Indian Railways Introduces New Summer Special Train, Extends Patna–Khurda Services

BHUBANESWAR: To meet the surge in passenger demand during the summer season, Indian Railways has extended its weekly Summer Special train services between Patna Junction and Khurda Road, while also introducing a new weekly service between Virangana Lakshmbibai Jhansi and Khurda Road.

Train No. 03230 (Patna-Khurda Road) will now run till June 25, 2026, and Train No. 03229 (Khurda Road-Patna) till June 26, 2026, with no changes in timings, stoppages, or coach composition.

In addition, a new weekly Summer Special (01929/01930) has been



launched to enhance connectivity. Train No. 01929 will depart from Virangana Lakshmbibai Jhansi every Friday at 04:55 hrs and reach Khurda Road on Saturday at 19:30 hrs. In the return direction, Train No. 01930 will leave Khurda Road every Sunday at 00:35 hrs and arrive at Jhansi on Monday at 11:15 hrs.

‘Factually incorrect’

NEW DELHI: The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) on Wednesday dismissed as “factually incorrect” claims circulating in sections of the media that answer books under its On-Screen Marking (OSM) system were not scanned properly due to inadequate preparation and paucity of time.

In a post on X, the Board said every stage of the OSM system, including scanning, quality checks, marking and evaluation, was undertaken according to established procedures and under constant supervision. “A claim is circulating in the media that the scanning of answer books under OSM was not carried out properly due to inadequate preparation and paucity of time. This claim is factually incorrect,” the Board said.

“CBSE is a responsible national institution committed to ensuring fairness, transparency and integrity in the examination and evaluation process,” it added.

The Board also urged students and parents to rely only on official sources for verified information.

The court noted that it was not the petitioner's case that AAP obtained its registration through fraud or that the political party had intimidated to the Election Commission that it no longer had allegiance to the Constitution.

“The petition is bereft of any merit, which is resultantly dismissed,” it concluded.

On February 27, the trial court discharged Kejriwal, Sisodia and 21 others in the liquor policy case, as it ruled that the case was wholly unable to survive judicial scrutiny and stood discredited in its entirety.

NEW DELHI: The Delhi High Court on Wednesday dismissed a PIL seeking a direction to the Election Commission to deregister the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) and disqualify its chief Arvind Kejriwal and other leaders from contesting elections for boycotting HC proceedings in the liquor policy case.

A bench of Chief Justice D K Upadhyaya and Justice Tejas Karia said the petition by Satish Kumar Aggarwal was bereft of any merit and his contention was “too far-fetched, highly misconceived and misplaced”.

According to the public interest litigation (PIL), AAP was liable to be deregistered in terms of Section 29A(5) of the Representation of the People Act on account of its officer bearers and members -- Kejriwal, Manish Sisodia and Durgesh Pathak-boycotting the pro-



ceedings before Justice Swarana Kanta Sharma in the liquor policy case.

The counsel for the petitioner contended that while Section 29A(5) mandates a political party to “bear true faith and allegiance to the Constitution”, Kejriwal, Sisodia and Pathak failed to adhere to the constitutional principles when they “scandalised and politicised the entire system” in the liquor policy case.

“There is nothing on record to establish that the Respondent no. 3 (AAP) has admitted that it has no faith in the Constitution or the principles of secularism, socialism

or democracy,” the high court said.

The court stated that the Election Commission does not have the power to deregister a political party, and contempt of court proceedings have already been initiated against the politicians for their conduct.

The high court also ruled the petitioner's contention that Kejriwal and others ought to be disqualified for their lack of allegiance to the constitutional provision was “absolutely baseless”.

It added that the issue of their disqualification from contesting polls would arise only when there are any upcoming

Pradhan reviews NEET-UG re-exam security

Ordered strict action on fake Telegram channels spreading exam misinformation.

NEW DELHI: Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan chaired a high-level meeting with central security and intelligence agencies on Wednesday to review preparations for the upcoming NEET-UG re-examination, officials said.

He directed strict action against fake Telegram channels spreading misinformation related to the medical-entrance exam.

The minister stressed the need for heightened vigilance and foolproof security arrangements to ensure the safe, secure and fair conduct of the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (Undergraduate), according to officials.

Senior officials from the Ministry of Education and the director general of the National Testing Agency (NTA) were also present at the meeting, where preparations were reviewed in detail to ensure timely preventive and corrective measures.

At a parallel meeting with representatives of major social media platforms -- Meta, Google and Telegram -- serious concerns were raised over the growing spread of misinformation related to competitive examinations, particularly through Telegram chan-

nels and anonymous online groups, the officials said.

They said several such channels become highly active in the run-up to major examinations, circulating fake paper-leak claims, clickbait content and unverified information that create panic and confusion among students and parents.

“It was highlighted that many such links redirect users to automated bots and fake groups designed to amplify misinformation,” an official said.

According to inputs shared by intelligence agencies, multiple suspicious channels are being operated through a limited set of phone numbers, indicating coordinated and organised activity.

Taking strong note of the issue, Pradhan directed a focussed crackdown on such networks, including proactive identification, blocking and takedown of channels spreading fake information and propaganda before examinations.
