'No recruitment in Telangana Endowments department'

The State Endowments department has warned the public against a fake recruitment notification circulating online claiming vacancies for 190 Executive Officer posts. Officials clarified that no such recruitment advertisement has been released by the department and job aspirants were advised not to trust or respond to the false notification. All recruitment notifications are only through official government and departmental websites. The department further stated that strict legal action was being initiated through the cyber crime police against individuals responsible for creating and spreading the fake advertisement.

Three dead, six injured in two road accidents in A.P. districts

Two separate road accidents in Anakapalli and Visakhapatnam districts of Andhra Pradesh claimed three lives and left six others injured on Saturday. Two persons were killed and six others sustained injuries after the four-wheeler in which they were travelling rammmed into a lorry parked on NH-16 in Anakapalli district. In another incident, a 26-year-old man died after his two-wheeler came under the wheels of an APSRTC bus while he was trying to overtake it. The APSRTC bus was travelling from Srikakulam to Visakhapatnam at the time of the accident. The PM Palem police rushed to the spot and shifted the body for post-mortem.

5 killed as vehicle collides with lorry in Kalaburagi

Five persons were killed on the spot when the passenger vehicle they were travelling in collided with a lorry on National Highway 150 in the Kalaburagi district of Karnataka on Saturday. According to the police, the accident occurred around 12.30 a.m. when the vehicle collided with a lorry heading from Gujarat to Chennai. The lorry driver reportedly fled the scene. Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Minister Priyank Kharge expressed grief over the incident. "With a heavy heart, I pray for eternal peace to the departed souls. I hope the families find the strength to bear the loss of their loved ones," the Minister said.

India's second largest cricket stadium to come up in K'taka

Row over Kerala poll officer's appointment to CM's office

CPI(M) and the BJP Kerala unit question the move, with the left party alleging it casts doubt on the credibility of the Assembly polls; Chennithala defends appointment as the State govt.s prerogative

A political controversy has erupted over the appointment of Chief Electoral Officer (CEO - Kerala) Rathan U. Kelkar as Secretary to Chief Minister V.D. Satheesan. Both the Opposition Communist Party of India (Marxist) and the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) have questioned the motives behind the decision.

The CPI(M) State secretariat has alleged that the appointment puts a question mark over the credibility of the Assembly election. The government decision is unprecedented and endorses the Left Democratic Front's (LDF)

charge that the Election Commission of India (EC) had adopted measures favouring the Congress-led United Democratic Front (UDF), the CPI(M) said. The party also drew parallels with the appointment of Manoj Kumar Agarwal,

who oversaw the West Bengal Assembly election as CEO, as Chief Secretary to the new BJP government.

The CPI(M) and the BJP in Kerala also drew attention to Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's remark: 'The bigger the theft, the bigger

the reward', made over Mr. Agarwal's appointment. "So Rahul ji, what happened in Kerala, is it still 'reward for theft' or suddenly the beauty of democracy?", BJP leader K. Surendran posted on social media on Saturday.

It is understood that Mr. Kelkar was contacted on Friday and asked to join the new Chief Minister's team. Formal orders were issued on Saturday transferring Mr. Kelkar as Secretary to the Chief Minister.

Meanwhile, Home Minister Ramesh Chennithala defended the move, calling it the prerogative of the State government. He is a good officer. There is nothing unnatural in the appointment, he said.

Rift in AMMA over actor's allegations

The ongoing rift within the Association of Malayalam Movie Artists (AMMA) got murkier on Saturday with actor Ansiba Hassan accusing actor Tiny Tom and a section of the members of the forum of subjecting her to character assassination and making communal remarks targeting her. She cited the alleged harassment as the reason behind

her resignation from the organisation on February 21. Ms. Hassan was the joint secretary of AMMA.

Speaking to the media, the *Drishyam* actor alleged that Mr. Tom had accused her of attempting religious conversion, besides spreading rumours about her personal life.

Mr. Tom, meanwhile, rejected Ms. Hassan's allegations. "I am a person who works sincerely and speaks openly," he said.

Garment workers yet to see wage revision

Even as the Karnataka government's final notification on revised minimum wages for scheduled employees became available on Saturday, revision for 19 sectors – including garment, beedi and plantation workers – is yet to happen.

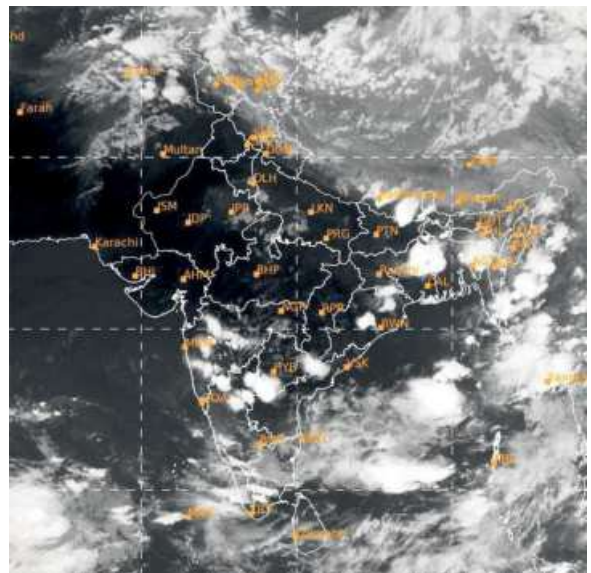
The minimum wages for 65 scheduled employees, including four in

hazardous ones, have now been revised and fixed. In addition, 18 employees – including non-teaching staff in educational institutions, employees of e-commerce and courier companies, and office staff of religious institutions such as temples, mutts, churches, mosques, and gurdwara – have been brought under the minimum wage.

The revision is expected to help over one crore employees in the State.

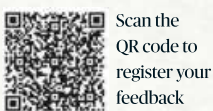
