

Reckless riding on NH 844; activists demand action

DHARMAPURI: Activists in Dharmapuri have urged police to take steps to stop dangerous motorcycle stunts performed by youth along NH 844 near Thadangam. On Sunday, videos went viral on social media, showing several youth doing dangerous stunts along the highway near the Butterfly bridge in Thadangam.

R Satishkumar Raja, from NGO 'My Dharmapuri', told *TNIE*, "The bridge is a key road connecting Dharmapuri and Neralur in Bengaluru. This road is busy, and heavy vehicles frequent it. Recently, several people have been conducting dangerous motorcycle races on the highway, putting their lives and others' at risk. I had reported the matter multiple times, but no action was taken." Another resident, B Nandhakumar from Nallampalli, said, "I have witnessed many youth gather at this road and disturb traffic flow."

The police told *TNIE*, "Efforts would be taken to improve patrol. Witnesses must note down vehicle registration number and report it."

Exam malpractice: Principal, two teachers of Salem pvt school held

A school principal and two mathematics teachers were arrested in connection with an alleged malpractice case during a Class 12 mathematics public examination, held on March 17 at a private school in Muthampatti near Vazhapadi.

According to sources, the incident came to light after the chief superintendent of the examination centre, a government school headmaster from Mettupatti, became suspicious after noticing students frequently leaving the examination hall to use the restroom.

On inspection, answers related to the mathematics examination were allegedly found pasted on the restroom walls, while two members of the private school staff were reportedly present in the area at the time. The matter was brought to the notice of Salem Chief Educational Officer P Maheswari on the same day.

102 prohibition cases filed in Krishnagiri district in 10 days

A total of 102 cases have been registered under the Tamil Nadu Prohibition (Amendment) Act and 512 litres of liquor stored or transported for illegal distribution have been seized in the district in the last 10 days, since the TVK formed government on May 10. Following Chief Minister C Joseph Vijay's order to close 717 Tasmac liquor outlets across the state, the government has also intensified its crackdown against drugs and illegal sale of liquor.

Police sources told *TNIE* that, based on the state government order, six Tasmac outlets were closed in the district. The personnel in all 31 law and order police stations and the three prohibition enforcement wing units at Hosur, Krishnagiri, and Uthangarai have been regularly monitoring the illegal sale of Tasmac liquor. Also, the police are patrolling on a daily basis to ensure liquor is not sold outside the permitted hours in nearly 111 Tasmac outlets in the district, added sources.

Extra ₹5: Tasmac staff in soup

Krishnagiri: Collector C Dinesh Kumar on Monday directed authorities concerned to take action against the salesman of a Tasmac outlet in Kaatinayanapalli for allegedly charging a customer extra ₹5. A video of the incident has gone viral on social media, in which the salesman was allegedly seen charging ₹5 extra for a bottle of alcohol costing ₹180, saying they need to bear loading, unloading, and other expenses.

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A source from the police department said, "During the same time, the district police have seized 35 kg of ganja and arrested eight persons. One more person was arrested for the possession of methamphetamine. The police are also planning to recommend the invocation of the Goondas Act against three suspects in the ganja cases."

Residents petition collector to shut 2 Tasmac outlets in sensitive zone

SEEKING the closure of Tasmac outlets (shop no. 2835 and 2875) in Marandahalli and Bommidhi, residents filed a petition with Collector R Sadheesh on Monday.

During the grievance day meeting, residents from Marandahalli and Bommidhi filed separate petitions, seeking the closure of Tasmac outlets in their area. S Kishore from Marandahalli said, "Tasmac shop (no. 2835) lies less than 50 m from a private school and 25 m from a temple. It also lies close to the state highway. Yet, when the state government

closed 717 Tasmac shops across the state, this shop was not included. Therefore, we staged a protest outside the Tasmac shop on Monday and filed a complaint with the collector seeking removal of the shop."

K Babu from Bommidhi said, "The Tasmac outlet (no. 2875) lies a few metres from the ration shop, a primary school and the local temple. Students passing by are harassed by tipplers outside the Tasmac outlet. Therefore, efforts should be taken to close down the outlet."

When *TNIE* reached out, officials in the administration said, "We will inquire and action will be taken."

Yercaud summer festival dates yet to be announced

Salem: Even as preparations are under way for the 49th Summer Festival and Flower Show in Yercaud, uncertainty continues over the dates, with no official announcement yet made by the district administration. In a consultative meeting held recently, the officials discussed whether the event should be conducted in the third or fourth week of May. However, officials indicated that the clarity on the summer festival schedule is likely only after the new collector takes charge.
