

Eight arrested for attack on pastor Abhinaya

It's a conspiracy as the incident was recorded and circulated on social media to disturb communal harmony, says SP

ALLURI Sitharama Raju District police have arrested eight persons in connection with the attack on Bharosa Party president and pastor Abhinaya Darshan at Neeruthotapalem village in GK Veedhi Mandal, describing it as a pre-planned conspiracy.

Superintendent of Police Amit Bardar said the accused mobilised locals from Dumbriiguda and nearby areas through inducements and monetary transactions.

Four men — Thangula Vasanth Kumar, Kumada Premkumar, Thangula Satyaranjan, and Kindangi Indra Kumar — physically assaulted Darshan as part of the plan.

Police revealed that the incident was recorded and circulated on social media to create fear, disturb communal harmony, and spread unrest.

Investigators linked the conspiracy to Darshan himself, along with Billa Kiran alias Kiran George, K Benhar, and Bhanu Prasad, noting coordinated mobilisation from Dumbriiguda and other villages.

They further connected the case to political activities of the Bharosa Party, founded by Darshan on March 26, 2026 in Kakinada during the first death anniversary of Pastor Praveen Pagadala.

The party has since engaged in campaigns, meetings with pastors, and outreach to minority and Christian communities in agency areas.

Police detailed activities between February 2 and 6, 2026, including meetings in Pedabada village, a campaign in Sunkarimetta, and submission of a

memorandum to the GK Veedhi MPDO on May 11, 2026. A rally was also held in Neeruthotapalem involving about 100 villagers under Vasuparthi Timothy, District President of Yesu Kristu Sangam, demanding justice for the attack.

The arrests were made under Sections 189(3), 196(2), 299, 3(5), 302 and 353(1) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

Supplementary inquiries have also exposed Darshan's personal controversies. Originally from Kadapa, he faces criminal cases

in Kadapa and Vizianagaram for dowry harassment, multiple marriages, and intimidation.

His first wife accused him of forcing loans in her name for personal luxuries and later discovering his secret marriages in Vijayawada and Vizianagaram. Police records show charges under IPC Sections 498-A, 494, and the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Officials said Darshan's activities — from fund raising under party banners to orchestrating rallies and social media campaigns (@andarivaduabhinay, Facebook page) — are under close watch.

Tribal hamlet vows to end child marriages in Kurnool

AT a time when child marriages in Kurnool district are drawing Statewide attention and concern, a remote tribal hamlet in Pattikonda mandal has emerged as a model for social reform. Villagers of JM Thanda unanimously passed a historic resolution on Wednesday pledging to completely eradicate child marriages from their village.

The special village meeting was conducted under the leadership of government school teacher M Kalyani Kumari (a shining teacher award) in the presence of Pathikonda Deputy MPDO Narasimulu. Villagers collectively vowed that they would not conduct marriages for



children below the legally permitted age and would immediately inform authorities through Child Helpline-1098 toll free number if anyone attempted to encourage or arrange child marriages.

The villagers declared that no child marriages, would be allowed in their community. Jana Vignana Vedika State convenor B Suresh has appreciated the rare collective decision.

300 migrant workers of Nellore rescued from bonded labour

MORE than 300 migrant labourers from Nellore district returned home on Wednesday after being freed from alleged bonded labour at brick kilns in Nizamabad district, Telangana.

The large-scale rescue was coordinated by district authorities in Telangana, led by Principal District Judge Bharath Laxmi, following a complaint to the State Legal Services Authority (SLSA) by an escaped worker from Nellore.

Families, including women, children, and elderly persons, were rescued from four kilns in Siddapur village, Nandipet mandal. Many had migrated from



Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, and Tamil Nadu after being promised wages and advances.

Preliminary testimonies revealed workers faced debt bondage, restricted movement, denial of wages, intimidation, and physical abuse. Survivors said they were forced to work long

hours daily and confined to the kiln premises for months or even years. Officials reported that several women and children were visibly malnourished, living in cramped tarpaulin shelters under extreme heat.

Children were allegedly engaged in brick-loading instead of attending school. One worker, Thupakula Babu of Nellore, lodged the complaint that triggered the operation, alleging illegal confinement and exploitation of multiple families.

Survivors said kiln operators issued grocery vouchers worth ₹200-₹400 weekly. Many were forced to sign blank bond papers and threatened with violence if they tried to leave.
