

Malda gears up for CM's first major regional review meeting

Chief Minister Suwendu Adhikari is scheduled to visit Malda on 12 June to chair a high-level administrative review meeting involving four districts - Malda, Murshidabad, North Dinajpur and South Dinajpur. Official confirmation of the visit reached the district administration today, triggering extensive preparations ahead of the Chief Minister's first major regional review meeting in central Bengal since assuming office.

Administrative sources said Mr Adhikari will arrive by helicopter at the Malda airstrip around noon before proceeding to Malda College Auditorium, where he is expected to hold detailed discussions with senior government officials, district magistrates, police superintendents and elected representatives from the four districts. Significantly, legislators from

Portfolios of four ministers changed:

Kolkata: The allocation of portfolios in the expanded Cabinet of Chief Minister Suwendu Adhikari saw three ministers, who had been assigned multiple departments earlier, shed some of the load today. However, one minister was relieved of a ministry, but simultaneously got an additional responsibility. It may be recalled that five ministers had taken oath alongside Adhikari on 9 May, when the first BJP government in the state took office in the presence of Prime Minister Narendra Modi at the iconic Brigade Parade ground here. Among them, veteran leader Dilip Ghosh had been entrusted with the panchayat and rural development department along with animal resources development and agricultural marketing. Now, Ghosh has been relieved of the animal resources development portfolio, which has been handed to Rajesh Mahata. Noted fashion designer-turned politician Agnimitra Paul was so far heading the urban development and municipal affairs department, besides women & child development and social welfare. Malati Rava Roy, the veteran BJP leader and MLA of Tufanganj, will henceforth look after women & child development and social welfare. Kshudiram Tudu, a tribal leader of the BJP, would also have a reduced workload, with the Backward Classes welfare department being allocated to Cabinet minister Gouri Sankar Ghosh. Tudu is now left with the tribal development department along with and minority affairs & madrasa education portfolios. However, there is a slight variation as far as Nishith Pramanik is concerned. Pramanik, who won the recent Assembly election from Mathabhanga, would continue to be the minister for north Bengal development, while the ministry of youth services & sports, earlier given to him, would now be the responsibility of Indranil Khan. But Pramanik was on Wednesday allotted an additional ministry in the form of water resources investigation and development.

both the ruling party and the Opposition have been invited to attend the meeting. Ministers and BJP MLAs representing the four districts are also expected to participate, making the review one of the largest administrative exercises in the region in recent times. Sources indicated that district-specific development issues will feature prominently during the deliberations. In Malda, discussions are likely to focus on strengthening the district's economy through greater support for its globally renowned mango and traditional silk sector. Challenges such as riverbank erosion along the Ganga and Fulhar rivers, flood

management, infrastructure development, healthcare and connectivity are also expected to come up for review. Officials said the Chief Minister is likely to seek detailed assessments of ongoing development projects, implementation of welfare schemes and district-level administrative challenges. Key issues concerning Murshidabad, North Dinajpur and South Dinajpur will also be discussed, with a particular focus on infrastructure, agriculture, employment generation and public service delivery. Security arrangements have been tightened in and around the Malda airstrip and the

meeting venue. Senior police officials have already conducted toset the tone for the government's development priorities in the four districts, which together account for a substantial portion of the state's population and agricultural output. Local industry representatives and business bodies are also hopeful that the visit will bring renewed attention to long-pending demands relating to industrial growth, investment and employment opportunities in the region.

