

EESL moots advanced technology in energy & water efficiency

EESL CEO Akhilesh Kumar Dixit approves implementation of a roadmap designed to strengthen long-term sustainability of small and medium enterprises in AP

IN a major boost to sustainable industrial development in Andhra Pradesh, the Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL), under the Ministry of Power, Government of India, has finalised a comprehensive and time-bound action plan aimed at transforming the MSME ecosystem across the State through advanced global technologies in energy and water efficiency.

The initiative follows the grand success of the AP MSME Growth Summit 2026 organised

by the Industries Department, Government of AP, and reflects the State Government's strong commitment towards industrial modernisation, green growth and sustainable economic development.

EESL Chief Executive Officer Akhilesh Kumar Dixit, in consultation with the AP MSME Development Corporation (APMSME-DC), has approved an extensive implementation roadmap designed to strengthen the long-term economic sustainability of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in Andhra Pradesh. The initiative is expected to

significantly reduce operational and maintenance costs for MSMEs, improve industrial productivity and competitiveness, generate large-scale green employment opportunities, promote efficient utilisation of energy and water resources.

EESL thanked Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu for fully supporting the implementation of global advanced technologies and handing over the work order issued by APMSME-DC to EESL at the AP MSME Growth Summit 2026 in the presence of Ministers for Industries and MSMEs TG Bharat and K Srinivas, Industries Secretary N Yuva Raj and APMSME CEO M Viswa.



The ceremonial handover marked the official operational launch of one of India's most ambitious MSME sustainability and industrial efficiency initiatives under the Government of India's RAMP (Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance) Programme and AP MSME & Entrepreneur Development Policy 4.0. Under the approved scope of work, EESL will undertake implementation of advanced technologies across MSME clusters in the State.

The initiative includes capacity-building workshops across industrial clusters, cluster mapping and diagnostic studies for 15 industrial clusters, investment-grade energy audits for 452 MSMEs, water audits for 300 MSMEs and deployment of advanced energy-efficient and water-efficient technologies.

The programme aims to enable MSMEs to adopt modern

industrial practices that reduce costs, improve efficiency, enhance global competitiveness and ensure sustainable industrial growth. A major highlight of the initiative is its significant potential to generate direct and indirect employment opportunities across AP while building a robust green industrial ecosystem.

Officials said the initiative could pave the way for the emergence of a completely new green industrial services economy in the state by creating demand for skilled professionals, auditors, technicians, startups, Energy Service Com-

panies (ESCOs), technology manufacturers and sustainability experts. N Yuvaraj stated that the current Phase-I implementation is only the beginning of a much larger transformational industrial opportunity for Andhra Pradesh.

EESL opined that strategic partnerships with industrially progressive states such as Gujarat, Maharashtra, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh would help in creating a favourable ecosystem for implementation of advanced industrial technologies and sustainable manufacturing practices.

APSDMA predicts light to moderate rains and thunderstorms today

ANDHRA Pradesh is expected to witness a mix of thunderstorms, lightning and intense heat conditions on Monday, according to the Andhra Pradesh State Disaster Management Authority (APSDMA).

APSDMA Managing Director Prakhar Jain said varying weather conditions would continue across the state due to a trough extending from a cyclonic circulation over Vidarbha through North Coastal Andhra Pradesh and the west-central and adjoining north-west Bay of Bengal.

The weather system is likely to bring light to moderate rain accompanied by thunderstorms and lightning in Anantapur, Sri Sathya Sai, Kadapa, Anantapur and Chittoor.

Scattered light rain with thunderstorms is also expected

in other districts of the state.

Jain advised people not to take shelter under trees, electric poles or hoardings during thunderstorms. Farmers and cattle rearers have been urged to move to safe locations immediately when dark clouds gather and thunder is heard.

At the same time, high temperatures are expected to prevail in several districts. Temperatures between 42°C and 44°C are likely at isolated places in Polavaram, Eluru, Krishna, NTR, Guntur, Markapuram, Bapatla, Palnadu, Prakasam and Nellore districts.

Temperatures ranging from 40°C to 42°C may be recorded in parts of Parvathipuram Manam, Alluri Sitharama Raju, East Godavari, West Godavari, Nandyal, YSR Kadapa and Tirupati districts. On Sunday, the highest temperature of 44.3°C was recorded at Achampet in Palnadu district.

Cricket betting gang nabbed, ₹11L seized

PRODDATUR II Town Police arrested 13 people on Sunday for their alleged involvement in an organised cricket betting syndicate and seized cash, mobile phones, and electronic devices used in the operation.

Assistant Superintendent of Police U Vibhu Krishna said the crackdown followed credible information about betting activities in the town.

Acting on his directions, Inspector P Vamsinath and his team first detained Sheikh Javed, also known as Balaji, and his maternal uncle Sheikh Jilani, who were allegedly running betting networks. Interrogation revealed a wider syndicate operating across the region.

Special teams later raided premises near the Tea Move-



ments Shop close to KMH Function Hall on the Yerraguntla Bypass road, arresting 13 suspects. Police seized ₹11.34 lakh in cash and froze ₹14.12 lakh in bank accounts linked to the network, securing assets worth a total of ₹25.46 lakh. Seventeen mobile phones

and a tablet allegedly used for betting transactions were also confiscated.

Investigators said Javed and Jilani recruited associates and coordinated betting through mobile phones, WhatsApp groups, online applications, UPI transfers, and other digital

Sex determination test racket unearthed

CHITTOOR District police busted an illegal foetal sex determination racket in Bangarupalyam mandal and arrested four people for conducting unlawful gender identification tests on pregnant women. A scanning machine used in the operation was seized.

Acting on the directions of District Superintendent of Police Tushar Dudi, police intensified efforts to

curb violations of the PCPNDT Act and protect the rights of girl children.

Based on credible information, a raid was conducted on May 30 at an under-construction house near Chandrasekharapuram village in Ragimanupenta panchayat.

The operation was carried out by Bangarupalyam Inspector Katti Srinivasulu, SI Ari Prasad, police personnel, and Health Department officials under the supervision of Palamaner

DSP.

Authorities found that illegal tests were being conducted on pregnant women brought from Tamil Nadu and Karnataka. One suspect escaped, while others present were taken into custody.

During interrogation, the accused admitted to charging around ₹10,000 per woman and falsely claiming to operate an authorised scanning centre. Police identified 14 victims and recorded their statements.
