

Six cops suspended for nexus with matka gangs

TIRUPATI District Superintendent of Police L Subbarayudu suspended six police personnel, including officers and constables, for nexus with gambling syndicate and extending support to matka gangs. Following the allegations against the cops, a detailed enquiry has been conducted, and the SP confirmed the nexus between the police and gambling operators and issued orders for the suspension of cops.

The suspended officers include two circle inspectors and four constables. A charge memo was also issued to a Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP).

The suspended officials include Srikalahasti One Town CI Prakash Kumar, CI Gopi (currently posted at Puthalapattu and previously served in Srikalahasti), and constables Praveen, Hemadri, Pratap and Kranthi Kumar.

The constables were reportedly associated with the Srikalahasti DSP office. Additionally, a charge memo was served on Srikalahasti DSP Narasimha Murthy. The suspension of six police personnel has created a sensation across Tirupati district. The stern action against

the police is being viewed as a strong message from SP Subbarayudu that any police personnel found colluding with criminal elements or supporting illegal gambling activities will face strict disciplinary action. The investigation into the matka gambling network is continuing, and officials have indicated that further action may follow based on additional findings.

Earlier, the police had taken the matka kingpin Padmanabham and grilled his activities.

Padmanabhan has been escaping the law enforcement agencies and managing gambling operations for over a decade across Srikalahasti, Tirupati, Nagari and several border areas of Tamil Nadu.

Padmanabham is accused of running an extensive matka gambling network that allegedly ruined the lives of many people by attracting them into illegal betting activities.

During the investigation, several crucial revelations reportedly emerged, including allegations that some police personnel had colluded with the accused and provided protection to the illegal matka gambling and supporting the matka activities.

AP's urban infra plan focuses on 5 core areas

₹17,394 crore master plan has been prepared to provide tap water connections to all households in the State

THE Andhra Pradesh government has announced a multi-pronged urban infrastructure plan to be implemented over the next three years, prioritising five core areas—safe drinking water supply, solid waste management, used water management, internal roads, and street lighting.

Inaugurating the two-day Urban Challenge Fund (UCF) Capacity Building Workshop organised under HUDCO's national Urban Investment Window framework in Vijayawada on Tuesday, Municipal Administration and Urban Development Minister Ponuguru Narayana explained the objectives of the government to develop infrastructure facilities in urban local bodies.

Narayana has dismissed speculation that municipal assets were being privatised, calling such claims baseless.

He clarified that upcoming projects will be executed under Public-Private Partnership (PPP) frameworks strictly to make Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) financially self-reliant, with all works awarded through transparent, competitive bidding while retaining full public ownership.

Detailing the funding layout, the Minister revealed a ₹17,394-crore master plan to provide tap water connections to every household, with works worth ₹12,395 crore already under AMRUT 1.0, AMRUT 2.0, UIDF, and AIB schemes.

To convert all katcha drains into permanent concrete structures, an estimated ₹29,000

crore is required; engineers have been directed to immediately complete the first phase of drainage works in high- and medium-density zones with an outlay of ₹9,000 crore.

Explaining the mechanism of the Urban Challenge Fund, Narayana said Andhra Pradesh

will shortly receive ₹3,600 crore in central grants (25% share), while the state must mobilise ₹10,800 crore through HUDCO and other banking channels.

The Finance Department has also cleared an additional ₹5,000-crore pipeline to execute works via an annuity model in smaller municipalities.

He instructed engineers to avoid needless demolition of functional roads or drains under political pressure, and ordered municipal commissioners to take up silt clearance on a war footing ahead of the monsoon while preparing all Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) within three months.

HUDCO Chairman and Managing Director Sanjay Kulshrestha praised Andhra Pradesh for achieving economic growth faster than the na-

tional average, commending its project readiness even before central guidelines were issued.

MA&UD Principal Secretary S. Suresh Kumar said the urban population in the State is 45-50 per cent; municipal revenues alone cannot sustain expanding public amenities.

Suresh Kumar revealed that the department has revived and fast-tracked a ₹15,800-crore pipeline of stalled works under AMRUT, Swachh Bharat, and UIDF schemes, and mandated strict digital data discipline across ULBs.

The workshop was attended by Public Health ENC M Prabhakara Rao, CE A Sudhakar Rao, state official Karthik, along with municipal commissioners, engineers, and finance officers.

Govt extends last date to apply online for faculty posts in varsities till June 15

THE State government has extended the deadline for Faculty Recruitment 2026 in state public universities by one week.

The Office of the Commissioner of Higher Education stated that the revised last date for submission of online applications and payment of the registration fee is June 15, 2026, instead of June 8, 2026.

The applications are being accepted through the Common Recruitment Portal at <https://apuniversitiesrecruitment.apcfss.in>.

Officials said the extension

follows requests from candidates seeking additional time to complete the application process.

So far, 34,207 candidates have registered on the portal. Of them, 29,179 candidates have applied for at least one post, while 27,267 have completed the full application process.

Candidates have applied for a total of 1,60,314 posts.

The department has also revised the recruitment schedule. It extended the last date for submission of hard copies of applications, along with enclosures, to June 22, 2026.

It will display the list of prima facie eligible and ineligible candidates on June 29, 2026. It will accept grievances on eligibility up to July 6, 2026 and publish the final list of eligible candidates on July 7, 2026.

The government has advised candidates who have not completed their applications to submit them before June 15, 2026 and ensure that hard copies reach the registrar of the concerned university within the deadline. The authorities also asked applicants to regularly check the recruitment portal for updates.

392 newly recruited doctors to get postings on June 12

In a move aimed at enhancing transparency, the Andhra Pradesh government has announced that postings for 392 newly recruited doctors under the National Health Mission (NHM) will be carried out through web-based counselling for the first time.

Health Minister Satya Kumar Yadav on Tuesday stated that the AP Medical Services Recruitment Board had selected the doctors on a merit basis, with MBBS qualification, under contractual appointments. Posting orders will be issued on June 12, and the doctors must

report for duty by June 20.

The minister explained that this digital counselling system replaces the earlier Zoom-based process, which often caused technical difficulties and limited options for candidates.

The new method allows applicants to register preferences across six categories of posts, with allotments generated automatically eliminating human intervention. Of the 392 posts, 173 are designated for Urban Health Centres, 99 for NCD clinics in CHCs, area and district hospitals, 70 for newborn care units, 12 for nutrition rehabilitation centres, 25 for telemedicine hubs, and 13 for district early intervention centres.

Driver burnt alive as two trucks collide on highway

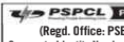
Anantapur: A truck driver was burnt alive in a devastating road accident after two heavy vehicles collided and caught fire near a toll gate on the Ballari-Rampuram highway on Tuesday. According to information a heavy truck laden with gravel was travelling from Rampuram towards Ballari rammed into a cement tanker coming from the opposite direction. The mishap led to massive blaze that rapidly engulfed both vehicles. Gravel truck driver Dikshit (24) of Gaudanahalli village in Hingur burnt alive. Meanwhile, the cement tanker driver, Veera Muthu, managed to jump out of his vehicle and is safe.

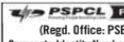
