

50 CPI(M) members held for protest against the ED

New Delhi: Around 50 CPI (M) leaders and workers were detained by Delhi police during a protest near the ED headquarters against searches conducted at former Kerala CPI (M) leader Pinarayi Vijayan's residence, a senior police officer said.

According to the police officer, the general secretary, M A Baby, and other party leaders, including Vijay Krishnan and Vinoda Karan, were detained. The CPI(M) leaders had organised a march towards the ED office. But they were detained 300 metres from the ED office. Police said all the detained leaders and workers were later released.

"Several individuals whose names reportedly appeared in the CMLR diary continue to hold important posts in the state government. However, while ignoring all of them, the continuous targeting of Pinarayi Vijayan further exposes the political vendetta behind these actions," Baby told reporters.
