on non-Yadav OBC and SC, while the party also reached out to the Brahmin community.

Former state BJP chief Bhupendra Chaubary and SP rebel leader Manoj Pandey were inducted as Cabinet ministers. The four MoS included Krishna Paswan, a four-term MLA from the SC community in Fatehpur; BJP Varanasi district unit chief Bhanu Vishwakarma, a Loh leader from Kannauj; Kailash Singh Raigarh, and youth leader from Aligarh Surendra Diler.

Along with them, two incumbent MoS were promoted to MoS with Independent charge. They included Ajit Singh Pal, a two-term BJP MLA from Barabanki and senior Kamur Bader. Pal had administered the oath of office to the newly inducted ministers at Jan Bhavan in Lucknow. CM Adityanath and his two deputies — Keshav Prasad Maurya and Brajesh Pathak — were also in attendance.

With the latest inductions, the strength of the UP Council of Ministers has risen to 60, thereby reaching its ceiling limit. Chaubary is a Jat leader from west UP, and has been active in politics since the Ram Temple movement in the early 1990s.

In 2017, when the BJP government came to power with a full majority, Chaubary was appointed as minister with Independent charge for the Panchayati Raj Department. The BJP later assigned him an organisational role, and in August 2022, he became the state president.
