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Court declares Mount Carmel 2017-18 tuition fee hike 'illegal', caps annual increase at 8%

IN NEARLY nine-year-old dispute over school fees, a Chandigarh civil court has declared illegal the monthly tuition fee hike imposed by Mount Carmel School, Sector 47, Chandigarh, for the 2017-18 academic session and directed the school to restrict the increase to 8 per cent over the previous year's fee structure.

The Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division) Sachin Yadav while disposing of the Civil Suit application filed by 349 parents against Mount Carmel School, Chandigarh Administration and the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), ordered, "Monthly tuition fee hiked by the Mount Carmel School Sector 47, Chandigarh, is declared illegal and the school is directed to increase the fee for the year 2017-18 and subsequent years at the rate of 8 per cent from the previous year and parents are only required to pay the increase of 8 per cent and not otherwise".

The applicants, parents Gurpreet Singh and others, had challenged the fee revision announced by the school in February 2017.

The parents through counsel Baljeet Singh, had contended that the school had "almost doubled" the monthly tuition fee, ranging from Rs 4,800 to Rs 4,975 per month for classes Nursery to XII, without any corresponding increase in facilities and without consulting parents, thereby violating the Rule 11.3 of the CBSE circular by revising fees.

The counsel further argued that the school "flatly refused to give a plausible explanation" for the hike and that the move had created "severe financial distress, uncertainty, and a dilemma among parents."

The Mount Carmel School, however, argued that the fee increase was only between 8.7 per cent and 11.3 per cent and no fee was doubled for any of the classes, as alleged by the parents.

Its counsel contended that the institution, being a private unaided school, required adequate funds to maintain infrastructure, pay staff and sustain educational standards.

The school also argued that several fee components had been clubbed into a single monthly charge and that the Punjab fee-regulation law relied upon by the parents was not applicable to Chandigarh in 2017.

The court on hearing the matter observed that, "The plaintiffs have failed to place on record any document which could show that the fee was doubled. Hence, the plea of plaintiffs that the fee was doubled is hereby rejected".

However, the court went on to hold that the school had failed to justify increasing fees beyond 8 per cent.

Referring to CBSE regulations, the court observed that, "the rules of CBSE were still applicable, which clearly shows that school is run as community service and not a business, which means that fee cannot be increased randomly by the school authorities."

COURT OF ADDITIONAL CIVIL JUDGE (SENIOR DIVISION) SACHIN YADAV

The order further held that, "Fee can only be increased at the minimum rate of either 8 per cent or if, the school is able to show some specific development in the building or any other specific reason, then the fee could have been increased for more than 8 per cent. But, it is not so in the present case".

Rejecting the school's justification based on inflation and quality education, the court said that Mount Carmel School has failed to show "what extra facilities were added in the year 2017-18 from the previous year, for which fee of more than 8 per cent was required to be increased".

The court also rejected the argument that the suit was not maintainable because the school society had not been impleaded through its secretary, holding that the school had been correctly impleaded through its principal who had issued the impugned notice.

It further held that payment of the revised fee by some parents during the pendency of the case did not amount to acceptance of the hike.

Concluding the matter, the court held that the school could only have increased the fee by 8 per cent, but they have increased the fee more than that, "which is wrong".

The court directed the school to correct its fee structure and issue a fresh notice. It ordered that fees for 2017-18 and subsequent years be increased only at the rate of 8 per cent from the previous year and held that parents are only required to pay the increase of 8 per cent and not otherwise.

The court ruled, "monthly tuition fee hiked by the defendant no.1 (Mount Carmel School) is declared illegal and defendant no.1 is directed to increase the fee for the year 2017-18 and subsequent years at the rate of 8% from the previous year and plaintiffs are only required to pay the increase of 8% and not otherwise."

It also restrained the school from charging fee beyond that level or refusing admission on that ground.

2 arrested for 'supplying' mule bank accounts used in cyber fraud network

THE CYBER Crime Police Station, Chandigarh, has arrested two persons for their alleged involvement in facilitating mule bank accounts that were purportedly used to route proceeds of cyber frauds reported across multiple states.

The accused have been identified as Salman Ansari (24), a resident of Mullanpur in Mohali district, and Bheem Saroj

(32), a resident of Chandigarh. According to police, the action was taken following information received from the Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C) under the Ministry of Home Affairs. During scrutiny of bank accounts operating in Chandigarh, investigators allegedly found links to fraud complaints registered on the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal from several states, including Delhi, Tamil Nadu, Goa, Maharashtra and Gujarat.
