Maheshwari, BV Nagarathna and MM Sundresh, has sought to balance regional representation, judicial seniority, merit and gender diversity in the composition of the apex court.

Among the recommended judges, Justice Sheel Nagu currently heads the Punjab and Haryana High Court. Originally from the Madhya Pradesh High Court, he was elevated as a judge there in 2011 before being appointed chief justice of the Punjab and Haryana high court in 2024. He is known for his work in constitutional, service and administrative law matters.

His elevation also paves way for justice Ashwani Kumar Mishra as CJ of Punjab and Haryana HC. Mishra comes from UP and senior-most judge at HC right now.

Justice Shree Chandrashekhar, presently the chief justice of the Bombay High Court, began his judicial career in the Jharkhand High Court and was elevated as a judge there in 2013. He took over as chief justice of the Bombay High Court last year after serving as acting chief justice of the Jharkhand High Court.

Justice Sanjeev Sachdeva, who was originally a judge of the Delhi High Court and recently appointed chief justice of the Madhya Pradesh High Court, has handled several important constitutional, commercial and criminal law matters during his tenure on the bench. Before elevation as a judge in 2013, he had an extensive practice in the Delhi High Court and the Supreme Court.

Justice Arun Palli, who presently heads the Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh High Court, began practice at the Punjab and Haryana high court in 1988 and was designated senior advocate in 2007. Elevated as a judge in 2013, he dealt with constitutional, labour, civil and criminal matters before being appointed chief justice last year.

The recommendation of senior advocate V Mohana assumes particular significance as it would add another woman judge to the Supreme Court, which currently has only one woman judge—Justice BV Nagarathna.

A leading member of the Supreme Court Bar, Mohana graduated from Coimbatore Law College in 1988 as part of the institution's first five-year law course batch. She initially trained under advocate M Panchapakesan before moving to New Delhi, where she worked with former SC judge Justice Indu Malhotra and senior advocate CS Vaidyanathan.

After clearing the Advocate-on-Record examination in 1996, Mohana began independent practice in the Supreme Court, Delhi High Court and other forums including the National Consumer Commission.

Over the years, she appeared alongside several leading legal luminaries including Kapil Sibal, KK Venugopal, P Chidambaram, Arun Jaitley and TR Andhyarujina.

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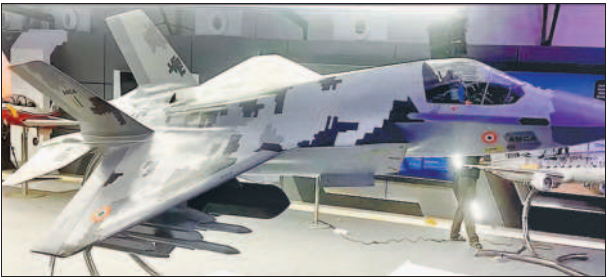
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Centre invites 3 bidders to produce 5 AMCA prototypes

NEW DELHI: The Defence ministry on Wednesday issued Request for Proposals (RFPs) to three short-listed bidders for the development and production of five prototypes of the Advanced Medium Combat Aircraft (AMCA) at an estimated cost of ₹15,000 crore, paving the way for a second fighter jet production facility in India besides that of Hindustan Aeronautics Limited. The three shortlisted bidders are: Tata Advanced Systems Limited (TASL); Larsen and Toubro plus Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL), and Bharat Forge plus Bharat Earth Movers Limited. Powered by an American GE-414 engine, the AMCA will be produced under the design and expertise of Aeronautical Development Agency (ADA) of the DRDO. While the first prototype of the

with 120 KM French Safran engines made in India.

This month, the foundation stone was laid for the ₹15,803 crore Integration and Flight Testing Complex at Puttaparthi in Andhra Pradesh with the Cabinet Committee on Security giving a green signal to development of the five prototypes. Featuring supercruise, inter weapons bays, and advanced AI, the AMCA will compete with stealth fighter jets such as the US F-35, Chinese J 20 and Russian Su-57 fighters in the near future. The fighter will ultimately replace the Su-30 MKI fighters and will have long-range indigenously developed Astra air-to-air missile, air-to-surface missiles, laser-guided and glide bombs with

top-of-the line radar and sensors to avoid detection by enemy air defence systems. While the Indian Air Force has proposed the acquisition of two squadrons of Russian SU-57 through the "Make in India" route, the government is still to take a call on the IAF requirement. As it is, the stealth capabilities of fifth generation fighters have come into question with vintage Iranian air defence systems damaging an American F35 using a heat-seeking missile during the on-going West Asia war. Given the current geopolitics where each country is protecting its own interest, it is important that the Indian private sector shows its worth by producing a fifth gen fighter outside the HAL facilities.

Cabinet okays AI use to select beneficiaries of PDS, ration delivery

NEW DELHI: India's public distribution system (PDS) could soon start using artificial intelligence (AI) to track food grain movement, handle citizen complaints on WhatsApp and phone calls, and identify beneficiaries in real time under the ₹25,530 crore extension of the 'Scheme for Assistance in Ration Transport and Handling-Income with Automation in PDS' (Sarthak-PDS) scheme, approved by the Cabinet on Wednesday.

The scheme now extends for five more years from April 2026 to March 2031 and aims to modernise the country's PDS, which distributes subsidised food grains through ration shops.

As part of the upgrade, the government plans to introduce three AI-enabled systems under SMART PDS Phase 2, with extended support from the India AI Mission under the IT ministry.

Union information & broadcasting minister Ashwini Vaishnaw, speaking at a media briefing on cabinet decisions in New Delhi, said the Cabinet approved three major reforms to Sarthak-PDS: financial assistance to states for internal movement of food grains, support for fair price shops, and funding for wider PDS modernisation.

"This is a huge structural reform in the PDS system, in the entire delivery system, logistics, transportation, material handling and for redressal of grievances of the PDS beneficiaries," Vaishnaw said.

"Under this programme, a basic ration is provided to 800 million citizens every month," the union minister said.

AI overhaul in PDS

One of the AI systems, NIRMAL, will create a real-time, AI-based registry of PDS beneficiaries and enable integration with other government schemes and ministries.

A second system, ASHA, will be a multilingual AI grievance platform able to interact with citizens through calls, WhatsApp, IVRS and chatbots.

The government says ASHA can handle up to 300,000 interactions a day, up from the current 200,000 calls made to beneficiaries each month.

The third system, SAKSHAM, will apply AI to supply-chain management, including vehicle tracking, QR-code tracing of food-grain bags, demand forecasting and route optimisation.
