KUWAIT
Airspace closed over attacks

Kuwait on Thursday said it closed its airspace over ongoing Iranian attacks. Kuwait's Directorate General of Civil Aviation made the announcement. It said flights were being diverted to other airports, without elaborating. Flights circled outside of Kuwait for some time before the announcement, after the military announced its air defences were firing. "This measure comes in light of the state of Kuwait being subjected to sinful Iranian aggressions and the potential risks that may result from this on civil aviation traffic in the region," Kuwait said.(AP)

Jaishankar meets Finnish FM

External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar on Thursday held talks with his Finnish counterpart Elina Valtonen on India-Finland strategic partnership and discussed cooperation across a range of emerging technology sectors. "Agreed to deepen trade & investment, while maintaining the momentum of our political engagement," Jaishankar posted on social media.

The two ministers discussed collaboration on startups, artificial intelligence, semiconductors, critical minerals, quantum technologies, 6G, clean energy and space, according to the post.

"Finland and India have excellent bilateral relations," Valtonen reiterated in a social media post after

meeting Jaishankar. "We will continue deepening our trade ties and see significant potential in digitalisation and sustainability."

The meeting comes months after India and Finland elevated their bilateral relationship to a strategic partnership in digitalisation and sustainability during Finnish President Alexander Stubb's visit to India earlier this year.

During that visit, PM Narendra Modi and Stubb had announced the partnership, with Modi noting that relations between India and Europe were entering a "golden era," a sentiment which was further reinforced by the conclusion of the India-EU Free Trade Agreement in January. The deal, concluded after nearly two decades of negotiations, covers a market of two billion people and roughly a quarter of the global GDP.

Following the bilateral meeting, Jaishankar is scheduled to attend the 14th edition of the Kaltaranta Talks, themed "A World in Transition: Global, Regional and Local Perspectives", and engage with Finnish leadership and other participants. The annual dialogue, hosted by the Finnish president, brings together senior leaders and policymakers to discuss global and regional security challenges.

Meanwhile, Jaishankar has pushed for "dialogue and diplomacy" as the only solution amid ongoing multiple conflicts and reiterated India's stance that this is "not an era of war."

Jaishankar made these remarks on Wednesday after the meeting with his Bulgarian counterpart Velislava Petrova-Chamova.



Drone strikes by Sudanese forces kill 15 people

Sudanese paramilitary forces carried out drone strikes overnight in central Sudan, killing at least 15 people and wounding dozens, health officials said Thursday, as the use of unmanned aircraft becomes increasingly common in the more than three-year war in the African country.

The attacks, which started late Wednesday, targeted various areas of the city of el-Obeid, including near an army position, according to two health officials at el-Obeid Hospital, which received the victims. More than 10 people were also wounded, some critically, the officials said, speaking on condition of anonymity because they were not authorised to speak to the media.

The war in Sudan erupted in April 2023, after long-simmering tensions between the army and paramilitary Rapid Support Forces, or RSF. The conflict has killed at least 59,000 people, displaced some 13 million, and pushed many parts of the country into famine. More

than 30 million people need humanitarian assistance.

Dr Mohamed Elsheikh, a spokesperson with Sudan Doctors Network, which tracks casualty tolls, told The Associated Press that in el-Obeid, RSF drones also hit a funeral gathering at a cemetery, killing four people there, and a gas station. He could not immediately confirm if the casualties were civilians, combatants or both.

An aid worker with Mercy Corps told the AP that drone attacks have intensified across el-Obeid in recent days, targeting gatherings of people in the city. The worker, who spoke on condition of anonymity for fear of reprisals, said schools have suspended classes and markets are only partially open because of the attacks.

Emergency Lawyers, a local aid monitoring group, said Thursday the toll is likely to increase as drones were still flying over the city.

The group said homes near the military headquarters of the 5th Infantry Division in el-Obeid were hit, as well as a truck carrying food supplies into the city. Its driver was killed, the group said. (AP)

Pakistan criticises India's remarks on PoK

Pakistan on Thursday criticised India's recent remarks on Pakistan-occupied Kashmir, asserting that it was addressing the issues related to the protests in the region within a democratic and constitutional framework.

On Tuesday, India came down hard on Pakistan for its "brutality" against people in PoK and called on the international community to hold that country accountable for its "abuses".

India's reaction came as over 20 people were reportedly killed in police action on protesters in several parts of PoK.

Responding to questions during



his weekly media briefing, Foreign Office spokesperson Tahir Andrabi on Thursday said Pakistan rejected India's statements "in their entirety."

He also rejected any effort to

compare the political situation on the two sides of the Line of Control (LoC). The situation in PoK is being addressed "within a democratic and constitutional framework," he said.

"Any attempt to conflate the two is misleading and does not withstand objective scrutiny".

Reacting to a statement made by an Indian minister, Andrabi warned that any attempt by India to block water would be treated as "an act of war". "Pakistan will take all necessary measures to safeguard its economy and its vital national interests and the lives of its 250 million people," he said.

He said that Pakistan firmly rejected any notion that water can be treated as a political tool or instrument of coercion or a weapon. "Such actions would threaten not just regional peace and security of South Asia and beyond...", he stated. (PTI)

Apart from her, the event was attended by the principal and senior staff of the college and the office-bearers of Aitchison College Old Boys Association.

"A plaque has been placed outside classroom 108 of

Senior School and a photograph of Harcharan Singh Brar wearing the college blazer has been hung inside the classroom," Dr Tarunjit Singh Butalia, honorary envoy at the Aitchison College, told PTI on Thursday.

mate and lifelong friend at the institution, wrote the text of the plaque that his daughter unveiled.
