

Markets end lower for fourth straight session; Sensex sheds 508 pts, Nifty slips below 23,400

New Delhi, Jun 1 (FN Reporter)

Indian stock markets on Monday fell significantly from the day's high to close in the red for the fourth straight session. At close, Sensex was 508.40 points or 0.68percent lower at 74,267.34, while the Nifty ended 165.15 points or 0.7 percent lower at 23,382.60. Sensex fell 1,000 points from the day's high, while Nifty was trading below the 23,400-mark. Nearly 1,505 shares advanced, 2,665 shares declined, and 180 shares were unchanged. In the Nifty pack, Tech Mahindra was the top gainer. Infosys, Tata Consultancy Services, HCL Technologies, and Wipro were up 1.2-4.2percent. Hindustan Unilever, Nestle India, and Tata Consumer Products were among the laggards. The market capitalisation of BSE-

listed companies fell to Rs 460.70 lakh crore from Rs 464.97 lakh crore. Investors lost Rs 4.26 lakh crore in a day. Among the sectors, the Nifty FMCG index dropped 2%. Nifty PSU Bank, Nifty Consumer Durables, Nifty Chemicals, and Nifty Private Bank were also down more than 1% each. Nifty IT emerged as the top gainer, surging 2.62 percent. Over 140 stocks touched their 52-week high on the BSE, including NMDC Steel, Wockhardt, Kirloskar Oil, AIA Engineering, IFCI, Sona BLW, Netweb, Hitachi Energy, among others. Among the energy players, Suzlon Energy Limited ended 5.4percent lower while OLA Electric Mobility Limited lost 4.7percent of its value. Among Adani Group stocks, Adani Total Gas Limited and Adani Power Limited declined 5.1percent and 4.6 percent, respectively.

BRICS DRR Working Group meet in Puri from June 3, focus on disaster resilience

Odisha will host the Second Technical Meeting of the BRICS Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Working Group in Puri from June 3 to 5, with deliberations focusing on sustainable disaster risk reduction financing, resilient infrastructure, forecast-based action, and the integration of traditional knowledge into disaster management practices. Briefing reporters on Monday, Odisha Revenue and Disaster Management Minister Suresh Pujari said the state was selected to host the prestigious international event in recognition of its globally acclaimed achievements in disaster preparedness, cyclone management, and early warning systems. Describing the event as a matter of pride for Odisha, particularly for Puri, Pujari said the meeting would bring together policymakers, disaster management experts, and representatives from BRICS member and partner countries to strengthen cooperation in disaster risk reduction. The inaugural session on June 4 will be attended by Odisha Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi as the chief guest. Representatives and experts from BRICS nations, as well as various Indian states, are expected to participate in the three-day deliberations. The theme of the meeting is "Enhancing Disaster Resilience



through Innovation, Cooperation and Sustainability." BRICS, a major international intergovernmental organisation and geopolitical forum of emerging economies, comprises Brazil, Russia, India, China, South Africa, Saudi Arabia, Egypt, the United Arab Emirates, Ethiopia, Iran and Indonesia. Together, these countries account for nearly half of the world's population and more than one-third of global GDP. Pujari said the first technical meeting of the BRICS DRR Working Group was held virtually on April 29-30, 2026, under the chairmanship of India's National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA). The discussions in Puri will focus on a wide range of issues, including community-based disaster risk reduction governance, strengthening disaster risk financing mechanisms, multi-hazard early warning systems, climate-resilient infrastructure, nature-based and indigenous solutions, and the role of science, technology and innovation in disaster risk reduction. Technical sessions will deliberate on sustainable financing models for disaster risk reduction, inclusive early warning systems, climate-resilient infrastructure, and the integration of traditional knowledge and nature-based solutions into disaster management strategies. Delegates will also undertake a field visit to Ramachandi to witness a boat rescue demonstration exercise. According to the minister, the outcomes of the meeting

The Gandhi scion counselled the party functionaries and office bearers to keep live dialogue with grassroot party workers. His advisory for party workers was to establish direct rapport with the people. At the Kishangarh air strip, the LoP Lok Sabha said: "There is a good understanding and coordination between the party state president and the CLP leader, this may be ex-

emplary for other states." Besides, prominent leaders such as former Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot, party Rajasthan unit incharge Sukhjinder Singh Randhawa, AICC general secretary and former Rajasthan Deputy Chief Minister Sachin Pilot, presidents and other office bearers of 50 organisational district from Rajasthan and 15 organisational districts of the Delhi national capital, have been attending the camp along with their families. Gandhi also freely mingled and interacted with the family members. Many elderly party veterans were seen sharing fondly their experiences with the party dating back to the 1950s. The LoP also enjoyed a family photo shoot and selfies with participant families. The

Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge was also scheduled to visit. However, it was put off later for unavoidable reasons.