Signature forgery: Abhishek skips Kolkata return amid CID summons

Trinamul Congress national general secretary Abhishek Banerjee did not return to Kolkata with party chairperson Mamata Banerjee on Wednesday after their three-day visit to New Delhi, triggering fresh speculation over his next move in connection with the alleged signature forgery case being investigated by the Criminal Investigation Department (CID). According to sources, Abhishek Banerjee had reached the Delhi airport and was initially scheduled to board the same flight as the former Chief Minister of West Bengal. However, he reportedly changed his plans at the last moment and decided to remain in the national capital. The development comes against the backdrop of the CID issuing multiple



summonses to Banerjee in connection with the alleged forgery of signatures on a document submitted to the West Bengal Legislative Assembly regarding the appointment of the Leader of Opposition. The Trinamul leader has already skipped three summonses issued by the

investigating agency. The deadline for his appearance before the CID expired at 5 p.m. on Tuesday. Banerjee, however, was in New Delhi to attend the INDIA bloc meeting along with Mamata Banerjee. His absence from the summons prompted the CID to intensify its efforts to ascertain his movements, with sources indicating that the agency sought details from airport authorities. Meanwhile, Mr Banerjee's counsel, senior advocate and Trinamul MP Kalyan Banerjee, moved the Calcutta High Court on Wednesday seeking protection from coercive action in the case. The plea for an urgent hearing was declined, though the matter is expected to come up for hearing on Thursday. Political observers believe the pending court proceedings may have influenced Abhishek Banerjee's decision to delay

his return to Kolkata. Sources said he is likely to await the outcome of Thursday's hearing before deciding his next course of action. The controversy stems from events following the declaration of the Assembly election results. Trinamul legislators had met at Kalighat on 6 May, where the name of senior party leader Sobhandeb Chattopadhyay was proposed for the post of Leader of Opposition. Subsequently, after newly-elected MLAs took oath in the Assembly on 13 and 14 May, signatures were collected on documents related to the proposal. Questions arose when the Assembly Secretariat reportedly found discrepancies between signatures submitted in support of the proposal and those available on official records. Following a complaint, an FIR was registered and the CID launched an investigation.

State Cong leaders have mixed feelings over Mamata comeback possibility

Speculation over Trinamul Congress chairperson Mamata Banerjee's possible alignment with the Congress has triggered a fresh political debate, with senior Congress leaders in West Bengal offering mixed reactions to the reports.

The buzz comes amid claims in political circles that the Congress leadership is exploring a larger opposition realignment following recent electoral setbacks suffered by the Trinamul Congress. Sources have suggested that Congress president Sonia Gandhi has allegedly offered former Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee the post of all-India vice-president of the party, while Trinamul national general secretary Abhishek Banerjee is said to have been offered a national-level organisational role. However, there has been no official confirmation from either the Congress or the Trinamul Congress.



The speculation gained further momentum after reports emerged that Congress general secretary (organisation) KC Venugopal will hold a meeting of state Congress presidents on Thursday. Reacting to the developments, former West Bengal Pradesh Congress Committee president and veteran Congress leader Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury maintained that his political differences with the Trinamul Congress had never been personal. "I never had any personal animosity with Trinamul leaders or the party. Trinamul tried to finish my party politically, and I fought to protect the

Congress. I considered it my political duty," Chowdhury said. Taking a swipe at Mamata Banerjee, he added: "Who is approaching whom is for them to explain. But it is true that Mamata is coming now only after losing the election. Earlier, she never came. Whether there is a merger or demerger taking place, I do not know. If my party takes any decision, it will inform everyone." West Bengal Congress president Shubhankar Sarkar struck a more accommodative note. Without directly referring to Mamata Banerjee, he indicated that the Congress would welcome leaders willing to

fight the Bharatiya Janata Party under Rahul Gandhi's leadership. "Politics is an art of possibilities. If anyone wishes to join our party accepting Rahul Gandhi's leadership and has the determination and strength to fight the BJP, we will certainly welcome that person," Sarkar said. Senior Congress leader Abdul Mannan, however, remained sceptical about any such political rapprochement. Questioning Banerjee's credibility, Mannan remarked, "Nobody can place complete trust in Mamata Banerjee's political conduct. Her credibility in national politics has reached a low point. Everyone knows that, including Sonia Gandhi. There was a time when it was said that the Left could be trusted more than Mamata." As speculation continues to swirl, neither the Congress high command nor the Trinamul Congress has issued any formal statement, leaving political observers closely watching the developments.
