

Colonel dismissed, gets 3 yrs in jail for outraging modesty of woman officers

A GENERAL Court Martial of the Army on Thursday ordered to dismiss a Colonel of the Army Medical Corps (AMC) from service and sentenced him to three years rigorous imprisonment (RI) for outraging the modesty of two woman officers — one Major and the other a Captain.

The Colonel and the woman officers were posted as doctors at the Military Hospital, Nasirabad in Rajasthan.

The Colonel was attached to Headquarters 97 Artillery Brigade where he faced the Court Martial for sexual misconduct towards the female officer. The sentence will become effective when confirmed by higher authorities.

A charge sheet issued on October 24, 2025 by Commander 97 Artillery Brigade accused the Colonel of six offences under the Army Act.

He has been found guilty of five charges and not guilty on the sixth charge.

The General Court Martial was ordered by Major General Adarsha Verma, General Officer Commanding, 41 Artillery Division, on October 25, 2025.

CONFLICT SPARKS SHORTAGE OF 2 COMMON CHEMOTHERAPY DRUGS

Chemo patients bear the brunt of war in West Asia

TWO COMMONLY used, affordable chemotherapy medicines—Cisplatin and Carboplatin—have gone off the shelves across the country over the last two weeks, prompting oncologists to raise an alarm. This is because of the increase in prices of raw materials, fuelled by the Hormuz crisis, and the inability of companies to raise prices since they are under the government's price control ambit, according to industry experts.

“Our hospital pharmacy has run out of Cisplatin and Carboplatin. Nearly seven in 10 patients in my clinic need one of these drugs. They are prescribed for oral, lung, cervical, oesophageal, ovarian, and breast cancer, among others. Now, we have cancer patients running from one store to the other in search of this medicine. My colleagues in other cities are also facing a similar situation,” said Dr Shyam Agarwal, chairman of medical oncology at Sir Gangaram Hospital.

of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi, echoed a similar concern: “There has been a shortage of these drugs for at least the last two weeks.” Another Delhi-based oncologist said that lower doses have completely gone off the shelves though higher doses are still available in some stores.

In Mumbai, Dr Mohan Menon, medical oncologist at Lilavati Hospital and Research Centre, said that there has been a shortage of all platinum-derived chemotherapy agents, adding the root cause of the failure

is the increase in prices of platinum globally. “This precious metal was trading at Rs 2,700 per gram in mid-2023 but has now skyrocketed to over Rs 7,800 per gram,” he said. Wholesalers and stockists, meanwhile, are fast running out of supplies. The owner of a major retail pharmacy in Delhi said: “Almost no medical store in the country has these medicines at the moment. Most stockists and wholesalers have run out of them. With the limited stock they have, they are saying they will sell it directly to

patients instead of retailers.”

While the increasing cost of raw materials has elevated prices of many medical products, especially those based on petrochemicals, since the start of the war, the companies producing these two drugs have maintained the prices. These medicines come under Drug Pricing Control Order (DPCO), which regulates the prices of all essential medicines in the country. Any drug under the DPCO can only increase its price in tandem with the average rise in wholesale prices each year.

While the prices of platinum have been going up—owing to a deficit in the world's largest supplier, South Africa, and the growing usage of the metal in the automotive sector besides in production of green hydrogen—the current West Asia crisis has added fuel to the fire. “Most of India's platinum is imported from Gulf countries, which have been impacted due to the current conflict,” said an industry expert, who did not wish to be named. United Arab Emirates is the biggest supplier of platinum for India, accounting for nearly half the imports.

Tata Memorial study finds radiation cuts bladder cancer recurrence risk by over 50%

A MAJOR clinical trial led by Tata Memorial Hospital (TMH), Mumbai, and conducted across four Indian cancer centres over eight years has found that radiation therapy after bladder removal surgery can reduce the risk of cancer returning to the pelvis by more than half.

The findings of the Bladder Adjuvant Radiotherapy (BART) trial were recently published in the ‘Journal of Clinical Oncology,’ one of the world's leading cancer research journals. “When bladder cancer recurs in the pelvis, treatment options are limited and survival is often measured in months. Our study shows that radiation after bladder removal surgery can significantly reduce the risk of pelvic recurrence with manageable side effects,” said Dr Vedang Murthy, professor, Department of Radiation Oncology, Tata Memorial Centre, and lead investigator of the BART trial.

Bladder cancer is among the most difficult and expensive cancers to diagnose and treat. According to the International

Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC), it is the ninth most common cancer worldwide. More than six lakh people were diagnosed with the disease globally in 2022. In India, data from the Global Cancer Observatory (2022) estimates around 22,548 new cases and 12,353 deaths annually, making it the country's 17th most common cancer. The disease disproportionately affects men, with tobacco consumption among the major risk factors.

Muscle-invasive bladder cancer is a particularly aggressive form of the disease. Standard treatment typically involves chemotherapy followed by surgical removal of the bladder and surrounding organs, including the prostate in men or uterus in women, along with nearby lymph nodes. Patients then undergo reconstructive procedures to create an alternative pathway for urine after bladder removal.

“Patients go through extensive treatment, yet nearly two-thirds develop recurrent disease within three years,” said Dr Murthy. “Some recurrences occur in distant organs such as the lungs or bones. However, in

roughly a quarter of high-risk patients, the cancer returns in the pelvis where the bladder was originally located. These relapses are especially devastating because there are very few effective treatment options once they occur. This is the challenge we set out to address.”

The BART trial enrolled 153 patients, who had undergone surgery for bladder cancer. Half the participants received radiation therapy to the pelvis after surgery, while the remaining patients were placed under observation.

“The results were clear. Radiation reduced the risk of cancer returning to the pelvis by more than 50 per cent,” Dr Murthy said. In the trial, fewer than five per cent of patients experienced severe side effects, while most treatment-related symptoms were temporary and improved after therapy ended. The significance of the study extends beyond India. While immunotherapy drugs such as nivolumab and pembrolizumab have shown benefits in reducing recurrence, their high cost remains a major barrier in many parts of the world.

Southwest monsoon hits Kerala, IMD forecasts heavy rainfall until June 7

THE IMD on Thursday announced the onset of southwest monsoon over Kerala, marking the beginning of the four-month long season. The normal

onset date is June 1, with a deviation of seven days. This year, the onset has been realised three days after the normal date, IMD said.

This year, the Met office has forecast below-normal rainfall over the country. Quanti-

tatively, it is expected to be 90% of the Long Period Average, which is 870 mm (1971-2020). This subdued rain forecast is mainly in view of the developing El Nino condition—a global, naturally occurring ocean-atmospheric phenomenon

along the equatorial Pacific Ocean.

Even though Kerala has been reporting heavy rain since last week, the IMD maintains some criteria, all of which when satisfactorily met, declares the monsoon onset over Kerala.
