

Allegations not enough to apply criminal law on husband, kin: SC

‘Victims’ Dignity Paramount But Can’t Enforce Law Indiscriminately’

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Monday said criminal law cannot be permitted to be set in motion against every relative of the husband in a matrimonial dispute merely on the basis of omnibus allegations lacking a specific factual foundation.

The top court said that while safeguarding the rights and dignity of victims of domestic violence remains of paramount importance, the courts are simultaneously required to ensure that the rigours of criminal law are not indiscriminately extended to every family member without a clear factual foundation.

It said when matrimonial relationships deteriorate and bitterness sets in, there is a natural tendency for allegations to be amplified or broadly worded out of anger, frustration or emotional distress.

"While the anguish of a complainant in a failed marriage cannot be lightly disregarded, equally, criminal law

cannot be permitted to be set in motion against every relative of the husband merely on the basis of generalised and omnibus allegations lacking a specific factual foundation," a bench of Justices Sanjay Karol and N Kotiswar Singh said.

It said courts are required to exercise greater caution and carefully scrutinise whether the allegations genuinely disclose the commission of cognisable offences against each accused individually, lest the criminal process itself becomes a "tool of harassment and misuse".

The observations came in a verdict which quashed a 2023 FIR lodged in Madhya Pradesh for alleged offences, including under the provisions of the Dowry Prohibition Act, against four family members of a man who was embroiled in a matrimonial dispute.

The bench also quashed

the proceedings initiated by the complainant against them in a separate complaint under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act.

The top court noted that during the pendency of proceedings before it, a decree of divorce was granted by a family court dissolving the marriage between the man and the complainant.

It said its verdict shall not operate as a bar to the trial court "exercising its power under Section 319 CrPC to summon the present appellants, if during the course of trial, evidence emerges before it which, in the opinion of the trial court, is sufficient to proceed against them for any of the offences alleged".

It said the court is equally conscious of the reality that genuine cases of cruelty and domestic violence do occur within the confines of the matrimonial home and often remain concealed from public gaze. ¶¶

Twisha case: Cops grill hubby, mom-in-law

Bhopal: Police have begun detailed questioning of retired judge Giribala Singh and her lawyer son Samarth Singh in connection with the death of his wife Twisha Sharma, who was allegedly harassed for dowry, officials said on Monday.

The information provided by the two accused is being verified, they said, adding that no conclusion has been reached so far.

Samarth Singh, who is currently in police custody, has apparently told investigators that their relations turned sour after Twisha became pregnant, according to sources.

The questioning by police comes even as the Madhya Pradesh government has recommended a CBI probe into the Twisha Sharma case, which has triggered widespread public attention.

The case has snowballed into a massive national controversy, given the background of the accused.

Investigators were separately questioning retired district judge Giribala Singh, who has secured anticipatory bail, and her son Samarth Singh, and cross-verifying their statements, a senior police officer said, re-

questing anonymity.

"We have questioned Giribala Singh. The process takes time. Her son Samarth Singh, who is in police custody, is also being interrogated. Information given by one accused is being verified with the other," the official said.

The investigation is still underway, and no final conclusion has been reached so far, he said.

"As of now, the case appears to be one of suicide, but the investigation is continuing. It would be premature to draw any conclusion at this stage," he added. The police have registered an FIR against Samarth Singh and his mother on charges of harassment for dowry.

Plea against bail to Giribala Singh adjourned by HC

Jabalpur: The Madhya Pradesh High Court on Monday adjourned to May 27 the hearing on pleas challenging the anticipatory bail granted to former judge Giribala Singh in connection with the death of her daughter-in-law, Twisha Sharma. The matter came up before the single bench of Justice Devnarayan Mishra. During the proceedings, Giribala Singh's counsel, George Carlo, submitted that his client had not yet received a copy of the petition filed by Twisha's father and requested additional time.

Carlo further argued that the two pleas, filed by Navnidhi Sharma and the Madhya Pradesh government, seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail were based on different grounds and required separate replies. The HC on Friday issued notices to Giribala Singh, who is currently serving as chairperson of the Bhopal Consumer Court. ¶¶
