Iran agreed to dismantle nuclear programme, claims White House

Pakistan says final text of US-Iran peace deal agreed

TEHRAN

US President Donald Trump said on Friday that Tehran's stated version of a deal on stopping the war is not what was agreed to, with the White House insisting Tehran would dismantle its nuclear programme.

It comes as Pakistan's Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif said that the final text of a US-Iran peace deal had been agreed. "We can confirm that a final, agreed upon text of the peace deal has been reached and Pakistan is now working closely with both sides to finalise the next steps," Sharif posted on social media.

Earlier in the day, the US and Iran released starkly different accounts of the proposed agreement, with Tehran insisting on its right to enrich uranium and maintain control over the Strait of Hormuz. "The terms that Iran leaked out to the Fake News have NOTHING to do with the terms that were agreed to, in writing," Trump said in a post on his Truth Social network.

"What they said, including their weak and pathetic statement on having a deal, bears no relation to the truth. Very dishonorable people to deal with," Trump added.

"They better get their act together, and FAST!" Trump said in a statement on his Truth Social platform. A senior Trump administration official said the Iranians had agreed to five key points in the deal.

"This is what they have agreed to. This is a performance-based deal," the official told AFP on condition of anonymity.

Iran's nuclear material will be destroyed and removed, and its nuclear program will be dismantled under the deal, the official said.

Iran's frozen funds will not be released until they meet the conditions; the Strait of Hormuz will be open; and Iran will not fund terrorist groups, the official added.

But Tehran's official IRNA news agency said stripping Iran of its enriched nuclear material was not even on the table, while it would insist on managing traffic through the Strait of Hormuz.

After inking an initial memorandum of understanding, IRNA said, Iran and the United States would hold 60 days of talks and that "Iran's right to enrich uranium and the retention of enriched material... will be emphasised with a view to their inclusion in the final agreement".

Meanwhile, Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi said Washington and Tehran have "never been closer" to a deal on ending the war.

"The Islamabad Memorandum of Understanding has never been closer," Araghchi wrote on X, referring to the Pakistani capital which hosted previous US-Iran talks.

"Pending its finalisation, the media should refrain from entering speculation about its content," he added, after purported details of the accord were published by Iranian media.

The clash over the content of the deal comes as both sides seek to show that they have come out with the upper hand following the war that the United States and Israel launched on Iran on February 28.

David Hockney, contemporary master of bold colours no more

LONDON

BRITISH artist David Hockney's paintings captured the world in brilliant colour, from carefree 1960s California to the bucolic landscapes of his native Yorkshire.

Hockney, who died Thursday aged 88, always retained his Yorkshire burr and a determined liking for fish and chips and cigarettes as he grew to be "perhaps the most popular and versatile British artist of the 20th century", in the words of Britain's Tate gallery.

His agent Erica Bolton described Hockney as "one of the most important figures in contemporary art in both the 20th and 21st centuries," adding he had

"passed away peacefully at home" in London on Thursday a month before his 89th birthday.

He leaves behind a huge body of works.

In 2018, his iconic swimming pool picture, "Portrait of an Artist (Pool with Two Figures)" sold for \$90.3 million in New York, setting a new auction record for a living artist. He was unseated by Jeff Koons's "Rabbit" a year later.

Born in 1937 to working-class parents in the northern English town of Bradford, Hockney

went against the conventions of post-war Britain, realising at an early age that he was gay and that he wanted to be an artist.

Hezbollah says it confronted Israeli troops in south Lebanon

Hezbollah said on Friday that its fighters had confronted Israeli forces advancing towards a southern Lebanese town, as Israel pressed on with its strikes in Lebanon. In a statement, Hezbollah said its fighters first targeted Israeli troops advancing towards Majdal Zoun, around five kilometres from the western side of the border, on Thursday evening "with repeated rocket barrages, forcing them to retreat". It then said it engaged with an advancing force there on Friday.

Ukraine reclaimed more land in May than it lost

UKRAINE recaptured more territory than it lost to Russian forces in May for the second straight month, an analysis of data from the Institute for the Study of War (ISW) showed.

Ukraine's army gained a net 282 square kilometres over the month, according to the analysis, as Kyiv hails its improving fortunes on the sprawling battlefield across the south and east of the country.

The pace of Russia's advance has been slowing since late 2025, hobbled by the increasing effectiveness of Ukraine's frontline and mid-range drone strikes, the ISW said.

are still infiltrated in most of the areas where Ukraine has retaken territory, the ISW said. The Russian army regularly sends small groups of soldiers to take up positions along parts of the front line and hide there — a tactic designed to pave the way for larger groups of troops to advance later.

Ukraine's gains in April and May — around 403 square kilometres in total — remain marginal, representing around 0.4 percent of the total territory held by Russia. But they nevertheless point to a positive trend for Kyiv, which has touted itself as having recently gained the upper hand in the four-year conflict.

Moscow had lost control of around 120 square kilometres in April, the first month in which its forces gave up more ground than they captured for two and a half years.
