Close shave for 10 newborns as fire breaks out in hospital

Nagpur: Ten newborn babies had a miraculous escape Wednesday morning after a smoke-and-fire incident in one section of the Sick Newborn Care Unit at Daga Memorial Govt Women's Hospital, reports **Sarfraz Ahmed**. The 42-bed SNCU had 36 babies admitted at the time, including 10 in the affected section. The babies were safely evacuated even as their mothers were away then. Sources alleged the hospital administration did not inform health authorities about the fire for 24 hours. The incident occurred around 11am after an electrical overload reportedly caused sparks in power supply wires connected to baby warmers. Medical superintendent Dr Dilip Madavi said it involved "minor sparking due to overloading and voltage fluctuation."

Submit data for renewal of MBBS seats by May 30, med colleges told

New Delhi: National Medical Commission (NMC) has directed all medical colleges across the country to submit detailed annual disclosure reports by May 30 for renewal of MBBS seats for the 2026-27 academic session, warning that no extension will be granted beyond the deadline.

In a notice issued by the

Under-Graduate Medical Education Board (UGMEB), the NMC said all existing medical colleges with approval to run MBBS courses must upload mandatory institutional data on the commission's portal under the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations (MSMER), 2023.

The disclosure process forms a key part of the annual renewal mechanism through which colleges receive permission to continue admitting undergraduate medical students. It has also made it mandatory for colleges to pay an online processing fee of Rs 3.54 lakh, including GST.

Most crime-infested region in NCR now India's 'jewar': Yogi

'Development Now Spans All 75 Districts'

Lucknow: Nine years of BJP's governance in UP transformed one of the most crime-prone regions of NCR into an investment hub that now qualifies to be called India's "jewar" (ornament), CM Yogi Adityanath said Thursday at the "Defining Years of Transformation" conclave organised by TOI.

Adityanath harked back to the 2011 Bhatta-Parsaul agitation, marked by clashes between farmers and police over land acquisition for the Yamuna Expressway, as one of the many hurdles in this journey of change.

"The Jewar region, once associated with unrest and uncertainty, is now the site of the country's largest airport project," the CM said, referring to Noida International Airport which is poised to start commercial

CM Yogi highlighted the impact of infrastructure projects, saying they had significantly improved connectivity across the state

flight operations on June 15.

"The airport will play a key role in boosting investment, employment and connectivity in western UP."

Adityanath said citizens needed to understand and acknowledge the socio-economic changes that had come about in UP since 2017, protecting the state from the malefic conditions that previously brought "ruin".

He said the state had moved from being a "Prashn Pradesh" battling lawlessness to one driven by "niti, niyat aur ichhashakti" (policy, intent and willpower).

BJP govt ended policy paralysis and adopted an inclusive model of development based on the governing principle of "Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas", while steering away from nepotism and politics of appeasement, the CM said.

On the situation before 2017, he said the state had been grappling with mass migration, farmer distress, recurring communal unrest, corruption in recruitment and a crisis of confidence among the youth. He alleged that the absence of policy direction and political intent pushed UP into the infan-

mous "BIMARU" category.

Adityanath said his govt inherited severe financial stress, with empty coffers and limited borrowing capacity. He said development now spanned 75 districts instead of being concentrated in select urban centres.

He highlighted the impact of infrastructure projects, including the Yamuna, Purvanchal and Bundelkhand expressways, saying these had significantly improved connectivity across the state. He also pointed to the expansion of Metro rail services and improvements in road network. On the law-and-order front, the CM said reforms introduced by his govt improved public safety, particularly for women.

He also spoke about developments in agriculture, claiming better growth rates and timely sugarcane payments, with 92% of dues for the 2025-26 season already cleared. He said UP's per capita income had nearly trebled since 2017, while the state budget GSDP increased substantially without imposing additional tax burden on citizens.

Foundation stone for AMCA project to be laid

Defence minister Rajnath Singh and Andhra Pradesh CM N Chandrababu Naidu will on Friday lay the foundation stone for the Advanced Medium Combat Aircraft (AMCA) programme infrastructure in Sri Satthya Sai district on Friday, along with other defence projects, reports **Surendra Singh**. AMCA is India's 5th-gen, twin-engine stealth multirole fighter programme. "This facility for aircraft integration, testing, validation and certification would accelerate the development of the AMCA programme," a defence ministry statement said.

New Delhi: Exhorting defence scientists to accelerate R&D work, defence minister **Rajnath Singh** on Thursday said the "battlefield of tomorrow will reward those who can shorten the time between an idea, a prototype and operational deployment".

Addressing defence strategic dialogue Kalam & Kavach 3.0 in a video message here, Rajnath said, "A nation's strength will increasingly depend on how quickly its defence forces, labs, and industries think & act as one", underscoring the impor-

ance of self-reliance and jointness to secure strategic autonomy & remain future-ready for emerging security challenges.

In the presence of Italian and Armenian envoys, MoS defence Sanjay Seth told foreign delegates India's defence exports, which were a meagre Rs 686 crore a decade ago, have skyrocketed to a record high of Rs 38,424 crore today. He said annual defence production has touched an all-time high of Rs 1.54 lakh crore in 2025-26 and reaffirmed govt's resolve to achieve the target of Rs 50,000 crore of defence exports and Rs 3 lakh crore of defence production by '29-30.
