

'Dummy bomb' in Pune placed for extortion: Police

TWO DAYS after a "bomb-like" object was found at the Ushakiran Superspecialty Hospital in Pune's Hadapsar, the probe by the Pune city police, Maharashtra Anti Terrorism Squad (ATS) and intelligence agencies has found there was no explosive material in the device.

Police said it was a "dummy bomb" placed in the hospital by a financially distressed man, who wanted to extort money from doctors. The ATS nabbed the suspect identified as Shivaji Rathod, aged around 30 years, from Nagpur railway junction on Friday. Police said there was no terror angle to the case. Hailing from Solapur, the accused is married and lived in Pune.

According to Dr Vilas Gaik-

wad, owner of the hospital, a woman staffer spotted the "bomb-like" object inside men's washroom on the first floor around 7 pm. Dr Gaikwad kept the suspicious object, with a timer showing a time of 7.10, in a box in an open space outside the hospital and informed the police within a few minutes. The Bomb Detection and Disposal Squad (BDDS) neutralised the object at the Gliding Centre in Hadapsar on Wednesday night.

Based on a complaint filed by a hospital employee, a case was lodged at the Hadapsar police station under Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) Section 109 (1) (attempt to murder) and Section 4 (punishment for attempt to cause explosion, or for making or keeping explosive with intent to endanger life or property) of the Explosive Substances Act.

NARRATES SUSPECTED TRAIL BEFORE DELHI COURT

NEET paper leak originated from within NTA, says CBI

THE NEET-UG paper leak, which has led to the exam's cancellation and sparked nationwide outrage, originated from within the National Testing Agency (NTA), the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has told a Delhi court. The central agency, which has made seven arrests in the case so far, explained the trail behind the alleged leak to the court on Friday.

The CBI has said that Shubham Khaimar, an Ayurveda student and the first to be arrested in the case from Maharashtra, got the paper from Dhananjay Lokhande. Lokhande, who knew Khaimar, is alleged to have got the paper from Pune-based Manisha Waghmare. Waghmare, it is alleged, got it from a "source in NTA". The CBI has said. Both Lokhande and Waghmare have been arrested and are now in the CBI's custody.

According to the CBI's submissions, Khaimar allegedly "facilitated accused Yash Yadav for distribution of leaked NEET (UG) 2026 question paper and accordingly on 29.04.2026, accused Yash Yadav got the PDF files of the NEET question papers through Telegram". The agency has recovered the PDF files containing papers of Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

The CBI also told the court that it wanted to ascertain the role of public servants in the leak after confronting the accused. Lokhande was produced in court on Friday. Five accused were produced in court on Thursday: Khaimar, Mangilal Biwal, Vikas Biwal, and Dinesh Biwal from Jaipur, and Yadav.

The accused, arrested in Maharashtra, Rajasthan and Haryana, have been brought to

Delhi on transit remand.

"Their remand is necessary as it was a larger conspiracy in the whole nation... Papers were leaked and distributed. We need to find the extent to which the accused persons had access to the public servants and how many people from the printing press were involved," the public prosecutor representing CBI told the court. On Friday, the public prosecutor said the investigation was ongoing and that Waghmare and Lokhande were allegedly involved in providing the papers to Khaimar. The agency provided the same grounds of arrest for all seven accused persons.

The CBI is learnt to have found that Khaimar allegedly informed Yash that Mangilal Biwal had approached him for "arranging leaked NEET UG 2026 question papers before the examination for his youngerson for 10-12 lakhs". According to the CBI, Mangilal allegedly contacted Yash on WhatsApp for the leaked papers.

Lavrov: Discussed increased energy supply with Modi and Jaishankar

Russian foreign minister: agreed to strengthen cooperation

ADAY before the US's waiver on sanctions on Indian imports of Russian oil is set to expire, Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov said Friday the topic of "increased supply of Russian energy" came up in his conversations with PM Narendra Modi and External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar on Thursday.

Lavrov, who was on a two-day visit to New Delhi for the BRICS Foreign Ministers' meeting, said he had a conversation with Modi and negotiations with Jaishankar. "We discussed the key areas of our privileged strategic partnership that were defined during the summits between President Putin and Prime Minister Modi...We agreed to strengthen transport cooperation and investment cooperation, including the development of the international transport corridor...We also discussed the steps that are being

taken to improve the system of direct mutual settlements and we discussed the increased supply of Russian energy, fertilisers and cooperation in the field of peaceful nuclear energy," Lavrov said regarding his interactions with Prime Minister Modi and Jaishankar.

When asked about the increased supply of Russian energy to India, Lavrov said the data was out in the public domain. "It's not a secret statistic... This information shows that oil supplies to India increased and it does not depend on us, it depends on our Indian counterparts that always received a positive answer towards their request for supplying more energy. This is how we continue moving," he said. During the BRICS Foreign Ministers' meeting, Lavrov said the focus was on preparation for the 18th BRICS summit to be held in India later this year. The situation in West Asia, including Strait of Hormuz, Lebanon and Palestine, was discussed as well, he said. When asked about the conflict between two BRICS members, Iran and the UAE, Lavrov said BRICS was not the organisation for mediating, but some of its member states, like India, could. He noted Pakistan's role in the talks between the US and Iran.

8 of 14 held after 'Iftar on Ganga' in Varanasi get bail

THE ALLAHABAD High Court on Friday granted bail to eight men accused of allegedly disposing of leftover chicken biryani into the Ganga at Varanasi during an iftar party in March. A detailed order is awaited.

Fourteen men, all in their 20s, were arrested in connection with the case, spending nearly two months behind bars. The men were accused of "hurting religious sentiments", "defiling" a place of worship and "extortion", as well as charges under the Pollution Act. Friday's hearing was for 11 accused. The hearing for the remaining three is listed for Monday. On March 17, police had initiated action after a video of the alleged incident aboard a motorboat went viral on social media. Officials said the footage was purportedly uploaded by the accused themselves.
